Directions To Wheelock Park

The entrance to Wheelock Park is on Park Avenue in Keene, NH.

From the East (Concord, NH):

- * Route 9 West toward Keene
- * Continue on Route 9 West past the intersection with Route 12 (You are actually on Routes 9/10/12 at this point)
- * Take next right at West Street exit, turn right onto West Street

From the East (Manchester, NH):

- * Route 93 to Route 101 West toward Milford/Peterborough/Keene
- * Continue straight at Route 12 intersection (with traffic light) in Keene (by Tire Warehouse)
- * Proceed through the rotary (2nd exit in rotary) continuing on Rt 12/101/10 North
- * Turn right at next light (on Routes 9 East/10 North/12)
- * Take next right at West Street exit (first exit), turn left onto West Street.

From the East/South (Boston):

- * Route 2 to Route 140 North (Gardner, MA), continue onto Route 12 North
- * Turn left at Routes 12/101 intersection in Keene (by Tire Warehouse)
- * Proceed through the rotary (2nd exit in rotary) continuing on Rt 12/101/10 North
- * Turn right at ext light (on Routes 9 East/10 North/12)
- * Take next right at West Street exit (first exit), turn left onto West Street

From the West (NY, VT, Western MA):

- * Route 91 to Exit 3 (Brattleboro, VT), through rotary and onto Route 9 East toward Keene
- * Turn left at light after State Police Barracks/Super 8/Home Depot as you enter Keene. This light is approximately 15 miles from the rotary in Brattleboro VT.
- * Take West Street exit (first exit), turn left onto West Street

Then - There are also brown signs at the West Street exit ramps for Wheelock Park. Follow Park Avenue toward the right when West Street veers off to the left (this is just after the turn onto West Street). The entrance to the park is on the right just after the flashing yellow light and immediately after Plotkins Furniture.

After you enter Wheelock Park, you will see a large athletic field with agility rings. There will be a fork in the driveway. Bear to the right and there is a large paved parking lot or you can bear to the left before the field and there is parking behind the field (with lots more shade!).

If you are going to the Wheelock Campground, you should bear right after you made the first turn to enter the park. Campground guests will check in at the campground office. If you want to go to the CATS RV area (the "gravel lot"), bear left before the field and then look for the sign that says "RVs Register Here". Campers using the gravel lot (not the campground) must check in with a CATS member UNLESS you have used the gravel lot before. Please don't take up more space that you need when parking your rig!

CAMPING in the Gravel Lot is available. The fee is \$10 per night, payable to "Keene Parks & Rec". You may send your camping check with your entry. No hookups are available. (If you want/need hookups, please reserve a site at Wheelock Park Campground).

Wheelock Park RULES **EVERYONE PLEASE READ!!**

This is a public park.

NO adult beverages are allowed in the Park.

NO glass is allowed in the Park.

NO disposal of alcoholic beverage containers or glass in the trash.

Non-adherence to these family-friendly policies may be cause for expulsion from the trial.

NO dogs on the infield dirt of the ballfields or fenced fields, regardless of the time of day.

NO vehicles are allowed on the agility field at any time.

THERE ARE TWO OPTIONS FOR RV/CAMPER PARKING AT THIS SITE.

1. The gravel lot (no hookups) You must fill out the camping form included in this test schedule and return it with your entry with appropriate fees. SEE CAMPING SECTION IN THIS TEST SCHEDULE.

2. Wheelock Park Campground (hookups). You must call the Campground directly if you wish to reserve a camping site with hookups. The phone number for Wheelock Park Camping is listed under "Hotels" in this Test Schedule.

Entries & Acceptance

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA[®] Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com.

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

REFUNDS

CATS Refund Policy

Please note: Overpayments of entry fees are not refundable. Please check your math! Underpayments do not constitute a valid entry. Please check your math!

A dog or handler who suffers an injury and/or illness, or bites that come into season after the closing date may be eligible for a refund of up to 50% of the total entry fee paid for that dog. Requests for said refunds must be received in writing by the Test Secretary by Monday, June 4 at Noon and must be accompanied by a dated letter from the veterinarian or doctor on the veterinarian's or doctor's letterhead with a brief description explaining the reason the dog, or the handler, cannot compete.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

General Entry Conditions

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Class Descriptions

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm, each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at www.usdaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm, and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

Mixed-Height Pairs Entry Allowed

Dogs entered as partners in pairs relay at this event may be combined without regard to jump height, i.e. a mini dog may be entered as a partner with an open dog. Any pair consisting of at least one open dog must qualify in accordance with the QCT set forth by the judge of record for Open Pairs AND will be considered an open pair for placement purposes.

Veterans Program Classes

Veterans level classes offered at this event are open to a competitor with any dog that is at least eight (8) years of age as of the first day of this event. Previous experience in the sport sufficient to establish proficiency and confidence in performance is strongly encouraged. Once a competitor has earned a qualifying score with a dog in a Veterans class, the dog is no longer eligible to enter that class in the Championship or Performance Programs when a Veterans class is offered. Prizes & Awards

Test Class & Tournament Awards

Standard and Non-Standard Classes: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th places in each jump height and to mini and open divisions for Pairs Relay. A maroon qualifying ribbon will be awarded for those achieving a qualifying score in any class being held for certification purposes.

Grand Prix and Performance Grand Prix: Placement ribbons will be awarded in each jump height for each tournament. Special qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those competitors who earn a qualifying score. First place qualifiers in each jump height/tournament shall receive a regional bye voucher.

Steeplechase and Performance Speed Jumping: Special Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded following Round 1 to all dogs achieving a qualifying score. Following the second round, each jump height will be awarded 1st thru 4th place Rosettes and monetary awards. Go to www.usdaa.com for prize money payout chart.

Tentative Schedule

Running order of classes

On Friday, depending on the number of entries received, we may assign up to 3 separate groups for walking and running, eliminating any conflicts!

If separate walk-throughs are necessary in the Masters ring, the details will be in your final confirmation. Starting jump heights will vary in the Masters ring, so please be sure to check your competitor catalog and the gate sheets.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 26" in the Championship Program or 22" in the Performance Program must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). When not enrolling electronically, please send a copy of one of the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor web account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In - May Run FEO

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may opt to run the dog in the lower jump height class "For Exhibition Only", and no awards or qualifying scores may be earned. The competitor may not change their entry from one program to another (e.g., from Championship to Performance).
