Please volunteer using the Volunteer Sign-up Sheet on site. We would appreciate course building & set-up help Friday morning at 7:00 AM. If you are helping to set-up, you can set-up your crate between 7:00 AM and 8:00AM on Friday. The building will be open to all at 8:00 AM Friday and 7:00 AM Saturday and Sunday.

Preliminary counts, running order, and judging program (contingent upon corrections/updates) were additional attachments in your confirmation email. IF needed, the walkthroughs may be limited 25 people. We will announce it at the briefings. If two or more walkthroughs are required there will **not** be a 5 minute count down. Classes with multiple walkthroughs will have back-to-back 8 minute walkthrough times with the first dog on the line when the last group is finished with the walkthrough. Move-ups: Please email or mail move-ups to trialsecretaryjbeer@gmail.com and please put "Agility Move-up" in the subject line of the email message. Move-ups for Friday will NOT be accepted after Monday, July 13th at 5pm Central Time. Move-ups for Saturday and Sunday will be accepted in person at the trial on the day before the trial in question. Please submit your move-ups as soon as possible.

Armbands and Measuring: Armbands will NOT be used for this trial.

IF YOUR DOG HAS NEVER BEEN OFFICIALLY MEASURED, IT MUST BE MEASURED BY THE JUDGE BEFORE YOUR FIRST RUN!

This change is effective August 1, 2022. If your dog is measured and your selected jump height in your confirmation does not match, please tell the secretary **BEFORE you run.**

Check-in and Course Maps: Maps will be available on the MyDogEntry (MDE) website at 12:01 each trial day and check in at 6am each morning.

MDE will be used for check in, course maps and by the gate steward. If you need help to check in, please ask the gate steward, a committee member or any competitor for help. A hard copy run order will be posted, but it is subject to change due to scratches and conflicts. Listen to the gate steward for your dog's name. Check in using MDE. Paper copies of course maps will also be posted at the trial site.

National Anthem: The trial will open with the singing of the first verse of National Anthem. The complete lyrics are at the end of this document.

Briefings: There will be briefings before the walkthroughs. Be sure to ask any questions at the briefing. **NOTE: FAST is one course with different bonus requirements by level and all levels run at the same time in jump height order. Listen to the briefing- you may be required to announce to the judge that you are running Open or Novice. Otherwise the judge will assume you are running the Excellent/Masters bonus.**

AKC Rule Changes: Be aware there are some changes to the rules regarding double bar jumps, the table & tire. Effective July 1, 2025 the AKC requires that the tire jump side straps **MUST** disengage from the frame holding the tire up should a dog choose to jump between the tire and the frame. Refer to the Agility AKC rulebook amended January 3, 2024.

Trial Site: Trial site will be open at 8 a.m. Friday and 7a.m. Saturday and Sunday. This trial will be held indoors on artificial turf. The site is air-conditioned. Crating is available on both the concrete floor and turf area, separated from the agility ring. Please maintain social distancing. No ex-pens will be permitted inside the building. Crate mats or tarps are required under crates. Please help keep aisles clear. Keep track of the run order status on

MDE and be available at the gate roughly 3-4 dogs before your run.

Bring chairs, crates, mats, and clean up tools. Please bring your own masks, pens/pencils, gloves & hand sanitizer if desired. Water is available on site. Dogs must be removed from the trial site daily upon completion of the trial. **All dogs must be on leash at all times when not in the ring or in the designated warm-up area. Please clean up after your dog(s)!**

Food: Packaged snacks, and hard and soft drinks can be purchased in the bar area. Water is available for all. We will have potluck for lunch. Main course provided by PVKC. Please bring summer salads, fresh fruit, desserts, etc. **Please eat and drink in the bar area. No food or beverages, except water, are allowed on the AstroTurf.**

Raffle: Several items are in the raffle including a \$75.00 Chewy gift card. See Pat Kaffenberger for tickets.

Lodging: Details are in the premium and MDE.

Leashes: Effective January 1, 2022 exhibitors may place leashes in their pockets or wear them when running the course. Leash must fully fit in a pocket if not being worn. This is a permanent regulation change. A leash runner will be provided.

PVKC's High in Trial Ribbons: PVKC plans to offer Special Ribbons as follows:

Friday – Best times for dog with qualifying runs in both FAST and T2B in all levels- Novice, Open, Excellent and Master.

Saturday – Best times for qualifying runs in Standard and Jumpers with Weaves for OPEN Dogs only!

Sunday – Best times for qualifying runs in Standard and Jumpers with Weaves for NOVICE

For all Double, Triple and Quadruple Q's earned in a day, there are Brag Tags, rosettes, key chains and ball chains. These can be displayed on your key ring, crate, ribbon display, etc.

Quint Q Coup Tournament:

Any dog entering all five eligible classes on any trial day is automatically entered into the tournament for the day. Any level combination for the five classes is acceptable. There is a special handmade award for the daily winner.

Prizes will be awarded for quintuple Q's earned by EVERY dog for the day. These will be \$25 vouchers for future entry to Platte Valley Kennel Club Trials and must be redeemed through mydogentry.com. Additional Voucher Prizes awarded DAILY as follows:

Fastest dog will receive..... \$100

Second fastest will receive..... \$50

Third fastest will receive..... \$25

In the event there are no quintuple Q's earned, quadruple Q's then triple Q's will be used.

Note: ISC scoring is faults, then time – this will be converted to Q for the tournament. If quadruple or triple Q's are used this ranking will break ties: NQ, FEO, E, ABS.

On the shore dimly seen through the mists of the deep
Where the foe's haughty host in dread silence reposes,
What is that which the breeze, o'er the towering steep,
As it fitfully blows, half conceals, half discloses?
Now it catches the gleam of the morning's first beam,
In full glory reflected now shines in the stream,
'Tis the star-spangled banner - O long may it wave
O'er the land of the free and the home of the brave!

And where is that band who so vauntingly swore,
That the havoc of war and the battle's confusion
A home and a Country should leave us no more?
Their blood has wash'd out their foul footsteps' pollution.
No refuge could save the hireling and slave
From the terror of flight or the gloom of the grave,
