



GENERAL BRIEFING FOR BO-GEE'S UPCOMING CPE EVENT AT

Run In The Woods 37 Ham Rd Raymond, NH

- **ARRIVAL TIME:** 7:00AM
- **DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES** 7:15AM
- **GENERAL BRIEFING:** 7:30AM
- **WALK THROUGH:** 7:45AM
- **FIRST DOG ON THE LINE NO LATER THAN:** 8:00AM
- **CATALOG:** The catalog aka running order can be found on mydogentry.com. Go to Trials, Closed & look for our event. Click on the blue button under each respective day.
- **THIS IS AN OUTDOOR EVENT:** Please dress accordingly (this is New England, plan for any occasion!) including proper foot ware for running outdoors.
- **MEASURING:** All dogs that appear on the measuring list will need to be measured OR may present a permanent jump height card from another agility organization with the dog's actual shoulder height recorded, BEFORE their first run. Those appearing on the measuring list AFTER Thursday's CPE update will be emailed.
- **COURSE MAPS:** Can be found on mydogentry.com after 3pm the day BEFORE they are to be run. Go to Trials, Closed & look for our event. Click on the blue button under each respective day. Full size courses will be posted at the site as well.
- **PARKING** is in between and amongst the trees, plenty of natural shade. Please adhere to the Killam/Kent family parking instructions at all times. There is a **ONE-WAY** drive that goes counter clock wise around the agility ring. Please DO NOT drive around the ring while a dog is on course. Wait for a course build, walk through or jump height change.
- **TENTS:** You are welcome to set up your own tent for crating on the gravel pad behind the tan club tent. The **tan** tent is the staging area for dogs to go into the ring, results & ribbons. NO CHAIRS OR CRATES PLEASE. The **white** club tent is for spectators & food. NO DOG's or crating PLEASE!
- No campers, trailers, pull behind vehicles allowed without prior permission from the property owner.
- **NO SMOKING:** Smoking is only allowed inside competitors vehicles and cigarettes **must** be extinguished inside the vehicle. No butts dropped on the ground. Smoking is not allowed outside of vehicles on the property, including parking areas, wooded trails or near the agility ring (including porta-potties). Because of the substantial fire hazard, violators may be banned from the premises.
- There is plenty of wooded dog walking options. Do keep your dog on leash at all times except when at the warm up jump or in the agility ring. **DO NOT** walk on the front lawn in front of the private residence.
- For the health and safety of all we ask that people maintain physical distancing at all times!
- **POTLUCK IS BACK!!** What a great opportunity to show off your culinary skills or test out a new recipe. There is a sign-up sheet is on MDE.
- **JUDGES' CLASS BRIEFINGS:** Will be listed on each course map. The Judge will be available for questions as needed.
- **PORT-A-JOHNS** are available outdoors and a hose for cooling dogs & handlers alike if needed.
- The practice jump will be available.

- **WALK THRUS:** Will be split for the larger classes as needed. Walk thrus will be 5 minutes, i.e., walk, walk, run, run. Only ONE WALK THROUGH per handler. Maintain the 6-foot social distance during your walk. NO TOUCHING the equipment.
- Please follow the direction of the Gate Steward. It will be each exhibitor's responsibility to be ON LINE when it is your turn.
- **COLLARS/LEASHES:** All handlers have the choice to put their leash in their pocket, safely loop it around their waist or neck OR leave a 2nd leash at the finish. The leash does not have to be out of the dog's sight, however, if the dog plays with it during the run, it would be considered a toy resulting in an NT. Per CPE, dogs may now wear a **SINGLE** flat collar, NO TAGS.
- **GATE SHEETS:** Will be on the ribbon table. Please check in for the day.
- **REAL TIME RUN ORDER** May be available and used depending on internet availability.
- **MOVE-UPS:** Move up's in repeated classes are allowed. The competitor **MUST** complete the move up sheet on the ribbon table for the next day, before leaving the trial.
- **SCORING/RESULTS:** Questions may be given to one of the committee members and they solely can approach the scoring area. Per CPE rules once the trial is over results cannot be changed!!! Please check your scores!!!
- **VOLUNTEERS:** THANK YOU!!! You are welcome to snacks and for each class you volunteer and work, put your name on a slip of paper (or 2) & put it in the OTHER **red** flip top container for a chance at dog treats, toys or **\$\$CASH\$\$** The raffle will be pulled towards the end of each day and marked on the volunteer schedule. **NEW** for this trial, we will be offering a special raffle for free classes to future Bo-Gee trials!
