



Thank you for your entry. Please remember clocks go BACK on Saturday evening.

If money is owed, please see Val prior to running.

To help speed it along, we ask that you listen to the judges briefing and being online when asked to do so. This means leashes off and kisses done.

We will only be using the green side door for Entry and Exiting. Please do not use the front door.

All handlers of dogs entered in USDAA trials must check-in.

Saturday and Sunday

Doors open at 7:00 each morning. Please do not enter prior to this time.

Measuring and check in 7:15 - 7:45

General briefing will be at 7:45 followed by walk thru. First dog on line 3 minutes after walk.

Walk-thrus:

Will be 7 minutes long. Please pay special attention to the running order.

There will be three (3) minutes after the walk thru before 1st dog is on line

==> Updated mask policy: Masks will be optional in the building. We encourage those who are unvaccinated or in contact with vulnerable people to consider wearing a mask for your safety and that of others.

==>Entry and exit into the ring will be at the front gates. We will not be using the rear arena exit. Because of this we need to keep the front area as uncongested as possible. Only dogs entering and exiting the ring should be in this area. Please, no chairs or seating in the arena. Use the upstairs for crating and viewing.

Please use the back entry into the kitchen to line up, maintaining a safe distance. Make your way to the entry gate when the dog in front of you has gone into the ring.

When exiting, quickly make your way out of the arena to reward. Please leave your treats, toys, rewards on the table provided. No lingering along the fence line, please.

==> Please note there is no parking to the left of the building. This is reserved for trial committee and staff.

==>Maps will be available for all competitors through two methods: Maps will be posted on site for competitors to view and photograph. Maps will also be posted on WWW.MYDOGENTRY.com Competitors may choose to also order physical copies of maps for \$5 a day. We will not be printing individual copies of maps for competitors unless that competitor pre orders maps. If you choose to order maps, they will be available in the morning prior to walkthroughs for pick up each day.

==> Dogs must be on leash or crated unless in the ring or when at the warm up jump. Competitors are RESPONSIBLE for the behavior of their children and/or dogs and the dogs or children in their care. Please DO NOT tie your dogs out and/or leave them unattended at ANY time for ANY reason!

==> Please pick up your dog's poop (or any other you may see); trash containers will be provided for disposal. Anyone who does not pick up after their dog will be asked to leave. No refund, no exceptions!

==> Those dogs entered in Masters/PIII Snooker cannot be moved in the running order. The only exception to this USDAA rule is if you are running more than one dog and the dogs are within 10 dogs of each other in the running order you may only move UP in the running order
