#### Directions to the Site:

##### **From the North:**

From Providence: Take Rt. 95 South, exit Left onto Rt. 4 South. Take the second exit on Rt. 4, Rt 403 East/Quonset Point. Go approx 2 miles on RT 403 exiting to Davisville Rd. Drive 3/4 mile and site will be on your left.

##### **From the South:**

From Westerly: Take Rt 95 North to Exit 8A, Post Rd/ East Greenwich. Bear right off ramp and take immediate left at first traffic light, Division St. At second traffic light bear right onto Rt 4 South ramp. Travel Rt 4 South for approx 1 mile, exiting at Rt. 403 East/Quonset Point. Travel 2 miles then bear left on Rt 403, exiting to Davisville Rd. Drive 3/4 mile and site will be on your left.

##### **From the East:**

From Warwick/ Rt. 1 Post Road: Take Rt 1 /Post Rd South to North Kingstown/Quonset Point. Approaching Rt. 403 overpass take left at light onto Gate Rd. (Marriott Residence Inn will be on your left approaching turn onto Gate Rd). Travel on Gate Road through traffic light approx 3/4 mile to rotary, Take first rotary exit onto Davisville Rd. Drive 1/4 mile and site will be on your left.

##### **From the West:**

From South County/ Rt.1 Post Road: Take Rt.1/ Post Road North through Wickford to Quonset Point. Travel over Rt 403 at Quonset and take right at immediate traffic light, Gate Rd. ## Entries & Acceptance

### Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

### No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

### General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com).

### Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

### NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

### Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

### New Refund Policy for Bitches in Season

**USDAA RULES: BITCHES IN SEASON** shall not be eligible to participate.

There will be a refund of entries for bitches coming in season after the trial has closed. Refund requests along with a veterinarian's note/receipt must be received by the trial secretary within five days of the event. Refunds are subject to all non-refundable fees incurred by the club.

### Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

### Regional - Provisional GP/PGP/STP/PSJ Entries

Provisional entries will be accepted for competitors who have not earned a qualifying score prior to the closing date, which is required for entry to the Regional classes for Grand Prix, Performance Grand Prix, Steeplechase and Performance Speed Jumping. Qualifying opportunity in the Grand Prix/PGP or STP/PSJ through local qualifiers is offered at this Regional Championship event.

A separate payment for provisional entry fees to the tournament classes is required and must be designated on the Entry Form, or such payment will be nonrefundable should the dog not be eligible to run.

### Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

## General Entry Conditions

### Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

### Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

### Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

### Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

### Regional 2014 Jump Height Transition Rules Per Tournament Rules

Due to the change in jump height regulations effective January 1, 2014, the following rules have been established for determining whether the qualification requirements for tournament rules have been met:

In the Championship Program,

- Two qualifications in the 16" height class of the Championship program or one qualification in the 12" height class of the Performance Program prior to January 1, 2014, shall be considered as having been earned in the 14" height class for dogs measuring less than or equal to 14" for purposes of determining eligibility for entry to the 14" height class at a Regional Championship or at Cynosport 2014.
- Two qualifications in the 22" height class of the Championship Program or one qualification in the 16" height class of the Performance Program prior to January 1, 2014, shall be considered as having been earned in the 18" height class for dogs measuring less than or equal to 17 1/2" for purposes of determining eligibility for entry to the 18" height class at a Regional Championship or at Cynosport 2014.
- For competitors eligible for the 14" or 18" height classes under 2014 regulations, at least one of the two required qualifications in an individual tournament (i.e., Grand Prix, Steeplechase or MC Biathlon) must be earned at the height class to be entered at Cynosport 2014, or at a higher height class in the Championship Program prior to January 1, 2014. Consult the Dog Agility Masters tournament rules for separate Jump Height Transition rules for team tournament eligibility
- In the Performance Program, qualification in the 22" height class prior to January 1, 2014, shall be considered as having been earned in the 20" height class.

### Team Relay Limit

#### Team Relay Limit

**In the event of a large entry, the club reserves the right to limit the Team Relay to the top 75% of teams.**

## Class Descriptions

### Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from [www.usdaa.com/rulesReg\\_eBook.cfm](http://www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm), and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from [www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm](http://www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm), each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

### Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at [www.usdaa.com/gen\\_formDoc.cfm](http://www.usdaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm), and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

### Veterans Program Classes

Veterans level classes offered at this event are open to a competitor with any dog that is at least eight (8) years of age as of the first day of this event. Previous experience in the sport sufficient to establish proficiency and confidence in performance is strongly encouraged. Once a competitor has earned a qualifying score with a dog in a Veterans class, the dog is no longer eligible to enter that class in the Championship or Performance Programs when a Veterans class is offered. ### Masters Challenge Classes - Championship & Performance

All dogs - regardless of level of competition - are eligible for entry in the Masters Challenge classes and to earn qualifying scores. These qualifying scores will remain on the dog's record and calculate toward Masters Challenge titles once the dog achieves the Masters Standard / Masters Performance Standard and Masters Jumpers / Masters Performance Jumpers titles.

