From the North:

From Providence: Take Rt. 95 South, exit Left onto Rt. 4 South. Take the second exit on Rt. 4, Rt 403 East/Quonset Point. Go approx 2 miles on RT 403 exiting to Davisville Rd. Drive 3/4 mile and site will be on your left.

From the South:

From Westerly: Take Rt 95 North to Exit 8A, Post Rd/ East Greenwich. Bear right off ramp and take immediate left at first traffic light, Division St. At second traffic light bear right onto Rt 4 South ramp. Travel Rt 4 South for approx 1 mile, exiting at Rt. 403 East/Quonset Point. Travel 2 miles then bear left on Rt 403, exiting to Davisville Rd. Drive 3/4 mile and site will be on your left.

From the East:

From Warwick/ Rt. 1 Post Road: Take Rt 1 /Post Rd South to North Kingstown/Quonset Point. Approaching Rt. 403 overpass take left at light onto Gate Rd. (Marriott Residence Inn will be on your left approaching turn onto Gate Rd). Travel on Gate Road through traffic light approx 3/4 mile to rotary, Take first rotary exit onto Davisville Rd. Drive 1/4 mile and site will be on your left.

From the West:

From South County/ Rt.1 Post Road: Take Rt.1/ Post Road North through Wickford to Quonset Point. Travel over Rt 403 at Quonset and take right at immediate traffic light, Gate Rd. Travel on Gate Rd for approx 3/4 mile to rotary. Take first rotary exit onto Davisville Rd. Drive 1/4 mile and site will be on your left.

Entries & Acceptance

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA® Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com, as amended

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Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Bitches in Season

Bitches is Season:

PAWS is now accepting entries from Bitches in Season. (BIS) BIS will be allowed to compete within the following parameters: Valori Duff (the trial secretary: Valwaussies@comcast.net) must be notified as soon as the competitor knows their bitch is in season/will be in season at the event. Bitches MUST wear sanitary panties at all times on the show grounds, including in the crating area, common areas, on the way to potty and while competing. By doing so no adjustment in the running order will be needed and other exhibitors with intact dogs can easily recognize the condition of the bitch. Please be respectful of other competitors while your BIS is in close proximity of other dogs. Failure to follow these procedures may result in dismissal from the trial.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 24" in the Championship Program or 20" in the Performance Program at local and regional events must be measured unless they have permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration status or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). Please note that only dogs 18 months of age and entered in the event may be officially measured.

Eligibility

Eligibility Notification for Provisional Regional Entry

If you have entered the Regional Grand Prix/Performance GP and/or Steeplechase/Speed Jumping on a provisional basis, written notification of eligibility MUST be given to the secretary of record no later than noon on Monday, July 7th prior to this regional championships. This notification may consist of confirmation that the dog is eligible for the regional classes entered OR that the local qualifier(s) entered at the regional is still needed for eligibility. If no notification is given, you will forfeit provisional entry fees. Notification must be made via email to [View Note](#) with a read receipt. The secretary cannot be responsible for undelivered/misaddressed emails.

Regional - Special Measuring

Any dog entered in tournaments that does not have a completed registration card, i.e. three measurements that place the dog in a specific jump height, must be measured prior to competing at a Regional Championship event or Cynosport® World Games in order to confirm that the dog is eligible for the height entered.

If the dog measures up, the competitor must jump the dog at the higher jump height in all classes regardless of the jump height in which the dog earned its qualifications. If the competitor had a bye at the lower height, the bye is forfeited, and the competitor must compete in all rounds that may have been bypassed as a result of the bye.

General Entry Conditions

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of themselves, their dogs, children, and guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Fix & Continue Will Be Allowed At This Event

The [USDAA Policy Statement on Training in the Ring or "Fix & Continue"](#) has been adopted for this event and is hereby incorporated in its entirety by reference. Competitors are expected to familiarize themselves with this policy, which can be found on the USDAA web site at [http://usdaa.com/binary/files/20180828FixandContinuePolicy.pdf](http://usdaa.com/binary/files/http://usdaa.com/binary/files/20180828FixandContinuePolicy.pdf)

Fix & Continue during a competition run generally provides for repeat of an obstacle at handler's discretion under conditions set forth in the Policy Statement. When discretion is exercised to utilize the Fix & Continue, their score will be recorded as an elimination and the maximum course time set to 60 seconds. This practice may be utilized only once in any Standard, Jumpers, or Relay class (including similarly-styled tournament classes at qualifying events). The competitor must continue working the course in flow, while "fixing" and "continuing" on the course. See the Policy Statement referenced above for complete details.

