

Hi Scent Sport Exhibitors,

Below are some reminders and some important bits of information for you about our event this weekend. Please read everything carefully since we have some very specific rules pertaining to this event.

1. If you are ill, please stay home. If GLOC deems an exhibitor ill at the event, it has the option to excuse that exhibitor.

2. The Secretary will be setup in the office in the Gayle Hatten Pavilion. Armband labels will not be used for this event. My Dog Entry (website mydogentry.com) will be used for this trial. If you have questions, see the trial secretary or check with anyone who also plays agility locally.

- You'll get the most out of MDE if you log into your account. An account was created either when you used the online entry function or when I entered your mailin entry in the system.

- Check in – on the day of the trial, there will be a box at the top of the labeled Check-in. If you are logged into your MDE account, there will be a box to check for each of your entries that day. If you are not logged in, you will need to click through the trials and then search for your dog. Times listed are estimated run times and are just estimates.

- Run Order – there will be a Run Order box at the top of the page. The trial will be listed by location, so click on Saunders County Fair Ground. Run times are estimated but they will update throughout the day. After a dog has run, the gate steward will click “just ran” and that dogs name will disappear. The list will then only show dogs who have not run yet for that class.

- Results – after scores for each class have been entered, the results will be uploaded to MDE. If you are logged in, you can click on Results box to see your results/placements from your phone. If an error is found in the results, those corrections will be uploaded. Full results will still be printed and final results will still be emailed out.

- If you have any questions or problems, please ask! Give MDE a chance.

3. The judge's briefing will take place outdoors at 7:45am with start time at 8:00a.m. Remember: if you need clarification about anything, ask the judge at the start line before you begin your run.

4. There will be walk-thrus to familiarize you with the building.

5. In your confirmation you have received the order of elements and classes. Classes are listed in the order they will be run. Please bring along a copy of your confirmation and the CSS guidelines either printed or on your phone.

6. Crating is out of your vehicle only; there is no indoor crating space at this venue.

7. There will be a public event in Gayle Hatten Pavilion and the 4 H building on Saturday only. Event runs from 9-

5. We are expecting the parking for their event to be around the pavilion and near the swine barn as well.

8. Videotaping will be allowed during all searches. Please do not ask a steward to video you. You must have your own designated person.

9. There will be no food available at this trial. There are multiple fast food restaurants with 1.5 miles of the trial site.

10. Dog potty area will be along 1st Street. Please pick up after your dog.

11. Results and ribbons will be on a table inside near the Secretary. There will not be an awards ceremony. Pick up your own ribbons.

12 Class Transfers: Tell the secretary about any transfers. Since we have multiple rounds each day, make sure you tell the secretary about your transfer immediately after your run. The secretary will record your transfer information.

13. If you have your CPE scent sport title sheets, remember to bring them along with you so you can keep track of how your dog does. This will help you with class transfers. If you don't already have one, we will have them available at the trial.

Route to Trial Location

From Lincoln: Via US 77N; 29 miles then turn right at the traffic light onto W 1st St. Travel 1.2 miles. Fairgrounds will be on your right.

From Omaha: I-80 W to I 680 N to US 6 W toward Boys Town. Continue to NE-28B Link and take the W Dodge Rd/US275E exit toward NE-92/Wahoo. Turn Left on US 275 E, continue onto NE-92 for 17 miles. Turn left onto Rd 16 St (flashing light intersection last time I went through it). Road will curve several times until 4-way stop. Turn left onto W 1st St. In approximately 1 miles, Fairgrounds will be on your right.
