- Please bring multiple dogs to the ring whenever possible – dog holders can be found at ringside if your dog is ok to be held by someone else and with other dogs around. If you hold a dog for someone, please keep enough distance from other dogs.
- The next rotation will not begin until all dogs in a rotation have been accounted for (run or absent). Exception: rotations 7 8 9 each day do not have to wait – IF there are enough volunteers to start. Please listen for announcements and/or check the online run order.

Running Order:

- See the Section Set Order page for the classes in each ring each day and the rotation order for your rotation
- Posted running order Friday & Sunday, reverse running order on Saturday - see the posted gate sheets or the online run order (run orders also included in your check in envelope, subject to gate changes during the show for multiple dogs needing to move). Small to tall jump heights Friday & Sunday, Tall to small jump heights Saturday.

Other Notes:

- Due to accommodating key workers and the spread of handlers with multiple dogs in different jump heights, there are a few groups that have less dogs in a jump height than is preferred. Please work with your gate steward if needed, jumps and the timer may need to be set a second time for a height.
- Multiple dog handlers may need to work with the gate steward to move a dog depending on the order of jump height and the spacing between dogs that day. Handler with one dog should only be moving if the gate steward asks due to multiple dogs.
- **Sections with 12" & 16V=12" jump heights: 16V=12" dogs cannot move within the regular 12" dogs due to big dog vs small dog SCT**
- Conflicts will be handled if known, please work with your gate steward
