NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

*The safety of the dogs is the primary concern so by entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

*Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

*It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. If an exhibitor is asked to leave the trial site, then the exhibitor will not be refunded any fees that have been paid.

*Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

*Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms. Any illegible or incomplete entries will not be entered in the trial.

Refunds: There will be **NO** refunds after the closing date **UNLESS** the Trial Chairperson and/or Trial Secretary receive a note from the exhibitor's veterinarian or physician. The note must be delivered no later than the end of the trial. Only then will EMAC refund 60% of the entry fee.

CAMPING

RV Parking and Tent spaces will be assigned after closing. All reservations with spots indicated will be posted on our Facebook page and website (www.easternmaineagility.club) shortly after closing.

Ringside Camping is limited. Priority is given to those involved in event management. All other spots are assigned by the order of entries/forms received from opening date.

Please read these guidelines for they may have changed since our last trial.

- Be sure to fill out the request completely. Reservations must be paid for in full before reservation is accepted.
 - ⇒ EMAC Members: \$30.00 per night for camper or tent
 - ⇒ Non-EMAC Members: \$40.00 per night for camper or tent
 - ⇒ Any reservations received after the closing date: \$50.00 per night for camper or tent. If campsites are available, campers without reservations are allowed. You must check in with the Camper Coordinator, pay the \$50.00 per night fee before parking/setting up.
- Sites will have water and electric only, with priority given to campers. Tent site may not have electricity. There is a dump station on site free of charge. Please bring plenty of electric cords and water hose.
- Parking in assigned spaces only. If you park in an off-limits area or a spot that you were not assigned, you will be asked to move.
- Tent & campers will be assigned to an area.
- Arrivals the night prior to the event and staying until the morning after the event is allowed. Please include the fees for the extra night(s)
- Splitters for the water may be needed and generators must be **off from 9 pm - 5 am** each day.
- There is a dump station on site free of charge.
- Reservations will not be accepted by telephone or e-mail. You must submit this form with your entry form.