Additionally, these dogs continue to be eligible for their appropriate level in the regular classes at all levels, unless stipulated otherwise in the Agility Test Schedule. Competitive placements in the Masters Challenge Standard and Jumpers classes accumulate points for annual ranking for Agility Top Ten<sup>SM</sup> and Performance Top Ten<sup>SM</sup>.

### **Masters Challenge Qualification for 2014 Masters Challenge Biathlon**

At both local and regional events, a qualifying score in the Masters Challenge Standard and Jumpers (Performance included) will make a dog eligible for entry in the 2014 Cynosport World Games Masters Challenge Biathlon being offered for Championship and Performance. So that any dog may compete in this special Cynosport tournament, the Masters Challenge class rules have been modified to allow a dog at any level of competition to enter. ### **Team & Versatility Pairs Measure-up Policy - FEO**

The handler of a dog entered in Team or Versatility Pairs that is required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measurement must notify the secretary immediately. Should the higher jump height make the dog ineligible for their team (three jump heights), the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from available dogs. The dog may not be moved to Versatility Pairs.

In the event the competitor is unprepared to run their dog at the higher jump height, they may run in the tournament For Exhibition Only. No member of the Team or Pair may earn a tournament qualification, but Team or Pairs partners are eligible for individual placements, tournament top ten points and Lifetime Achievement Qs in the individual tournament classes.

## **Prizes & Awards**

### **Awards\***

#### **Test Classes:**

Each dog earning a qualifying score will receive a maroon qualifying ribbon. Separate 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height for all classes. Title Rosettes will also be awarded for completion of AD,PD, AAD, APD, MAD, MPD, ADCH, PDCH and Lifetime Tournaments

#### **GRAND PRIX & PERFORMANCE GRAND PRIX**

Local qualifiers – Maroon ribbons will be awarded to all qualifying scores (zero faults).

1st-4th place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height.

The first place qualifier in each jump height will receive a bye voucher which may be used at this event.

#### **Regional Championship**

Round 1: Maroon ribbons will be awarded to all qualifying scores (zero faults).

Round 2: Semifinalist rosettes will be awarded to all competitors having zero faults and earning a bye into the semifinals at the Cynosport World Games. The first 3 places in each jump height will receive a medal and rosette. The first place competitor in each jump height will be named the Regional Champion and will receive a trophy.

#### **STEEPLECHASE AND PERFORMANCE SPEED JUMPING**

Local Qualifiers – Maroon ribbons will be awarded to all qualifying scores as outlined in the rules. There will be no Round 2 at this event.

#### **Regional Championship**

Round 1: Maroon ribbons will be awarded to all competitors earning a qualifying score as outlined in the rules.

Round 2: Semifinalist rosettes will be awarded to all competitors earning a bye into the semifinals at the Cynosport World Games. The first 3 places in each jump height will receive a medal and rosette. Prize money will be calculated using entry fees from the local qualifier and Regional Round 1. The first place competitor in each jump height will be named the Regional Champion and will receive a trophy.

#### **TEAM AND VERSATILITY PAIRS**

Maroon ribbons will be awarded to all members of qualifying teams/pairs. The first 3 places in each tournament will receive a medal and rosette. The first place team/pair will be named the Regional Champion and will receive a trophy.

#### **BIATHLON**

First through third place rosettes and medals will be awarded in each jump height. The Regional Champion - first place in each jump height - will receive a trophy. For the individual classes placement and qualifying ribbons will be awarded.

## Check-in & Measuring

### Dog Measurements & Certification

Only dogs 18 months of age and entered in this event may be measured.

All dogs not jumping 26" in the Championship Program or 20" in the Performance Program must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). When not enrolling electronically, please send a copy of one the following items to facilitate the check-in process:

- photocopy of permanent dog registration card,
- printout of the dog-information page from your USDAA® competitor web account, or
- copy of your check-in letter from USDAA indicating your temporary card has been accepted by the USDAA office and your permanent registration card is in process.

### A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In FEO Not Allowed

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor MUST run the dog at the higher jump height. The dog shall be placed first in the running order for all classes entered. The competitor may not change their entry from one program to another (e.g., from Championship to Performance).

### Regional - Special Measuring

Competitors whose dog has a temporary height card MUST have the dog measured prior to checking in at any Regional Championship event or Cynosport® World Games in order to confirm that the dog is eligible for the height entered.

If the dog measures up, the competitor must jump the dog at the higher jump height in all classes regardless of the jump height in which the dog earned its qualifications. If the competitor had a bye at the lower height, the bye is forfeited, and the competitor must compete in all rounds that may have been bypassed as a result of the bye.

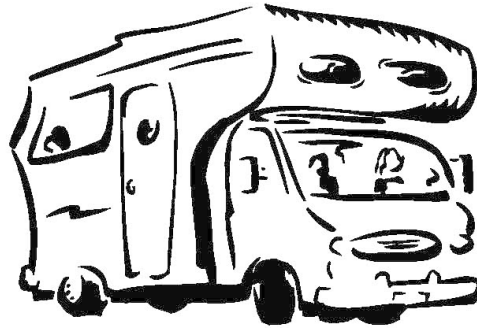
