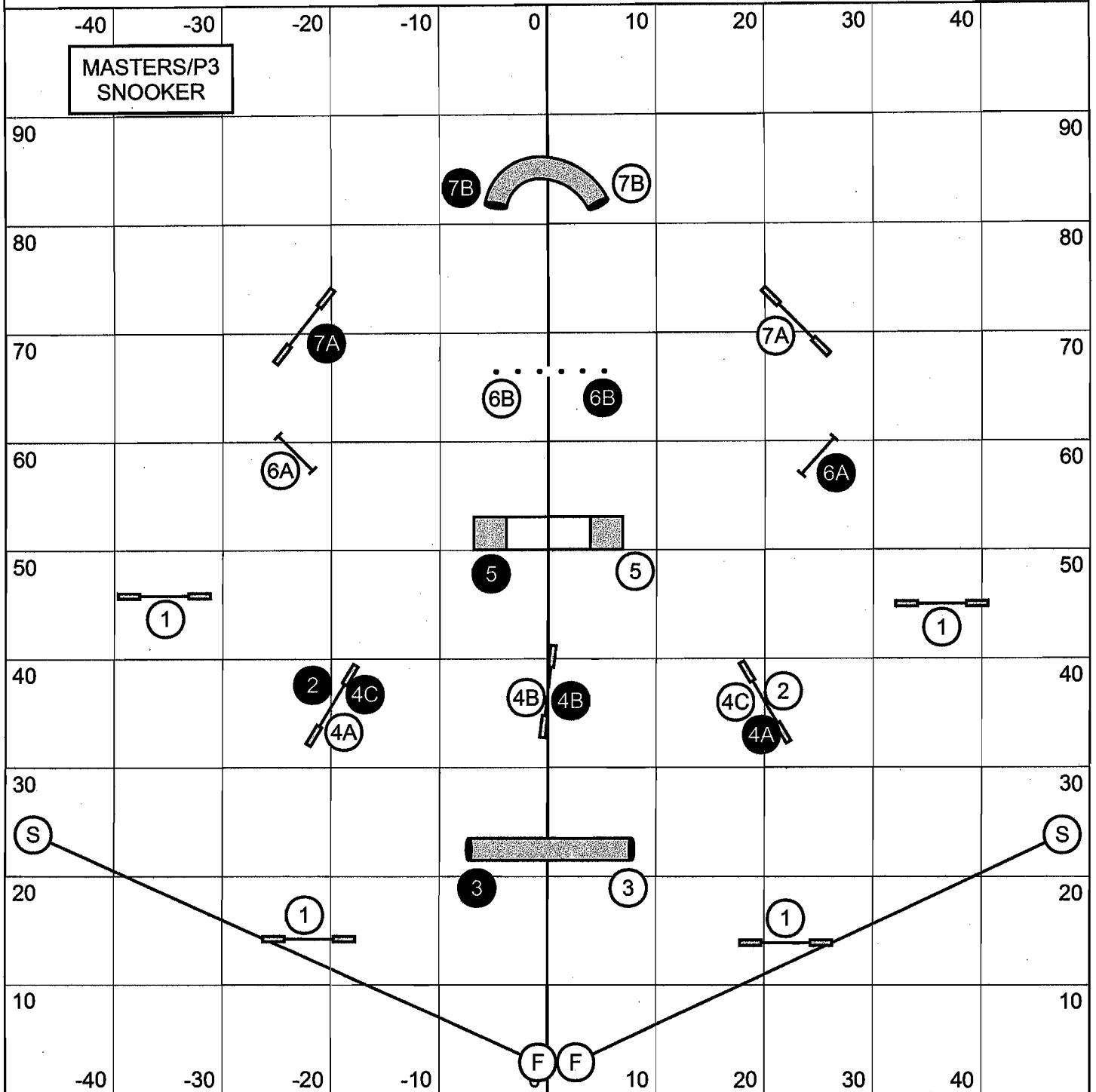


Opening period is 30 seconds with a 1-3-5-7 point system where there is no 7 point obstacle.
 Contacts back-to-back ok, contact to contact not ok - put something in between. Joker times:
 26/22" = 15 seconds, 16" = 16 seconds and 12" = 17 seconds. P3 + 1 second, Vets + 2 seconds.
 Successful Joker = 20 points.

Opening period 3 or 4 Reds may be attempted with all obstacles bi-directional. Combinations may be attempted in any order or flow as long each element is done only once. Closing, your choice of white numbers or black numbers. 26/22" = 52 seconds, 16" = 54 seconds and 12" = 56 seconds. P3 + 2 seconds and Vets + 4 seconds.
