

Takes 2 to Q CPE Agility Trial Dec. 13-14, 2025

Hello Exhibitors!

Thank you for entering the December 2025 CPE Agility Trial hosted by Takes 2 to Q Agility Club. This is your confirmation letter. At this time, we have a total of 79 dogs entered for 222 runs on Saturday and 178 runs on Sunday. We will all do our best to move the trial along efficiently while making sure everyone has a safe and successful run and gets their time in the ring. Walk throughs will be timed at 10 minutes; split walkthroughs for Jackpot and FullHouse will be Walk-Walk, Run-Run, 5 minutes each group. The first five (5) dogs need to be lined up and ready to run immediately after walk through time has expired. If we need to split walkthroughs for other classes, announcements will be made prior to the walkthroughs.

My Dog Entry (MDE): We will be using MDE for check-in, gating, trial documentation, course map delivery, and run results. The gate steward will have a tablet to check off the dogs as they run, which will update the real-time run order you can access on your phone. Paper gate sheets will be informational only and not used to check off dogs.

Volunteer Workers: We are counting on our volunteers (thank you so much!) to help make the weekend go smoothly. Please sign up at the link provided below to help out. Please sign up for your favorite jobs and click in an empty cell to save your input. If you cannot access the google doc, please try the link in MDE. You may also sign up at the trial. Volunteers will be able to take two (2) tickets for our worker's raffle for each class worked. Raffle prizes consist of monetary awards that will be applied to your MDE account, to be used for a future T2TQ trial. You will receive an email when the award has been applied to your account.

Site Details: There are a few rules to follow at Working Dogs. Please walk your dogs only in areas to the right of the parking lot and pick up all dog waste and human trash. Please read the facility rules posted in MDE regarding separate shoes for running on the turf and the cleanup fee for dogs soiling in the ring.

Awards and Ribbons: T2TQ offers the following awards and ribbons:

- Q and 1st – 4th place ribbons (self serve)
- Perfect weekend rosettes will be awarded to teams achieving Qs in all 8 runs.
- Ribbons for each new title earned; please write your titles earned on the sheet provided and a ribbon will be customized for you. Please let us know if you might earn a C-ATCH or C-ATE so we can celebrate with you.
- 51 point Snooker pins

Check In, Measuring and Start Times:

Friday: T2TQ trial set-up; there will be no run-thrus, check in, measuring or space set-up.

Saturday: Grounds and building will be open for setup at 7:00 am;

Measuring at 7:15 AM followed by a quick general briefing and walk throughs then 1st dog on the line @ approximately 7:45 AM.

Sunday: Grounds and building will be open for setup at 7:00 am;

Measuring at 7:15 AM followed by a quick general briefing and walk throughs then 1st dog on the line @ approximately 7:45 AM.

Catalogs: Please bring your own printed copy of the run order catalog. The catalog will be posted in MDE along with the real-time run order.

Course Maps: Course maps will be released at 3 PM the day before each trial day in MDE

Move Ups: During the trial, move-ups will be taken for Standard and must be submitted to the Show Secretary as soon as results have been posted on Saturday. A sheet will be available for you to record your move-ups, located at the scoring area. Thank you for your cooperation.

Food and Beverage: T2TQ will provide lite snacks and beverages for workers. We don't have a food vendor so please bring your own lunch or patronize some of our local establishments.

Rules: It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to be familiar with CPE Rules, documented in the most recent rulebook and member letter, located at the CPE website (www.CPE.dog). Please also remember that

scores cannot be changed once the judge, trial secretary, and/or handler have left the trial site each trial day. We will have a monitor set up for real-time results so please check your scores quickly and carefully throughout the day. If you have a question about your score, please see Dottie Piroha.

Directions to the Trial Site: *If using GPS, enter the street address not the name of the facility or you will be directed to a different location.*

From NYS Thruway Exit 27 - Amsterdam

At end of ramp, turn right onto Route 30 North. Take immediate right onto ramp for State Highway 5S.

Turn left onto State Highway 5S West. Follow .4 miles and turn left on Verbraska Avenue (just past Stewarts).

Working Dogs NY is on the left.
