From the South:

From the SE(Boston): Take Route 128 North to Route 2 West. In Gardener, MA, pick up Route 140 North to 12 North. Follow Route 12 North through Winchendon, through Fitzwilliam and Troy, NH to the traffic light in Keene, NH at the intersection of Route 101. Turn left onto Routes 12/101. At the traffic circle proceed 3/4 of the way around onto Route 10 South toward Swanzey/Winchester. Show site is approx. one mile on the right just after a right curve in the road. From SW(Springfield): Take Route 91 North to Exit 28A(Northfield, MA). Turn right off the exit. At the "T" in Northfield, turn left onto Route 10 North and continue through Winchester, NH. Show site is approx 30 minutes from Route 91 on the left in West Swanzey, NH. You'll pass a large Citgo on the left about 1/2 mile before the driveway for MHS.

From the East:

(Manchester,NH): Take Route 101 West to Keene. Route 10 intersects with 101 at the traffic circle in Keene. Proceed 3/4 of the way around the traffic circle onto Route 10 South toward Swanzey/Winchester. Show site is approx. one mile on the right just after a right curve in the road.

From the West:

(Vermont areas): Take Exit 3 off Route 91 and proceed through the traffic circle to Route 9 East. Follow Route 9 through Chesterfield, NH into Keene-approx. 15 miles. At the traffic circle, stay to the right and follow the slip lane to the right onto Route 10 South toward Swanzey and Winchester. Show site is approx. one mile on the right, just after a right curve in the road.

Site Access - Parking

The entrance to MHS is on Route 10 in West Swanzey NH (just outside of Keene, NH)

Note: You cannot see the Monadnock Humane Society building from Route 10. There is an identifying sign at the end of the driveway. Follow the road to the facility. The agility ring is at the rear of the building. Please follow any event signs and use designated parking as marked. Do not use any reserved parking for MHS customers or staff.

Parking & Crating

Parking is not close to the ring.

Shade is minimal at this site.

Pools and water hoses for your dogs enjoyment will be available.

Entries & Acceptance

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age, regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com.

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

General Entry Conditions

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 26" in the Championship Program or 22" in the Performance Program must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). When not enrolling electronically, please send a copy of one the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor web account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

Self Check In

Self Check In will be available for competitors who have submitted a copy of their dogs "Yellow Permanent Height Card". See above for eligibility.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In - May Run FEO

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may opt to run the dog in the lower jump height class "For Exhibition Only", and no awards or qualifying scores may be earned. The competitor may not change their entry from one program to another (e.g., from Championship to Performance).
