Entries & Acceptance

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age, regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com.

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

New BARK Refund Policy - Bitches In Season

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate per USDAA rules. There will be a refund of entries for bitches coming in season after the trial has closed. Refund requests along with a veterinarian's note/receipt must be received by the trial secretary within five days of the event. Refunds are subject to all non-refundable fees incurred by the club.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

General Entry Conditions

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Class Descriptions

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm, each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at www.usdaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm, and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

International Handler Challenge Classes (Not an IFCS Team Selection Trial)

These classes are open to ALL dogs regardless of level. Championship and Performance programs will be offered. A competitor may enter either program according to the regulation USDAA jump height schedule, or optionally pursuant to the IFCS international standard schedule of jump heights, as follows:

- * 12" height class is 30cm (11 13/16")
- * 16" height class is 40cm (15 3/4")
- * 22" height class is 50cm (19 11/16")
- * 26" height class is over 50cm (19 11/16")

These classes are being held as a fund-raising effort to support Team USA. A minimum of 50% of the net entry fees from the IHC classes go to support the IFCS USA Team.

No IFCS USA Team Selection Points are awarded at this event. Those wishing to try out for the IFCS USA Team should consult the Team Selection Rules.

The IHC Standard agility course contains all the obstacles required in a Masters Standard class excluding the table. The IHC Jumpers course contains all the obstacles required in a Masters Jumpers class plus a minimum of 10 weave poles.

IHC courses contain 18 - 20 obstacles with challenges commensurate with those seen at high-level domestic and international competition. Combinations (multiple hurdles to be defined as a single obstacle) are allowed, making the maximum number of obstacles to be performed greater than 20. A more complete description of the course configurations can be found in the Team Selection Rules.

More complete information on team selection, the IHC courses and contributions in support of the IFCS USA Team will be published as "Team Selection Rules" in the Forms & Documents Library on USDAA.com prior to the closing date for this event.

Veterans Program Classes

Veterans level classes offered at this event are open to a competitor with any dog that is at least eight (8) years of age as of the first day of this event. Previous experience in the sport sufficient to establish proficiency and confidence in performance is strongly encouraged. Once a competitor has earned a qualifying score with a dog in a Veterans class, the dog is no longer eligible to enter that class in the Championship or Performance Programs when a Veterans class is offered. Prizes & Awards

Tournament & Test Class Awards

TEST CLASSES

Each dog earning a qualifying score will receive a maroon qualifying ribbon. Separate 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height for all classes, except Pairs which will be awarded to mini and open divisions. Title Rosettes will also be awarded for completion of AD, PD, AAD, APD, MAD, MPD, ADCH, PDCH and Lifetime Achievements.

TOURNAMENTS:

Grand Prix & PGP: 1st through 4th place Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height. Regional bye vouchers will be awarded at this trial. Special qualifying ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying score.

Steeplechase/PSJ: Special qualifying ribbons will be awarded in Round 1. 1st through 4th place Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height. Go to www.usdaa.com for prize money payout chart.

Team & PVP: 1st through 4th place Rosettes will be awarded for the top four teams/pairs overall. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the first through third place teams/pairs overall. Lapel pins will be awarded to each member of a qualifying team/pair

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 26" in the Championship Program or 22" in the Performance Program must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). When not enrolling electronically, please send a copy of one of the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor web account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

Self Check In

Self Check In will be available for competitors who have submitted a copy of their dogs "Yellow Permanent Height Card". Please see note above for eligibility.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In - May Run FEO

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may opt to run the dog in the lower jump height class "For Exhibition Only", and no awards or qualifying scores may be earned. The competitor may not change their entry from one program to another (e.g., from Championship to Performance).
