

Run Wild, CPE and Paw-cific Agility Rules:

Please read and familiarize yourself with these rules before you arrive!

*The Speed limit on the property is FIVE (5) mph! Do not park on any grass area outside of the big field. The speed limit in the big field is also FIVE (5) mph. If you are caught speeding you could be asked to leave.

*Do not let your dog pee on anything man-made! Dogs should only potty in appropriate areas. Pick up your dog's poop! Find poop, pick it up, all day long you'll have good luck!

*If you are using a ground cover in your tent space at the outdoor competition field, you MUST pick it up nightly. It cannot stay on the ground overnight.

*If you bring a popup canopy, you must stake it down appropriately. We can have impromptu gusts of wind. Weights and stakes are highly recommended.

*If your dog eliminates on the turf, there is a \$25 fee payable directly to Run Wild Dog Sports. There are QR codes located on the walls inside the main arena for ease of payment. Otherwise there is a drop box to deposit a check along the wall inside the main arena. PLEASE potty your dog before your run.

*No Dogs Allowed in the Hospitality, Check-In, Raffle or Ribbon Room!

*No dogs off leash unless you are in one of the off leash paddocks. There are 4 paddocks for off leash play! Exception: the warm up jump.

*No dog treats, human food or drink within 10 feet of the ring. Water (only) is allowed for our ring crew. There will be a left-over treat bucket available by the Gate Steward. All food and drinks should be covered to discourage flies and bees.

*Dogs come into the ring on leash and leave the ring on leash, even if you are carrying them. Stay connected with your dog and always know where your dog's head is and what he/she is looking at. Do not let your dog interact with other dogs and do not approach another handler's dog without the permission of that dog's handler. This is for your safety as well as your dogs.

*If your dog needs space, BE POLITE and let others know. We have caution tape available at check-in if you would like to tie a piece onto your dog's leash.

*No dogs within 15 feet of the ring unless you are waiting your turn to run. The ONLY dogs that should be close to the ring are those that are lined up waiting to run.

*There is NO crating inside the arena! No exceptions! There is also no crating along the walls outside of the arena. We will have a couple of canopies set up outside to use as a staging area for those that are running multiple dogs. You may put crates under these canopies to use but once your runs are done, you MUST remove your crate(s) so that others with multiple dogs can use this space. Please mark your crate(s) with your name and Group Number. Please also bring a crate cover if your dog is likely to bark at other dogs/people while waiting in the crate. This is for the consideration of others that need to wait near your dog.
