# Directions to the Site: From the South:

From the SE (Boston): Take Route 128 North to Route 2 West. In Gardner, MA, pick up Route 140 North to 12 North. Follow Route 12 North through Winchendon, through Fitzwilliam and Troy, NH to the traffic light in Keene, NH at the intersection of Route 101. Turn left at Tire Warehouse onto Routes 12/101. At the traffic circle proceed 3/4 of the way around onto Route 10 South toward Swanzey/Winchester. Show site is approx. one mile on the right just after the Market Basket and a right curve in the road. From SW (Springfield): Take Route 91 North to Exit 28A(Northfield, MA). Turn right off the exit. At the "T" in Northfield, turn left onto Route 10 North and continue through Winchester, NH. Show site is approx 45 minutes from Route 91 on the left in West Swanzey, NH. You'll pass a large T-Bird Mini Mart/Citgo/Dunkin Donuts on the left about 1/2 mile before the driveway for MHS. If you get to the Market Basket, you missed MHS.

#### From the East:

(Manchester,NH): Take Route 101 West to Keene. Route 10 intersects with 101 at the traffic circle in Keene. Proceed 3/4 of the way around the traffic circle onto Route 10 South toward Swanzey/Winchester. Show site is approx. one mile on the right just after the Market Basket and a right curve in the road. If you get to the T-Bird Mini Mart/Citgo/Dunkin Donuts, you missed MHS.

#### From the West:

(Vermont areas): Take Exit 3 off Route 91 and proceed through the traffice circle to Route 9 East. Follow Route 9 through Chesterfield, NH into Keene-approx. 15 miles. At the traffic circle, stay to the right and follow the slip lane to the right onto Route 10 South toward Swanzey and Winchester. Show site is approx. one mile on the right, just after the Market Basket and a right curve in the road. If you get to the T-Bird Mini Mart/Citgo/Dunkin Donuts, you missed MHS.

#### **Entries & Acceptance**

#### No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

#### **General Rule on Eligibility**

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

#### **General Rule on Eligibility**

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

#### Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

#### **NSF Check/Credit Card**

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

#### **Refund Policy**

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

#### **CATS Refund Policy**

Please note: Overpayments of entry fees are not refundable. Please check your math. Underpayments do not constitute a valid entry.

A dog or handler who suffers an injury and/or illness, after the closing date MAY be eligible for a refund of up to 50% of the total entry fee paid for that dog. Requests for said refunds must be received by the Test Secretary and must be accompanied by a dated, signed letter from the veterinarian or doctor on the veterinarian's or doctor's letterhead, with a brief description explaining the reason the dog, or the handler, cannot compete.

#### Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

#### **Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event**

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

#### **Express & Overnight Entries**

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

## **Check-in & Measuring**

#### **Dog Measurements & Certification**

All dogs not jumping 24" in the Championship Program or 20" in the Performance Program at local and regional events must be measured unless they have permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration status or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). Please note that only dogs 18 months of age and entered in the event may be officially measured.

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may

- Run the dog at the higher height in the same program based upon the measurement,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Performance Program,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Veterans Program if the dog is 8 years old
- Run For Exhibition Only (FEO) at the next lowest jump height, but only in the program entered.

Because entry into a higher height is permitted in the Performance and Championship Programs, a dog measuring lower may not be moved to a lower height in either program.

#### **General Entry Conditions**

#### **Prohibitions on Aids & Devices**

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

#### Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of themselves, their dogs, children, and guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site

#### **Policy on Fault Limits**

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

#### Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

#### **BIS**

#### Bitches is Season:

CATS is now excepting entries from Bitches in Season. (BIS) BIS will be allowed to compete within the following parameters: Valori Duff (the trial secretary: Valwaussies@comcast.net) must be notified as soon as the competitor knows their bitch is in season/will be in season at the event. Bitches MUST wear sanitary panties at all times on the show grounds, including in the crating area, common areas, on the way to potty and while competing. By doing so no adjustment in the running order will be needed and other exhibitors with intact dogs can easily recognize the condition of the bitch. Please be respectful of other competitors while your BIS is in close proximity of other dogs. Failure to follow these procedures may result in dismissal from the trial.

#### Fix & Continue Will Be Allowed At This Event

The <u>USDAA Policy Statement on Training in the Ring or "Fix & Continue"</u> has been adopted for this event and is hereby incorporated in its entirety by reference. Competitors are expected to familiarize themselves with this policy, which can be found on the USDAA web site at <a href="http://usdaa.com/binary/files/20180828FixandContinuePolicy.pdf">http://usdaa.com/binary/files/20180828FixandContinuePolicy.pdf</a>.

Fix & Continue during a competition run generally provides for repeat of an obstacle at handler's discretion under conditions set forth in the Policy Statement. When discretion is exercised to utilize the Fix & Continue, their score will be recorded as an elimination and the maximum course time set to 60 seconds. This practice may be utilized only once in any Standard, Jumpers, or Relay class (including similarly-styled tournament classes at qualifying events). The competitor must continue working the course in flow, while "fixing" and "continuing" on the course. See the Policy Statement referenced above for complete details.

#### **Class Descriptions**

#### Misc Class Train in the Ring

This class is being offered for training purposes; open to all levels.

Audible toys are permitted.

Note: a dog can be rewarded inside the ring with a toy and occasionally run with the handler out of the ring where the dog is rewarded with a food treat. After which they may return to the ring to repeat the obstacle. All of this occurring with in the 60 seconds permitted.

Maximum time permitted on the course is 60 seconds. The time will start 5 seconds after the "GO" sound. There will be 2 horns, one at 50 seconds, telling you that you have 10 seconds to start working your way to the exit. Then another at the 60 second mark.... meaning exit the ring.

Any harsh or abusive handling is stickly prohibited and will result in immediate dismissal from the ring and shall be subject to disciplinary actions pursuant to Appendix C of the USDAA Official Rules & Regulations.

#### **Mixed-Height Pairs Entry Allowed**

Dogs entered as partners in pairs relay at this event may be combined without regard to jump height, i.e. a mini dog may be entered as a partner with an open dog. Any pair consisting of at least one open dog must qualify in accordance with the QCT set forth by the judge of record for Open Pairs AND will be considered an open pair for placement purposes.

## **Veterans Program Classes**

Veterans level classes offered at this event are open to a competitor with any dog that is at least eight (8) years of age as of the first day of this event. Previous experience in the sport sufficient to establish proficiency and confidence in performance is strongly encouraged. A dog entered in a Veterans class on a day may not be entered in that class in the Championship or Performance Programs. #### **Prizes & Awards**

#### **Test Class & Tournament Awards**

Standard, Non-Standard and Biathlon Classes: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th places in each jump height and to mini and open divisions for Pairs Relay. A maroon qualifying ribbon will be awarded for those achieving a qualifying score in any class being held for certification purposes.

**Grand Prix and Performance Grand Prix**: Placement ribbons will be awarded in each jump height for each tournament. Special qualifying ribbons will be awarded to those competitors who earn a qualifying score. First place qualifiers in each jump height/tournament shall receive a regional bye voucher

Steeplechase and Performance Speed Jumping: Special Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded following Round 1 to all dogs achieving a qualifying score. Ribbons and monetary awards will be awarded 1st through 4th place for each jump height. No second round will be run.
