Haute Dawgs "Cool Summer Morning" CPE Trial

Once again, it is July and I get to join Todd and provide some fun games for you to play this weekend with your dog, and to enjoy the day with your agility friends. I am happy to be here and share courses with you, hopefully you will find a course or two that appeals to you and your dog. Enjoy and have fun. This year we get to provide 2 DD classes.

On Saturday, I will have a Colors and Jumpers course for you to play on. On Sunday, I will have a DD Traditional Jackpot.

A few reminders for you:

Remember:

- Time starts when the dog crosses the plane of the first obstacle and ends when they take the last obstacle in the correct direction. Failure to finish the last obstacle will result in an NT.
- The club is permitting declared training in the ring at this trial. If you plan to use a toy, remember to show it to me before you run as I need to be sure that it is a permissible toy. Toys that are made to hold food cannot be used.
- Most of the class briefing info is on your maps. Feel free to ask me any questions you might have about anything. I will give a briefing before all the game classes.
- **Be ready to enter the ring when it is your turn. Check your course map to see when you should enter the ring also, please exit the ring quickly.**
- If at any time during your run you hear me say "thank you", that means your run is over.
- Keep your dog always leashed except in any designated off-leash areas. Be aware of your dog and aware of other dogs to prevent any problems.
- If there is any question about a call or score, please first see the score keeper and check your scribe sheet. The score keeper will ask me to clarify the information.
- **Most Important: Enjoy your time with your dog – stay cool and keep your dog cool.**
