From the North:

From Providence: Take Rt. 95 South, exit Left onto Rt. 4 South. Take the second exit on Rt. 4, Rt 403 East/Quonset Point. Go approx 2 miles on RT 403 exiting to Davisville Rd. Drive 3/4 mile and site will be on your left.

From the South:

From Westerly: Take Rt 95 North to Exit 8A, Post Rd/ East Greenwich. Bear right off ramp and take immediate left at first traffic light, Division St. At second traffic light bear right onto Rt 4 South ramp. Travel Rt 4 South for approx 1 mile, exiting at Rt. 403 East/Quonset Point. Travel 2 miles then bear left on Rt 403, exiting to Davisville Rd. Drive 3/4 mile and site will be on your left.

From the East:

From Warwick/ Rt. 1 Post Road: Take Rt 1 /Post Rd South to North Kingstown/Quonset Point. Approaching Rt. 403 overpass take left at light onto Gate Rd. (Marriott Residence Inn will be on your left approaching turn onto Gate Rd). Travel on Gate Road through traffic light approx 3/4 mile to rotary, Take first rotary exit onto Davisville Rd. Drive 1/4 mile and site will be on your left.

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Entries & Acceptance

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com, as [amended](#)

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Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

Regional - Provisional GP/PGP/STP/PSJ Entries

Provisional entries will be accepted for competitors who have not earned a qualifying score prior to the closing date, which is required for entry to the Regional classes for Grand Prix, Performance Grand Prix, Steeplechase and Performance Speed Jumping. Qualifying opportunity in the Grand Prix/PGP or STP/PSJ through local qualifiers is offered at this Regional Championship event.

A separate payment for provisional entry fees to the tournament classes is required and must be designated on the Entry Form, or such payment will be nonrefundable should the dog not be eligible to run.

Provisional Entries Triathlon

Provisional entries into the Triathlon will be accepted for competitors who have not yet earned a qualifying score prior to the closing date, which is required for entry to the Triathlon class in any one of the following tournaments: Grand Prix/Performance Grand Prix, Steeplechase/Performance Speed Jumping, or Championship/Performance Masters Challenge Biathlon (either the overall tournament or a clear round in either round of the Biathlon).

This qualification must have been earned during the period of July 1, 2017 through July 1, 2018. Qualifying opportunity in these tournaments through local qualifiers is offered at this event.

A separate payment for provisional entry fees to the Triathlon is required and must be designated on the Entry Form, or such payment will be nonrefundable should the dog not be eligible to run.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 24" in the Championship Program or 20" in the Performance Program at local and regional events must be measured unless they have permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration status or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). Please note that only dogs 18 months of age and entered in the event may be officially measured.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In - May Run FEO

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may

- Run the dog at the higher height in the same program based upon the measurement,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Performance Program,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Veterans Program if the dog is 8 years old
- Run For Exhibition Only (FEO) at the next lowest jump height, but only in the program entered.

Because entry into a higher height is permitted in the Performance and Championship Programs, a dog measuring lower may not be moved to a lower height in either program.

Regional - Special Measuring

Any dog entered in tournaments that does not have a completed registration card, i.e. three measurements that place the dog in a specific jump height, must be measured prior to competing at a Regional Championship event or Cynosport® World Games in order to confirm that the dog is eligible for the height entered.

If the dog measures up, the competitor must jump the dog at the higher jump height in all classes regardless of the jump height in which the dog earned its qualifications. If the competitor had a bye at the lower height, the bye is forfeited, and the competitor must compete in all rounds that may have been bypassed as a result of the bye.

General Entry Conditions

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Provisional rules

Notification of New Eligibility for Provisional Regional or Triathlon Entry Change in Tournament or Triathlon Eligibility Prior to the Event

If you have entered the Regional Grand Prix/Performance GP and/or Regional Steeplechase/Speed Jumping on a provisional basis, written notification of eligibility MUST be given to the secretary of record no later than 6pm July 9th, prior to this regional championships. This notification may consist of confirmation that the dog is eligible for the regional classes entered OR that the local qualifier(s) entered at the regional is still needed for eligibility. If no notification is given, you will forfeit provisional entry fees for the classes. Notification must be made via email to Valvaussies@comcast.net with a read receipt. Secretary cannot be responsible for undeliverable/misaddressed emails.

Change in Tournament or Triathlon Eligibility at the Event

Should a dog earn eligibility for round 1 or round 2 of the Regional Grand Prix/Performance GP or round 1 of the Regional Steeplechase/Speed Jumping in the local qualifier offered on the Friday at this regional, the competitor must complete and submit to the secretary the Tournament/Triathlon Eligibility form in accordance with instructions on the form which will be available at the awards table. This form needs to be submitted no later than 30 minutes after the last local tournament class on Friday.

Team Relay Limit

Team Relay Limit

In the event of a large entry, the club reserves the right to limit the Team Relay to the top 75% of teams.

Bitches In Season Allowed at This Regional

Special provisions are being made for competitors who have bitches in season. However, any dog that is ill or exhausted and pregnant bitches cannot take part in the running of any class. For details go to http://www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm.

Class Descriptions

Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at www.usdaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm, and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

Team & Versatility Pairs Measure-up Policy - FEO

The handler of a dog entered in Team or Versatility Pairs that is required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measurement must notify the secretary immediately. Should the higher jump height make the dog ineligible for their team (three jump heights), the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from available dogs. The dog may not be moved to Versatility Pairs.

