

Can only attempt 3 reds

In the opening, all single obstacles are bi-directional.

In the opening, combinationv#5a-b can be taken from any direction and in any flow.

In the opening, combination #7must be the teeter (square) and a single jump:

The 1st attempt at #7 must be the teeter + jump 7a1 (7, attempt 1)

The 2nd attempt at #7 must be the teeter + jump 7a2 (7, attempt 2)

The 3rd attempt at #7 must be the teeter + jump 7a3 (7, attempt 3)

Note: attempt is defined as an attempt to complete 7, it does NOT mean that #7 was completed successfully.

In the closing:

#2 is NOT bi-directional

Obstacles #2-#6 must be completed in the direction and order specified.

Combo #7 in the closing is: 7a + 7b
