Please drive carefully within the fairgrounds. The horses will be running on the track in the morning prior to the agility runs starting. Horses should be off the track by 745am each morning.

Please DO NOT walk dogs along the outside perimeter fence. This upsets the neighbor's dog. We are trying to keep them happy.

Food at Fairgrounds:

PAWS will be bringing in lunch Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. There may be a food vendor as part of an AKC event on site, but we don't have confirmation of that.

Many local Greenfield restaurants will also deliver to the fairgrounds.

GP/PGP BYES NOTE:

This only applies to those who submitted GP/PGP Byes. You will be entered in BOTH rounds. This does NOT obligate you to run in Round 1. All dogs with Byes should be listed in Sunday's Rd 2, if you do not see that listed, please contact Val immediately.

REMINDER: Byes can only be used by the handler/dog team who earned the Bye, no substitutions permitted.

Scores: Please be sure to check your scores prior to leaving for the day. Monitors are in place so you can check them almost immediately.

WORKERS: We can't do it without you. Please help out if help is needed. All workers will receive raffle tickets good for gift cards. Joyce Gauthier and Lauren Kras will be our fabulous worker coordinators. Please help out when needed.

AWARDS:

An award ceremony will be conducted after each of the following classes. Handlers and their dogs must be available. **Please be prepared so we can expedite this process.**

Friday-Completion of MC/PMC. Top three dog and handler teams in each division and jump height need to

be available following the completion of the class for pictures.

Saturday Steeplechase Regionals. Top three dog and handler teams in each division and jump height need to be available following the completion of the class for pictures.

Sunday- Completion of relay - Strategic games awards. Top three overall dog and handlers in Snooker and Gamblers for each jump height.

Sunday- Completion of Team relay - Team awards: Top three dog and handlers in 3-dog and 2-dog teams need to be available for pictures immediately following team relay.

Sunday Grand Prix Regionals. Top three dog and handler teams in each division and jump height need to be available following the completion of the class for pictures.
