### General Trial Information:

- **Snacks:** We will have prepackaged snacks available at this trial. The snacks are free to Volunteers and by donation for others.
- **Food:** We will not be ordering in food at this trial. Please plan to bring your own lunch. Please sign up for our [Saturday Night Potluck](#) with Judge Judy Raffone.
- **Water:** To “go green” and use less plastic, EMAC will NOT provide bottled water at this trial. A water cooler will be provided so that you can fill your own water bottle, so BYOWB!
- **Photo Op:** Lori is providing us with a “Fall Harvest” themed photo op! Take a picture with your pups!
- **Donuts on a String:** Join the donut duel and see who can conquer the dangling treat, hands-free!

- All exhibitors must pick up after their dogs in all areas of the campground. Please use the trash cans for dog pick-up.
- **Campground:** If you are camping or staying in a cabin at Hadley’s Point Campground, please make sure you check with the staff for the time you need to be off the campsite, or out of the cabin. The campground does have required check-out times. Remember, they have other guests coming in on Sunday.
