



Thank you for entering our Takes 2 to Q June Speedway trial at AgileDogs @ JAZZ.

ATTENTION: Please be advised that we are delaying the start time by one (1) hour. Please do not arrive on the property before 8:00 AM.

We still have runs available if you wish to add some or if you know anyone who would like to join us. If you are already entered in the trial, we don't charge the additional fee for Day of Show (DOS), you just pay the regular run fee which is \$13/run. DOS entries will be accepted between 8:00 AM and 8:30 AM. Once DOS entries have been finalized, the general briefing will follow and then first walk through. No additional entries will be taken after the first class begins, which will be no earlier than 8:45 AM.

This is a very small trial so those of you running multiple dogs don't have many dogs in between. Please don't worry, we will not be rushing you.

General site rules:

This is a private residence – please be respectful and do not walk your dogs near/around the house or fenced in pool area behind the house. If we find anyone in the fenced in area by the house or pool they will be excused from the trial and no refund given. Please maintain a 10-foot distance from the ring fencing with your dog. We have zero tolerance for dogs peeing on the fence posts when being walked to the ring. Dogs should not be walked along the sides of the ring. There are many other places to walk your dog on the property. Clean up after your dogs - please!

Parking may be tight at the site; there should be plenty of shady areas that are not far from the ring. There is no parking in the area of the agility ring except for committee members. Handicap parking is along the building. Please do not block the double gates. There is no crating of dogs in the training building. You may leave your chairs and crates in the building overnight if you wish.

To keep the trial moving and also because of space limitations, we ask that videos and photographs be taken from outside the ring. There are many great spots for videos and of course you are welcome to take photos in the ring with your dog during course builds and walk throughs. If you need assistance, please ask us.

Trash cans – will be in several locations throughout the site. There will be one blue recycle trash can, please only put recycle cans, bottles, paper and plastic in this can. Scores will be available in the training building. Please do not bring your dog with you to check scores. I know this is a lot



of rules. We want everyone to be safe. and we also want EVERYONE TO HAVE FUN and to enjoy our trial and AgileDogs at JAZZ!

My Dog Entry:

In preparation for using "My Dog Entry" (MDE) for our future trials, we will be using it for this trial as much as possible. Since this is our first time using the program, we appreciate your patience with us as we learn on the fly.

I have entered your paper entries for this trial into the system so you should already be able to find your account.

Course maps will be available through MDE at 3:00 PM the evening before the trial. One copy will be posted in the training building. You may print your own hardcopy from MDE.

Lite snacks and water will be available for our volunteers. Please plan to bring your own lunch and of course treats and water for your teammate.

Final Confirmation:

Run Order:

Pitstop: 3 rounds*

Slingshot: 3 rounds*

Pole Position: 3 rounds*

* Rounds 1 & 2 are the same course and may be run back-to-back if desired. Back-to-back must be declared to the Gate Steward and Scribe/Timer prior to the 1st round.
