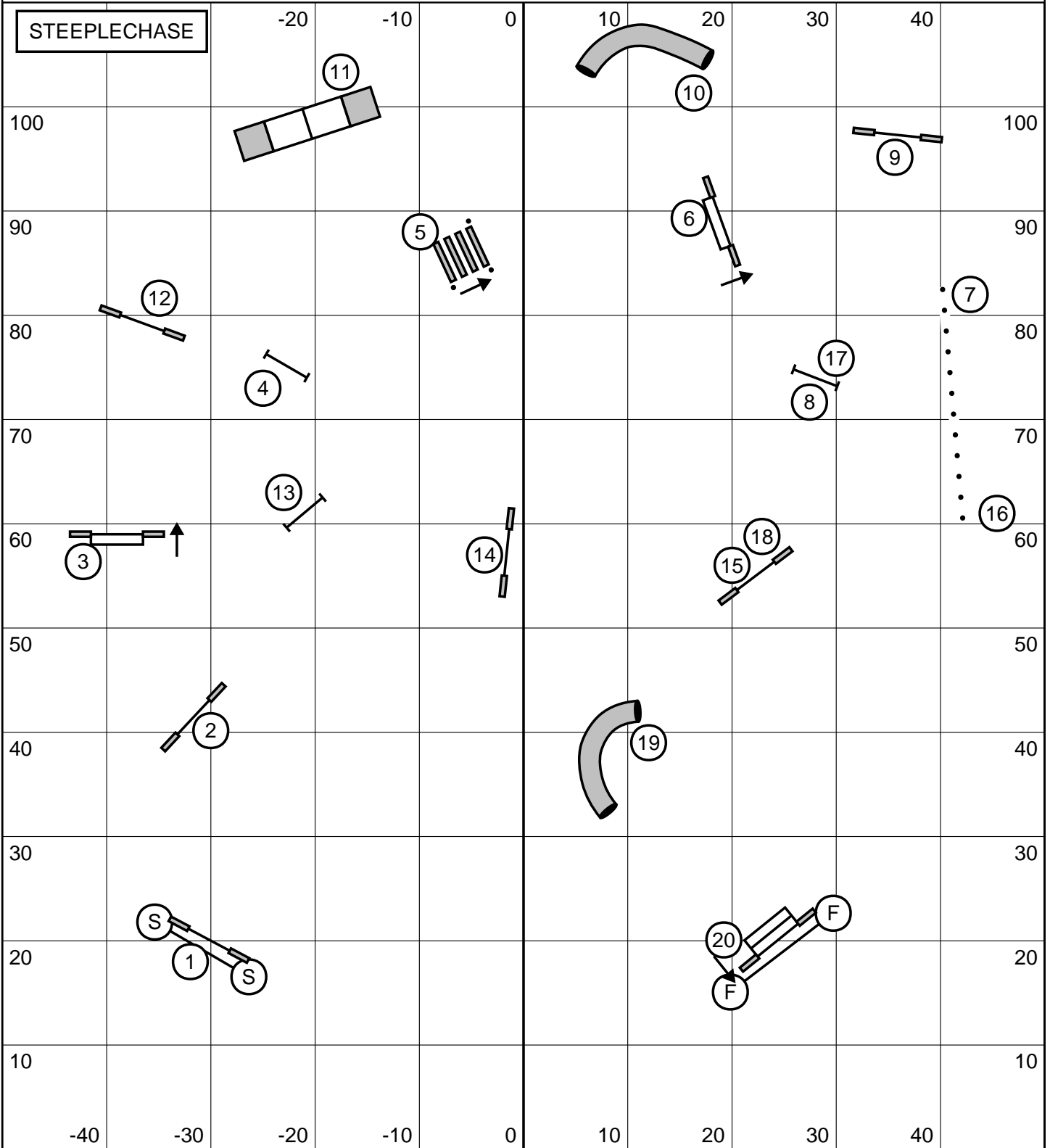


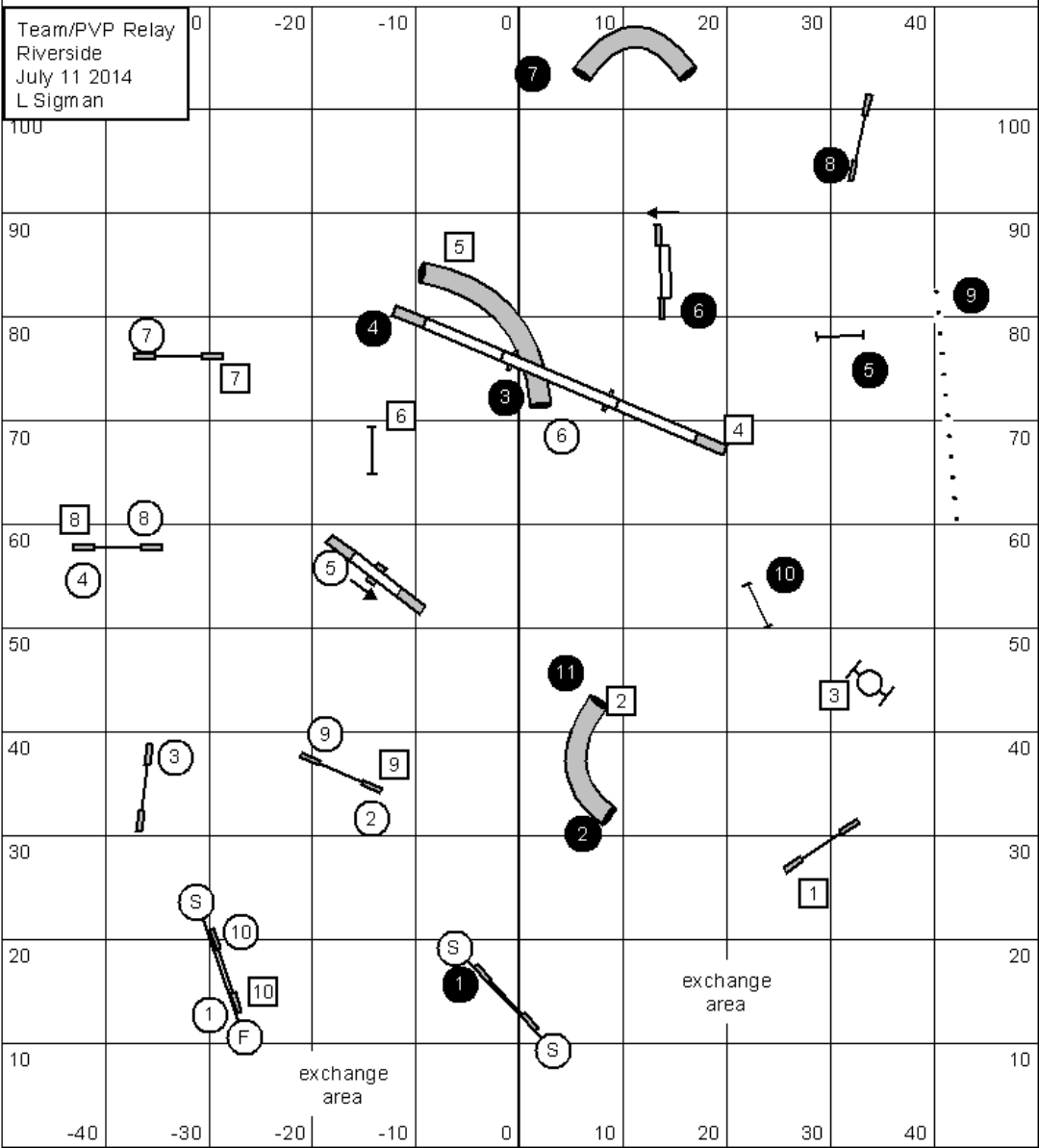

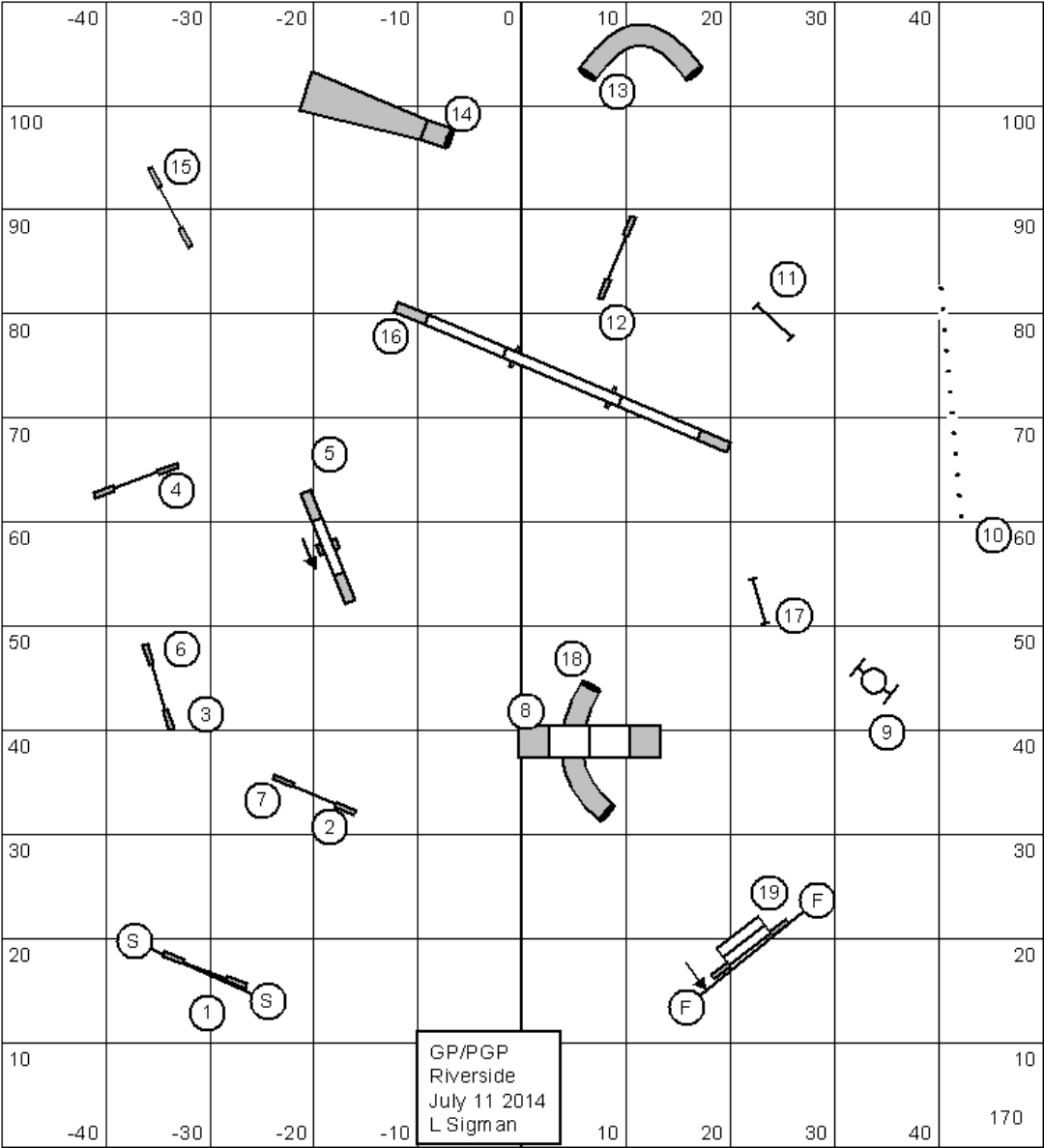