Class Descriptions

Mulligan Runs

Based upon the number of runs per day at this trial Mulligan Runs may be available for one or more classes each day. The Show Committee shall determine in which class(es) a Mulligan Run will be allowed. Availability and cost for each run shall be announced in final confirmations. Only competitors entered in the class are eligible for a Mulligan Run per USDAA policy which is hereby incorporated by reference.

A competitor must sign up and pay for their Mulligan Run immediately following their titling run (if they didn't sign up/pay for a Mulligan Run prior) and prior to the completion of the class. A Mulligan Run sign-up sheet will be made available. When Mulligans are running concurrently with another ring at an event, only silent toys are allowed and may not be tossed. Food, treats, training aids are not allowed.

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdcaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from www.usdcaa.com/rulesReq.cfm, each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at www.usdcaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm, and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

Team & Versatility Pairs Measure-up Policy - FEO

The handler of a dog entered in Team or Versatility Pairs that is required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measurement must notify the secretary immediately. Should the higher jump height make the dog ineligible for their team (three jump heights), the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from available dogs. The dog may not be moved to Versatility Pairs.

In the event the competitor is unprepared to run their dog at the higher jump height, they may run in the tournament For Exhibition Only. No member of the Team or Pair may earn a tournament qualification, but Team or Pairs partners are eligible for individual placements, tournament top ten points and Lifetime Achievement Qs in the individual tournament classes.

Veterans Program Classes

Veterans level classes offered at this event are open to a competitor with any dog that is at least eight (8) years of age as of the first day of this event. Previous experience in the sport sufficient to establish proficiency and confidence in performance is strongly encouraged. A dog entered in a Veterans class on a day may not be entered in that class in the Championship or Performance Programs. Masters Challenge Biathlon - Concurrent Titling Scores

The Masters Challenge (MC) & Performance Masters Challenge(PMC) Biathlon tournaments each consists of two classes; Standard and Jumpers. In addition to the combined score of these two classes being scored for tournament qualification purposes, each class will be scored independently in order to determine if title qualification has been earned for the MC and PMC standard and jumpers classes.

Test Classes:

Each dog earning a qualifying score will receive a maroon qualifying ribbon. Separate 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place Rosettes will be awarded in each jump height for all classes. Title Rosettes will also be awarded for completion of AD, PD, AAD, APD, MAD, MPD, ADCH, PDCH and Lifetime Achievements.

Local Qualifier Grand Prix & Performance Grand Prix:

Regional Bye Vouchers, 1st-3rd placement ribbons in each jump height.

Local Qualifier Steeplechase & Performance Speed Jumping:

1st-3rd placement ribbons in each jump height. (there is no round two)

Regional Grand Prix & Performance Grand Prix:

Round 1:

1st-3rd placement ribbons in each jump height. Q ribbons for qualifying scores.

Round 2:

1st-3rd place in each jump height receives medals and placement rosettes. Regional Champion Trophy awarded to 1st place. Certificates issued to all semifinalists in each jump height. These certs must be included with Cynosport entry.

Regional Steeplechase & Speed Jumping

Round 1:

1st-3rd placement ribbons in each jump height.

Round 2:

1st-3rd place rosettes and medals awarded in each jump height. Regional Champion Trophy awarded to 1st place.

Certificates issued to all semifinalists in each jump height. These certs must be included with Cynosport entry.

Team & Performance Versitility Pairs:

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals/1st-3rd place rosettes will be awarded to the first through third place team/pairs overall.

1st place overall: trophy to each member of the team/pair.

Blue Rosettes for top team and pair (consists of 2 PVP dogs) (consists of 3 open dogs)

Masters Challenge Biathlon Award:

1st- 3rd placement rosettes, with medals and trophy to 1st place in each jump height. Rosettes are awarded to the top 3 placements in Championship and Performance for Masters Challenge Jumpers and Masters Challenge Standard combined.
