NOTE:

***Sunday:** Advanced Buried and Advanced Container will begin 15 minutes after **Novice Buried & Container**. Dogs will run Novice Buried T-1 and move directly to Novice Container 1. This will permit people time to "move up" to the Advanced Level should they title. Once Trial 1 is completed, dogs will run Trial 2 Novice Buried followed by Novice Container.

CHECK-IN AND BRIEFINGS: Due to the changes and expected high temperatures, we will be opening the facility and starting the trial earlier than listed in the premium.

- The building will be open at 7:15 a.m. for exhibitors to set-up.
- Check-in begins at 7:30 am. Pick up your envelop with your numbers; you will have numbers for each day you are entered.
- Daily briefings will be held at 8:15, followed by Judges' briefings. Our goal is to begin judging by 8:30. If your plans do not permit you to be present until 9:00, we understand – we have plenty of dogs running so you will get your run “in” with a briefing “at the line.”

CRATING

- Will be available indoors in the agility area. We have doubled the crate area since the April trials.
- Crate in the area designated “EXHIBITORS”.
- NO X-Pens.
- For SAFETY reasons, your dog should be crated, not sitting or lying near the crate or your chair.
- You may leave your items, such as crates, chairs, etc. in the building overnight at your own risk.

EXCESSIVE BARKING

- If your dog barks excessively when you are not present, please crate from your vehicle.
- When crating from your vehicle or your RV, if your dog(s) are going to bark as people or dogs pass by, please be considerate of those walking past your vehicles and park further away.

NO EXTENSION leashes, nor pinch collars, inside the building.

POTTY AREAS and ACCIDENTS

- Exterior runs for novice and advance levels will be on concrete if possible.
- **DO NOT let your dog pee on the outside** of the building or the shrubs around the building. The building and areas around the building may be used as part of a search area.
- IF your dog urinates on any items in the test area, you will be charged for the replacement cost of the item(s).
- If you dog urinates or messes on the turf, there will be a \$20 fee.

PARKING - Please do not park in the front of the building. We will be using the area for searches.



RUN ORDER

- The gate steward will call the next dog by name or number. There will be chairs for you to sit after you are called. If you have an issue or a conflict please discuss with the Gate Steward.
- We know almost ALL exhibitors will have conflicts. With three classes being judged simultaneously, there will be a lot of conflicts. **Don't worry; you will get your run.**

MOVE UPS: If your dog titles during T1 and you want to “move up” to the next level, **let the judge know you will be moving up.** Immediately complete a Move Up form at the Trial Secretary's desk. If you move up from Advanced to Excellent, there will be a fee increase.

TRIALORDER

- **Friday and Saturday:** Trials 1 and 2 will be running concurrently both days, meaning you will go from T1 to T2, if you wish.
- If you would like a break between trials 1 and 2, let the gate steward know **AFTER** the judges' briefing.
- **Sunday: Dogs running Novice Container & Buried** will run Novice Buried T-1 and then move directly to Novice Container 1. This will permit people time to "move up" to the Advanced Level. Once Trial 1 is completed, we will re-set the equipment and run Trial 2 Novice Buried followed by Novice Container.
- This will be covered in more detail at the briefing.
- If you have questions, please see a volunteer or Cathie, the trial chair. Please don't panic – you will get your runs.

BREAKS

- There will be short breaks between classes while the judges place odor and take a break.
- There will be a 30-minute lunch break for judges and volunteers. There is no predetermined time for lunch, it will be as "time permits."

FAST FOOD RESTAURANTS: There are multiple fast food restaurants just five minutes driving time.

- Make a right out of Bratty Paws onto Taylor Road.
- At the signal light is a Wawa gas station.
- At the light, turn left for McDonalds, Arby's, Culver's, Burger King and Wendy's.
