**Thursday Night:** Fun Runs are being held on Thursday evening from 4pm – 6pm. \$5 per dog for EMAC members and \$10 for non-members. You do not need to be registered with CPE to participate although your dog should have some experience on the equipment – for your safety and your dog's.

• Course maps will be posted online at My Dog Entry and emailed to all competitors each night before each trial day. For example, Friday's maps will be emailed Thursday night. We will not have copies at the trial other than some posted.

## **Important Trial Information:**

- A previous email was sent containing information regarding your entry. It is your responsibility to check this information carefully and notify the trial secretary of any errors as soon as possible. Most errors cannot be fixed on the day of trial. Please email me at <u>emactrials@gmail.com</u> if you need something fixed.
- Parking: Per Topsham Fair groundcrew- please obey the No Parking signs. If you park in an area that cannot be parked on, you will be asked to move. Please respect our volunteers as they are only relaying the message of the Topsham Fair.
- Masks at this event are not required and may be worn at the competitor's discretion.
- Bait and toys must be at least ten feet from the ring. Use the "bait baskets" provided just outside the gates to store your bait bags.

- All exhibitors <u>must</u> pick up after their dogs in all areas of the fairgrounds. Please use the trash cans for dog pick-up.
- Crating: There will be a small amount of shaded crating space for quiet dogs under cover in the green building, where ribbons will be available for pick up. Please bring EZ-ups and shade cloth and plenty of water for your dogs.
- Special Note for Campers: If you are camping, please bring extra splitters, hoses, and RV extension cords.

### **General Trial Information:**

- **Food**: There will not be a food vendor on site. There are many restaurants and a grocery store within a few miles of the trial site.
- **Water**: In an effort to **"go green"** and use less plastic, EMAC will not provide bottled water at this trial. We will provide a large container of water (Spring water, not from the fairground faucet) so that you can fill your own water bottle, so BYOWB!
- The snacks are free to Volunteers and for purchase by others.
- **Saturday night** Sign up to bring one of our suggested items or add your own specialty dish for a **Saturday Night Picnic**! Dinner will begin approximately 45 minutes after the last dog finishes their run! <u>Click here to Sign Up</u>.