Team Relay: 1st dog runs white circles, 2nd (odd height dog) runs black circles, 3rd dog runs white squares

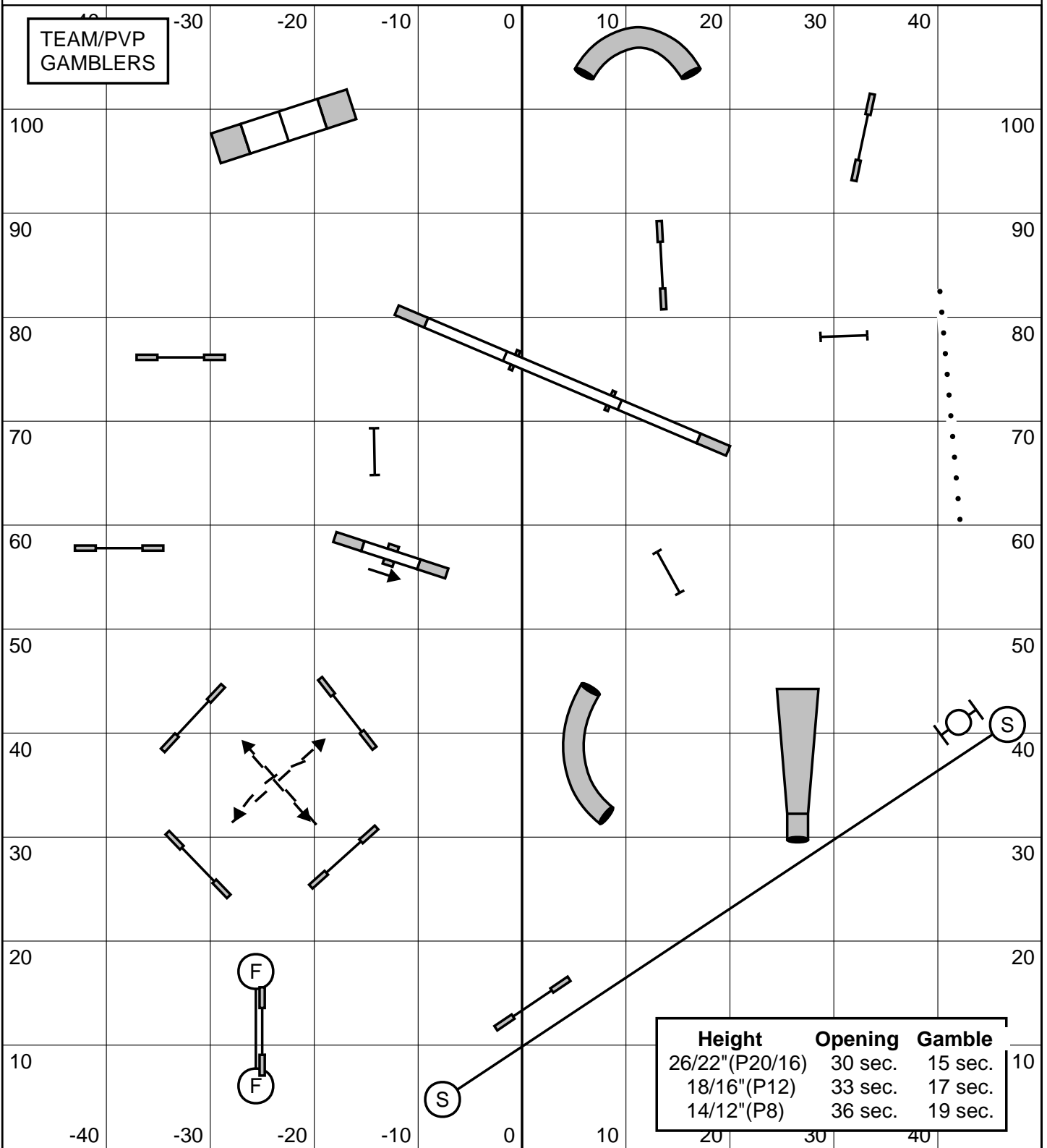
PVP Relay: 1st dog runs black circles, 2nd dog runs white squares

