NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

*The safety of the dogs is the primary concern so by entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

***Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing unless circumstances warranted are approved by the trial chair. However, up to a 50% refund of entry fees may be given for injuries to dogs or handlers, or bitches in season, if the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary ON OR BEFORE the moveup deadline. The request MUST be in writing and MUST be accompanied by a dated letter from your Veterinarian (or Doctor, if the injury is to the handler) on your Veterinarian's (or Doctor's) letterhead with a brief description explaining the reason the dog, or the handler, cannot compete. Also, no entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.**

Returned checks for any reason will incur a charge of \$30 plus bank charges. These are defined as ANY check that does not clear our bank the first and second time it is deposited. *All entry fees will be deposited promptly following the closing date. Please plan accordingly. Overpayments of entry fees will not be refunded. Please check your math carefully!

The deadline for withdraw is "move-up date" (ie Monday before the trial) which we should probably note the actual date rather than "moveup date since there isn't one in SW. Although the withdraw date is Monday before the trial, the required paperwork receipt deadline is the last day of trial as we complete the trial and close the books and assure they are on the refund list for the Treasurer to send checks to after the trial.

From the North: Take I-95 to Pittsfield, ME then take exit 150 towards Pittsfield. Turn left onto Somerset Ave. drive 0.1 Miles. Turn right onto Industrial Park St. drive 0.5 Miles. Turn left to stay on Industrial Park St. drive 0.3 Miles. Turn right onto Stinson St. drive 0.3 Miles. Turn right onto Main St / ME-100 drive 6.5 Miles. Turn right onto Johnson Flat Rd (Right side after Pride Manufacturing) Drive 3.4 Miles to 622 Johnson Flat Rd, event will be on the left.

From the South: Take I-95 to Clinton then take exit 138 towards Clinton. Turn right onto Hinkley Rd. drive 1.1 Miles turn left onto Main St / ME-100 drive 0.1 Miles.
