Schedule of Events:

- Run Events

- The following will be the run order for Saturday. Each round will be split into 2 heats to allow folks to volunteer.
 - Drag Race 50 yards Rounds 1, 2, 3
 - Drag Race 100 yards Rounds 1, 2

Drag Race Reminders

Your run will be an NQ if any of the following occurs:

- Toy or food on course.
 - Food cannot be visible during the run **until the dog crosses the finish line**.
 - A toy does NOT have to be out of sight during the run. It can be thrown into the **finish** area before the dog crosses the finish line. If the toy is dangled within or thrown into the 50 or 100 yd run area, or the dog grabs their toy and trots themselves back past the finish eyes, it's an NQ.
- Dog leaving the course before crossing the finish line.
- Dog eliminates on the course then the dog is excused.
- The Person Catching the dog steps over the finish line into the running area to entice the dog before the dog crosses the finish line. The handler in the finish/catch area may use a recall while the dog is chasing the

lure as an incentive without crossing the finish line into the running area to physically assist the dog or may toss a toy into the finish/catch area.

General Information:

- Weather: This event will be held rain or shine. If rain is in the forecast, please remember to bring extra socks/shoes \bigcirc Cross your paws for nice weather!
- **Parking:** There will be a sign at the entrance. Please be aware to not park where your dogs have a direct visual of the course (e.g. directly behind the starting area of the course).
- For You:
 - There will be bottled water available at this trial.
 - There will not be a food vendor at this trial. Please bring your own snacks/lunch.
 - $\circ~$ It is suggested to wear closed toed shoes.
- For Your Dog:
 - Please bring water for your dog.
 - Please bring 2 leashes One to be worn at the entrance gate and one for leashing up at the exit gate.
 - There will be room for you to crate your dogs under your EZ up.
 - Be sure to clean up after your dog. Buckets with liners will be available for your disposal.
 - Dogs must be on leash at all times when not running the course.
 - Bait and toys must be at least ten feet from the ring.