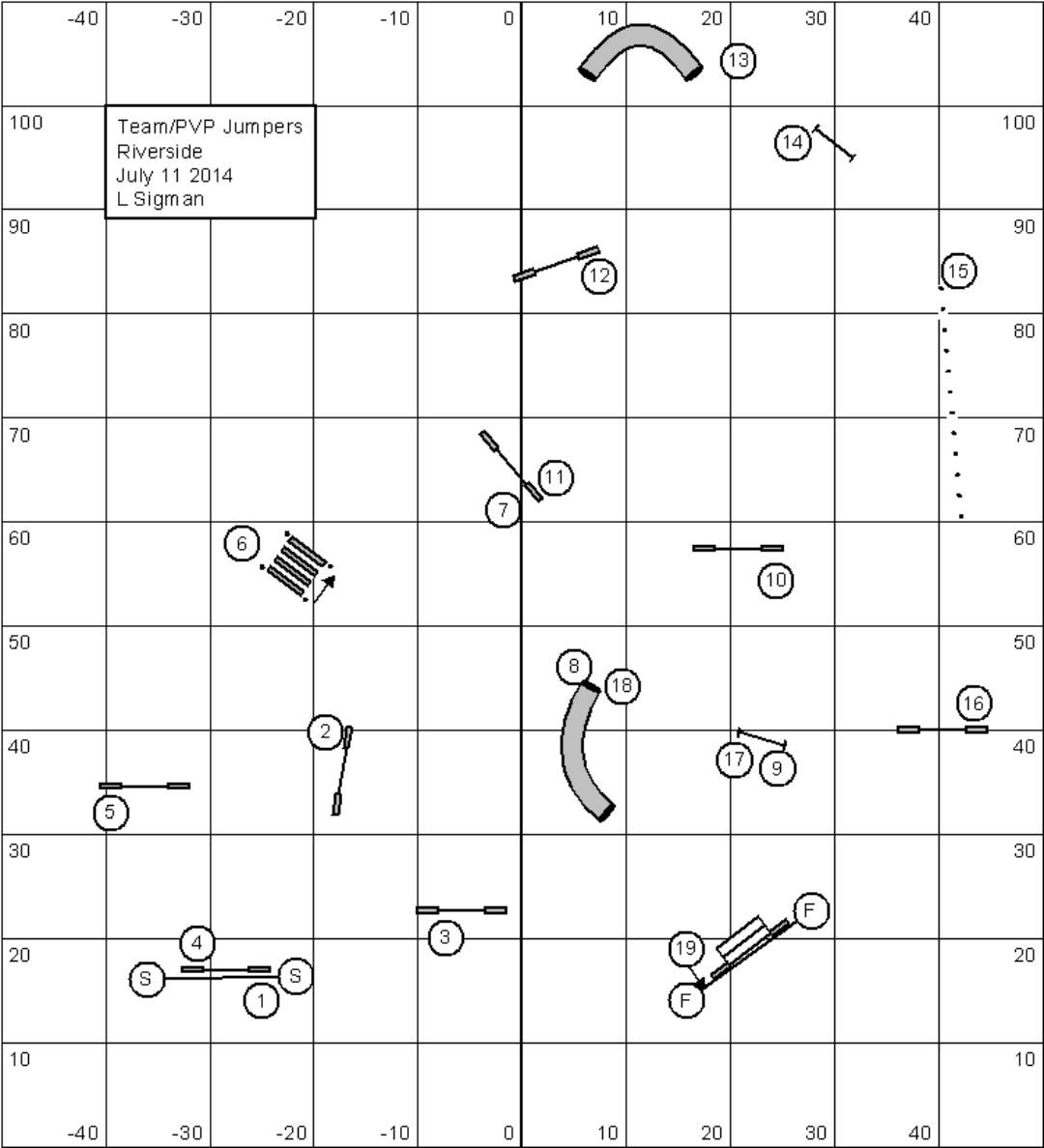




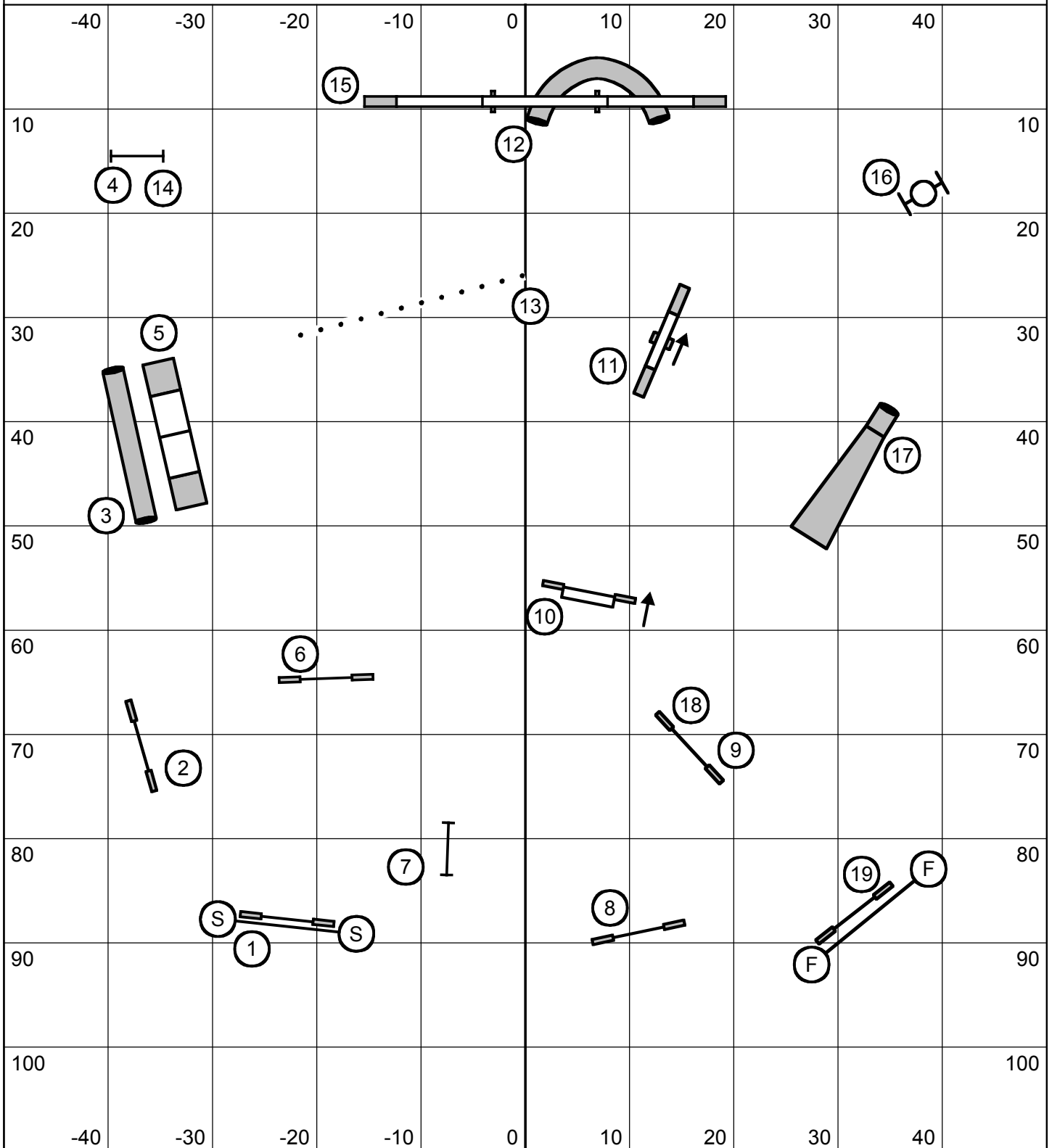

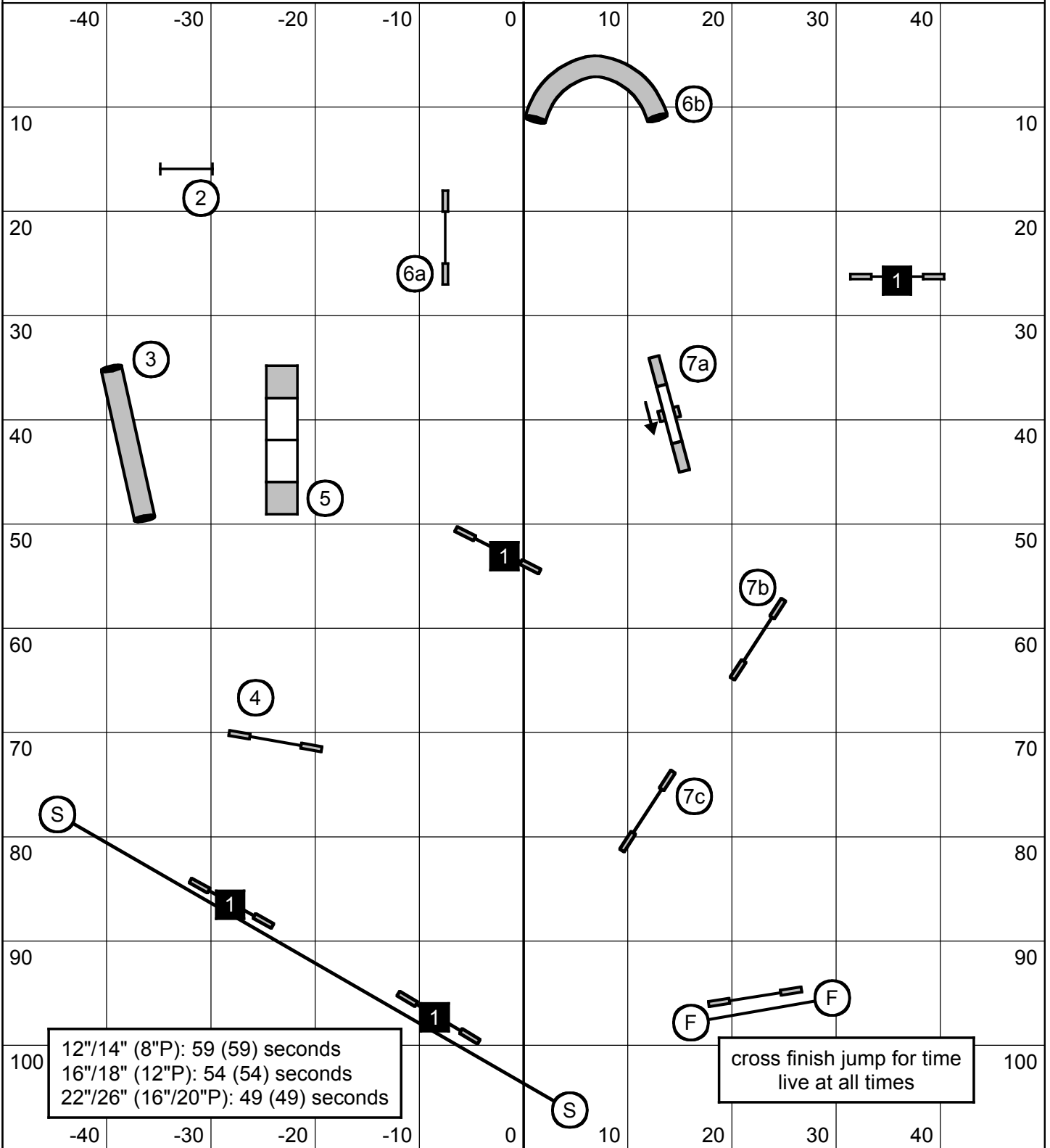
Opening period is a 1-2-3-5 point system where the -Aframe = 5 points. Closing period is the 4-jump-box where each successful jump across the box doubles the points (2-4-8-16-32). If a jump is taken in a diagonal direction or a bar is knocked down, point accumulation ends. The dog must cross the finish jump before the second horn or all points are lost.
