- This is your GENERAL BRIEFING. PLEASE READ IT !!
- Please stay current and follow YOUR local, State & Federal COVID guidelines.
- ARRIVAL TIMES: Sat & Sun 7:00AM
- CATALOG/MEASURING: The catalog/Run Order will be posted on My Dog Entry.com by Wednesday evening.
- PARKING: There is NO parking in the small lot to the right of the building as you are looking at it from the street. The only exception is if you are a handicapped handler & display a handicapped placard. Per the Gym, DO NOT walk your dogs in this area. Participants should only potty their dogs in the vicinity of the newly added potty stations. Spaces on the other side of the dumpster are reserved for those crating out of their car. If you bring a crate indoors, please DO NOT park near the dumpster.
- INDOOR FOOT TRAFFIC PATTERN: Entrance to the building and Arena will be through the lobby, and down the hallway where the restrooms are located. Exit will be through the staff door. Please pay attention to the signage.
- MEASURING: All dogs that appear on the measuring list will need to be measured OR present a permanent jump height card from another agility organization with actual shoulder height recorded, BEFORE their first run. You will be emailed with details Thursday evening.
- First dog on line NO LATER THAN 8AM each day. Sunday's first course will be open for all to walk at 7:15AM.
- CRATING: At this time, INDOOR Crating is allowed in the CLASSROOM only. PLEASE limit personal belongings. Items MUST be stacked on top or behind of your crate(s). If you are crating inside, PLEASE DO NOT PARK near the dumpster! Those closer spaces are for competitors working out of their car, i.e., NOT crating indoors. If you park near the dumpster and ARE NOT working out of your car, you will be asked to move. NO DOUBLE DIPPING PLEASE AND THANK YOU!!!
- For the health and safety of all we ask that people always maintain physical distancing!
- Sorry, NO Food Vendor. Please bring your own lunch and drinks including water for your dog(s). Individually wrapped snacks will be available for volunteers.
- COURSE MAPS: Will be posted on My Dogs Entry.com at 3PM the day before they are to be run. Full size courses will be posted at the site as well. Please DO NOT crowd these viewing area(s).
- JUDGES' CLASS BRIEFINGS: Will be listed on each course map. The Judge will be available for questions as needed.
- RESTROOMS are available indoors.
- The practice jump will be located indoors.
- WALK THRUS: Will be split for the larger classes as needed. Walk thrus will be 5 minutes, i.e., walk, walk, run, run. Only ONE WALK THROUGH per handler. Maintain the 6-foot social distance during your walk. NO TOUCHING the equipment. If there is ONE walk through, we will wait minutes or until 5 dogs are lined up, which ever come FIRST.
- Please follow the direction of the Gate Steward. It will be each exhibitor's responsibility to physically distance and be ON LINE when it is your turn. After your run, please exit the ARENA immediately.
- GATE SHEETS: Will be on the ribbon table. Please check in for the day.
- We will be using REAL TIME RUN ORDER on the monitor in the arena.

- There will be a monitor with Real Time Results, near the scoring area.
- MOVE-UPS: Move ups in repeated classes are allowed. The competitor MUST complete the move up sheet on the ribbon table for the next day, before leaving the trial.
- Scoring questions may be given to one of the committee members and they solely can approach the scoring area. Please be respectful of the Committee Members when they are getting ready to or have just left the ring with their dogs.
- VOLUNTEERS: THANK YOU!!! You are welcome to snacks and for each class you volunteer and work, put your name on a slip of paper (or 2) & put it in the OTHER red flip top container for a chance at dog treats, toys or CASH. The raffle will be pulled towards the end of each day and marked on the volunteer schedule.
