UNLIMITED - NO LIMIT OF DOGS ENTERED

As the trial is unlimited, unlike other years that had limits that did not fill, no pending entries will be accepted nor will the closing dates be extended.

Entry Information

Entry Method - First Received with an Opening Date: January 15, 2025, 12pm Eastern Time (ET)

- Entries may be received at any time on or after the opening date and time.
- Entries received before the opening date will be destroyed.

 Hand deliveries to the PO BOX only, due no later than the day before the closing date.
- Note: Overnight envelopes must have the recipient's signature waiver signed or the envelope may be refused
 or delayed.

If your dog cannot be entered through my dog entry due to a potential eligibility issue, email: nationals@cpe.dog. See your online member services nationals page for eligibility updates.

Entries will be accepted until March 5, 2025, 6pm Eastern Time (ET)

- Between March 5 April 2 (closing date), 2025, no entries will be accepted
- During this time, only the following changes will be allowable
 - Height Category changes if the dog is eligible for the new category
 - Jump Height regular height category only
 - Adding or removing a Jr Handler or Handicapped Handler
 - Do not send level changes until the move up/down dates below

Final Closing Date - Note the early Closing Date will be April 2, 2025, 6pm Eastern Time (ET)

- Checks deposited as early as February 1, 2025 / online entry fees will be charged upon an accepted entry for Agility & SpeedWay as they are unlimited. CSS online entry fees will be charged when your entry is accepted from the trial not filling, or from the random draw if needed.
- There will NO REFUNDS of Entries withdrawn after April 2, 2025

Move Up/Down

Level changes only will be accepted between April 9-16, 2025, by emailing nationals@cpe.dog must be received by April 16, 6PM Eastern Time (ET)

Please only Include: AG, CPE ID for the dog, dog's call name, class(es) and level to change to Entry Mailing

- Emails regarding status of entry will not be answered if received before February 15, 2025.
- If you wish to have delivery verification for your entry, be sure to use e-confirmation with the post office and waive any signature requirements or the delivery of your entry will be delayed. Do not send by certified mail!
- Receipt of delivery will not be verified before first confirmations are sent.
- Limit of entries per envelope: six (6) Dogs per event, if entered in multiple events, they can be included in one envelope with up to 6 dogs total amongst the entries. Note: The exception will be no limit if all dogs in the same envelope have the same 5 digit CPE membership number.

Emails regarding the trial, entries or move ups – only send to nationals@cpe.dog CPE is not responsible for mail or emails that are not received

An entry will not be accepted for the following reasons:

- Entries received prior to the mail in date will be destroyed without notice.
- An illegible or incomplete entry, unsigned/altered/incorrect year on check, ineligible dogs.
- More than six (6) dog entries in one (1) envelope with different CPE ID numbers, per event.
- If the fees are not in US dollars.

An entry will be delayed or not delivered for the following reasons:

- Using any method other than Postal Mail or MyDogEntry
- The required signature on Express mail is NOT waived. UPS and FEDEX will not deliver to a PO Box.
- If you have questions for My Dog Entry, see the contact info on page 1. CPE cannot help with those questions.

- CPE is not responsible for lost mail or emails that were not delivered. All emails received will get a response.
- Check your National confirmations carefully. Changes and corrections will NOT be made at the event regardless of who made the error. Ensure all entry information and move ups are correct.
- **NOTE:** Contact CPE at **nationals@cpe.dog** if you do not receive a confirmation by February 20, 2025. A move up confirmation is sent for each agility or CSS move up when processed during the move up dates on page 1.
- Early check in on Thursday will be listed in the final confirmation letter along with the check in times for each day dependent upon the number of entries received.

Nationals Information

The following classes will be offered each day: One Standard/One Fault Game/One Point Game.

Trophies and Awards

- Medals will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each height category (Regular and Veterans placements are combined per CPE placement rules), jump height and level in each class.
- Qualifying rosettes will be awarded to each dog earning a Qualifying score in any class.
- High in Trial Trophies: Regular/Veterans/Enthusiast/Specialist/Jr Handler
- High in Standard Classes and High Reserve in Standard classes in each height category and jump height within each level.
- Games Trophies for each height category in each jump height in the six (6) Games combined during the event. Four
 (4) trophies per height category in each jump height will be awarded depending on the number of entries in that height category and jump height.
- Each dog that earns a perfect 200 score (all 9 classes earned a qualifying run with zero faults), will receive a plaque direct shipped by CPE after the event.
- Swiftpaws will sponsor a Versatility award for the dog that participates in all three (3) events.

Sponsored High in Trial Trophies

Sponsored awards are not CPE sponsored. The sponsor will determine the recipient and present their sponsored award at the awards ceremony Sunday evening.

- Any CPE club/member wishing to sponsor an award must contact CPE, nationals@cpe.dog, between March 20-27, 2025. The award wording must be approved prior to the sponsorship being accepted. Limited to one (1) award per CPE member ID or CPE Host Club. The club/member is responsible for supplying the award and must be present to give the award to the recipient at the awards ceremony on Sunday evening.
- The sponsored awards will be listed with the emailed national catalog, so exhibitors know what sponsored awards are
 offered.
- The award cannot be a wooden wall plaque. Most awards are usually no more than \$50 in value. The award cannot exceed \$100 total in value (cash awards are not allowed, gift certificates are).
- The award can have "CPE," "Nationals" or "National Event" on the award, the dates of the event, city, and state and High In Trial.
- The award cannot duplicate a trophy awarded by CPE.
- Individuals cannot win their own sponsored award if eligible. The award would go to the next eligible dog.
- There must be at least five (5) dogs or handlers entered for each respective sponsored trophy to be accepted and awarded.
- Awards can only be High In Trial and must be able to be determined by a team's cumulative score, not by an
 individual class, score, vote, or personal determination, unless approved by CPE.
- All sponsored awards must have a signup sheet at the event and is the responsibility of the sponsor. Contact CPE for a sample signup sheet format. The sponsor must determine the award recipient. Competitors are responsible for

recording the scores on any award their dog is signed up for. If scores are blank, then those class(es) will not be counted regardless of the dog's score.

