Walk-thrus:

Will be 7 minutes long. Please pay special attention to the running order.

There will be three (3) minutes after the walk thru before 1st dog is on line

- ==> Updated mask policy: Masks will be optional in the building. We encourage those who are unvaccinated or in contact with vulnerable people to consider wearing a mask for your safety and that of others.
- ==> Entry and exit into the ring will be at the front gates. We will not be using the rear arena exit. Because of this we need to keep the front area as uncongested as possible. Only dogs entering and exiting the ring should be in this area. Please, no chairs or seating in the arena. Use the upstairs for crating and viewing.

Please use the back entry into the kitchen to line up, maintaining a safe distance. Make your way to the entry gate when the dog in front of you has gone into the ring.

When exiting, quickly make your way out of the arena to reward. Please leave your treats, toys, rewards on the table provided. No lingering along the fence line, please.

- ==> Please note there is no parking to the left of the building. This is reserved for trial committee and staff.
