DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED BOTH DAYS. Price is \$16/run. If you want to add runs or know anyone who didn't get signed up prior to closing, have them see the trial secretary prior to the walk thru for the run to be entered.

INFORMATION FOR TRIAL

BUILDING: The building will be open at 7:00 a.m. **First dog will be on the line at 8:00 a.m. both days.** We will do walk throughs at least 15 minutes before the first dog is on the line – please be ready to go.

INDOOR CRATING: Please be courteous. There is plenty of room. Bring chairs, crates, and bring and use a tarp/blanket/mat under your kennel. Other than treats for your dogs, please no food or drink

other than water on the turf.

DOG Measurements: There will be a list of all dogs CPE says need to be measured. If your dog needs to be measured, it must be done before their first run of the weekend. See the Trial Secretary if you're not sure.

WALK THROUGHS: Walk throughs will be limited to 5 minutes. If a split is necessary, there will be NO 5 minutes in between the walk and first dog on the line. To keep the trial moving, please pay attention and be ready to go when it's your turn. We will be using My Dog Entry (MDE) for check in and gate stewarding. Your confirmation contains the link. Click on icons across the top to check in and to view the run order.

BRIEFING AND COURSE MAPS: Judge's briefing will occur before we start each day and course maps will be available the night before each trial day on MDE. Maps will also be posted at the trial site. There will not be printed copies available at the trial.

RESULTS: Results and stickers will be available. Please do not crowd the results table. Results will also be posted to your MDE account after each class is processed. Double click your results to see the entire class results.

MOVE UPS: are available. Please notify Jeannine Beer regarding any move ups before you leave Saturday.

RIBBONS: Will be self served – however please maintain social distancing when obtaining your ribbons. Also notify us if you will be earning a C-ATCH or C-ATE.

FOOD: We will be doing a potluck for lunch each day. CDC will provide the main dishes of chicken on Saturday and pizza on Sunday. Please feel free to bring sides, condiments, rolls, desserts etc to supplement the main dish.