In the event the competitor is unprepared to run their dog at the higher jump height, they may run in the tournament For Exhibition Only. No member of the Team or Pair may earn a tournament qualification, but Team or Pairs partners are eligible for individual placements, tournament top ten points and Lifetime Achievement Qs in the individual tournament classes.

Masters Challenge Biathlon

This Biathlon consists of two classes; Masters Challenge Standard and Masters Challenge Jumpers. While these two classes will count as titling runs, they also form the biathlon where scores will be converted to time plus faults. After the two classes, scores will be combined to calculate those dogs in each jump height earning eligibility by posting an overall score in the top 25%. A dog scoring an elimination in either class will be eliminated from Biathlon award contention.

Triathlon

Triathlon - Requirement for Invitation

To enter the Triathlon, the dog must be entered either as a team entrant or as a draw in the Dog Agility Masters Team or Performance Versatility Pairs tournaments AND in addition must have entered the Triathlon class as a fully qualified entrant or provisional entrant. See the previous description of qualification under the Entries & Acceptance section for an explanation of eligibility to the Triathlon. No day of show Triathlon entries will be accepted.

The Triathlon is scored as follows: Triathlon Round 1 scores are taken from the Team/PVP Standard class (point basis of 130 minus the dog's time plus faults).

Triathlon Round 2 scores are taken from the Team/PVP Jumpers class (point basis of 100 minus the dog's time plus faults). Scores from Rounds 1 and 2 are combined in order to determine advancement into Round 3. A score of elimination in either Round 1 or 2 disqualifies the dog from advancing to Round 3.

Triathlon Round 3 is limited to the top 50% of entrants or five (5) Round 3 eligible dogs, whichever is greater, in each jump height.

Triathlon Round 3 is judged under Masters rules, except that refusals are not scored. The course is a Masters level design consisting of 17 to 23 obstacles which must include one contact obstacle and one set of weave poles, as well as other obstacles chosen from the following: wing jump,

wingless jump, spread jump, extended spread jump, long jump, tire jump, pipe tunnel, and viaduct/wall jump. This round is scored time plus faults.

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm, each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Veterans Program Classes

Veterans level classes offered at this event are open to a competitor with any dog that is at least eight (8) years of age as of the first day of this event. Previous experience in the sport sufficient to establish proficiency and confidence in performance is strongly encouraged. A dog entered in a Veterans class on a day may not be entered in that class in the Championship or Performance Programs. Prizes & Awards

Regional Awards

Test Classes:

Each dog earning a qualifying score will receive a maroon qualifying ribbon. Separate 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height for all classes, except pairs which will be awarded to mini and open divisions. Title Rosettes will also be awarded for completion of AD,PD, AAD, APD, MAD, MPD, ADCH, PDCH and Lifetime Achievements.

Local Qualifier Grand Prix & Performance Grand Prix:

Regional Bye Vouchers awarded to the first place qualifier in each jump height, 1st-3rd placement ribbons in each jump height along with special qualifying ribbons for qualifying scores.

Local Qualifier Steeplechase & Performance Speed Jumping:

1st-3rd placement ribbons in each jump height along with a special qualifying ribbons for qualifying scores. (there is no round two)

Regional Grand Prix & Performance Grand Prix:

Round 1:

1st-3rd placement ribbons in each jump height along with special qualifying ribbons for qualifying scores.

Round 2:

Regional Champion Trophy awarded to 1st place in each jump height.

Cynosport Semifinalist certificates are awarded to all competitors earning a bye

1st-3rd place medallions and placement rosettes will be awarded in each jump height.

Regional Steeplechase & Speed Jumping

Round 1:

1st-3rd placement ribbons in each jump height along with special qualifying ribbons for qualifying scores.

Round 2:

Regional Champion Trophy awarded to 1st place in each jump height.

Cynosport Semifinalist certificates are awarded to all competitors earning a bye

1st-3rd place Rosettes and medallions will be awarded in each jump height.

Team & Performance Versatility Pairs:

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals and rosettes will be awarded to the first through third place team/pairs overall.

1st place overall: Trophy awarded to each member of the team/pair.

Blue Rosettes for top team and pair (consists of 2 mini dogs) (consists of 2 open dogs)

Masters Challenge Biathlon Award:

1st-3rd place ribbons and medallions are awarded in each jump height.

Regional Champion Trophy awarded to first place in each jump height for overall(Championship and Performance for Biathlon Jumpers and Biathlon Standard combined.)

Generally, there will be plenty of time to move around in the running order of the Masters/Tournament classes (except Snooker, of course).

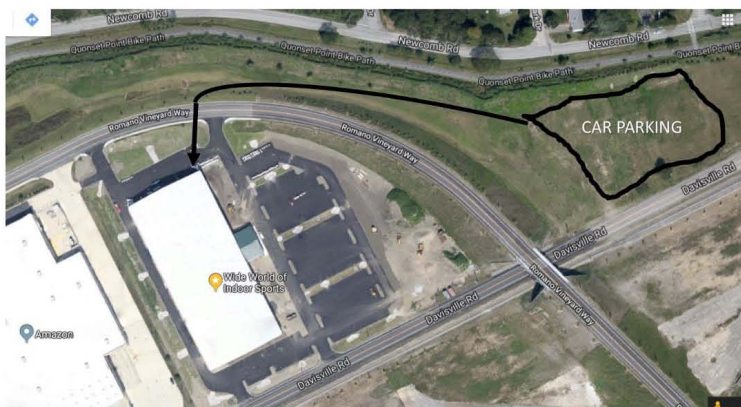
PARKING - IMPORTANT CHANGE TO RV AND CAR PARKING. PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.
