### PRIZES and AWARDS

Qualifying ribbons will be rewarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score and the AKC will mail you an official Title Certificate. All ribbons must be claimed the day of the trial; none will be mailed.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A fee of \$25 will be charged for all returned checks. Repeated returned checks will result in the exhibitor being placed on a cash basis for payment of entry fees in the future.

ACT Level 1J is open to dogs that have not earned any AKC agility titles. These are entry level Jumpers courses (Jumps and Tunnels). Level 1 courses have 10-12 obstacles. Time for all jump heights is 50 seconds with a minimum score of 85 to Qualify. Two Qualifying runs earn the title: ACT 1J

ACT Level 2J is open to dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC agility class except for an ACT 1J title. Level 2J courses have 11-13 obstacles, including 6 weave poles. Time for all jump heights is 60 seconds with a minimum score of 85 to Qualify. Two Qualifying runs earn the title: ACT 2J.

Refusals and Run-outs are not judged. More than 3 attempts at an obstacle will result in an elimination (failure). The rest of the faults are the same as in the regular agility classes.

Dogs run with a flat buckle collar, no tags, or with no collar.

All Qualifying scores can be under the same Evaluator. Only one dog in the ring at a time. Dogs may be entered at any of the following jump height divisions: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24 inches, Handler's Choice. A jump height card is not required. Dogs do not need to be measured.

**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:** ACT trials are open to all dogs 15 months of age or older, that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have obtained AKC ILP, PAL, or AKC Canine Partners listing numbers, or are approved FSS breeds. Dogs with a PAL/IILP or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to participate.

### SHOW SITE INFORMATION

There are plenty of parking spaces on the grounds as well as grassy area for walking. Shade is limited. No Flexi leads allowed.

The show site is indoors on artificial turf footing. We will have limited indoor crating space, available on a "first come first serve" basis. If our crating space fills, you must work out of your vehicle. Please bring your own clean up supplies & water for your dog.

X-pens are NOT permitted at the show site. Dogs must be kept on leash when not in the ring.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Please NO SPIKE SHOES OR HEELS on the turf. Please wear/use clean, athletic footwear to preserve the flooring!

From the NORTH: Travel South on I-87 and take Exit 16 onto Ballard Road toward Gansevoort/ Wilton. Continue on Ballard Rd. Drive to NY-50 N in Northumberland (4miles). At the stop light Turn left onto NY-50. The Follow the Leda Training Center will be on your RIGHT in approx. 4 miles. It is a tan building with fencing around it. Park only on the left hand side, or in the rear lot. Do not park in front of the WuffDorf Astora grooming salon.

From the SOUTH: Travel North on I-87 and take Exit 15 into Rt. 50 toward Saratoga Springs. Follow Rt. 50 North approx. 9 miles. The Follow the Leda Training Center will be on your RIGHT. It is a tan building with fencing around it. Park only on the left hand side, or in the rear lot. Do not park in front of the WuffDorf Astora grooming salon.

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure that their dogs are free of internal/external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- All dogs MUST be on leash, crated, securely penned, or otherwise under physical control at all times when not competing.
- Pinch collars, electric and dummy electric collars, and special training collars are prohibited on the trial grounds.
- No dogs under the age of four (4) months are allowed on the trial site.
- All handlers must pick up after their dogs. Anyone witnessed not doing so will be requested to leave and no refund will be made of any fees paid.
- Follow the Leda Dog Training assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any child not under the control of his or her parents or guardians.
- Follow the Leda Dog Training does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund will be made of any fees paid.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the evaluator or event committee.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed because of riot, civil disturbance, fire, or an act of God, emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Event Committee.
- Bitches in season and ill or injured dogs are not eligible to compete. Such
  dogs may be withdrawn after closing and no later than one-half hour prior
  to the start of the first class of the day of the trial, and entry fees (less
  direct costs of \$5 per) will be returned.

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. in consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations published for this event and any decision made in accord with them and further agree to be bound by this Agreement. I (we) agree that the club or ACT Evaluator, holding this event has the right to retuse this entry for cause which the club or ACT Evaluator shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs, in consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge or ACT Evaluator, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog white in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and ilability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. ### INSTRUCTIONS

Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. AKC Canine Partners<sup>301</sup> applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners or program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