Other Show Information

ALL competitors are responsible for the information listed in the following.

- This event will be run under the CPE Rules and Regulations in effect at the time of the trial.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, competitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Obstacles must meet the specifications for obstacles under the current rules of CPE.
- Dogs may wear flat buckle collars without any hanging tags attached to the collar, nothing attached to the collars and no bling. Puppies under 8 weeks old are not allowed at a CPE trial. Selling of puppies at the show site is not allowed.
- Help keep the hotels for future trials! Clean up after the dogs. NO dogs are to be left in the room by themselves at any time! Bring sheets to cover sofas/chairs and bedspreads.
- See the CPE website for more local Information: www.cpe.dog/nationals/ (i.e., Hotels, indoor crating space, camping, photographers, vendor list, other onsite events, and banquet forms). Forms and information will be added/updated as known
- Veterinarian and Hospital info will be included in future Nationals notifications and/or be available at the site.
- Competitors/handlers who are under 18 years old must be accompanied at the event by their parent or legal guardian, regardless of if they are signed up as a Jr Handler or not.

Team or State Shirts

The shirt can have "CPE", "Nationals" or "National Event", the dates of the event, city, and state.

Nationals Shirts

Shirts are ordered through Beauty Of The Beasts and can be picked up from their booth at Nationals or arrangements can be made with them to have them shipped to your home.

Show Site Information

- All Competitors are responsible for this information. Dogs MUST be on leash with the leash in the handler's hand (or picked up) at all times during the show each day from Tuesday set-up through Thursday's trophy presentation and tear down, when not in their crates/ex-pens/vehicle.
- **Note:** Exception is when dogs are in the warmup areas, or in your immediate camping area if camping, after the show each day and must be under direct handler supervision.
- Dogs must be on leash with it in the handler's hand (or dog picked up) when entering the ring and before leaving the ring out-gate chutes.
- Site buildings and grounds are smoke free. Smoking is NOT allowed in any building or on the grounds.
- No campfires at any campsites.
- All exhibitors are expected to pick up after themselves and their dogs and deposit it in the provided trash barrels or you
 will be excused from the event. If a competitor is excused from the event, refunds will not be provided.
- It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any competitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site without a refund of fees.

Refund Policy

- There will be a \$25 administration fee per each dog's entry for refunds requested prior to the closing date.
- Once a request has been processed to pull a dog from Nationals, the request cannot be reversed regardless of the date or reason.
- Refund checks will be sent by April 14, 2025, for refunds received by the closing date, by late May for all other refunds.
- No refund for bitches in season after the closing date.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog or handler is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of CPE, the show committee, or a Judge.
- Entry fee will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Returned check fee of \$30 will be charged for all entries received for the member and will be on hold until restitution is
 made by a US funds Money Order, bank check or certified check. Restitution must be received within 7 days of
 notification from CPE, or all entries are cancelled for that member. If the entries are cancelled, the returned check fee
 of \$30 will still be outstanding; if not paid within the 7 days, the CPE membership will be inactivated until the fee is paid.

- Dogs that are injured after the closing date will be eligible for a refund of 50% of the entry fees upon receipt of a veterinarian's letter on their office letterhead. Notification by email by May 1, 2025, or at the site by May 17, 2025. Letters received after these dates will not be accepted and will not result in a refund.
- In the unfortunate circumstance of the death of a beloved dog who is entered in the trial: a full refund of that dog's entry fee will be issued, even if after the closing date. Notification by email or at the site by May 17, 2025.

I/we agree that the Host Club holding the Agility Trial has the right to refuse entry for cause which the Host Club, in its sole judgment, shall deem to be sufficient. Upon acceptance of this entry, I/we agree to hold (a) Canine Performance Events, Inc., (b) this Host Club, (c) the owner or lessee of the premises, (d) any sponsors of this event, and each of their members, directors, officers, agents, show secretary, show chairperson, show committee and employees harmless from any claim or loss or injury or expenses (including attorney fees) which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing arising out of or in consequence of my/our participation in the Agility Trial or the act of my/our dog, howsoever such injuries or damage may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons. - I/we understand no entry corrections will be made at the event regardless of who caused the error. Competitors must verify their entry information from the club's confirmation and report any entry discrepancies to CPE before the closing date of the trial.
- I/we understand that no changes to trial results will be made once the trial has been completed. Competitors are responsible for reporting any discrepancies of posted results (scribe sheet copies or labels are not official, only printed posted results are official) prior to leaving the trial site each day; this also includes if there was a correction to a scribe sheet. The competitor must verify that the results were corrected as well.
- I/we agree to abide by the rules of CPE currently in effect at the time of the trial date and all terms and conditions pertaining to this Event. By signing below, I/we agree to the disclaimer and indemnity obligations on this entry form.
- I/we testify that the dog entered is healthy and vaccinated or titered. I/we certify that the dog entered is not dangerous to any person or other dog.
