Wildcard 35C

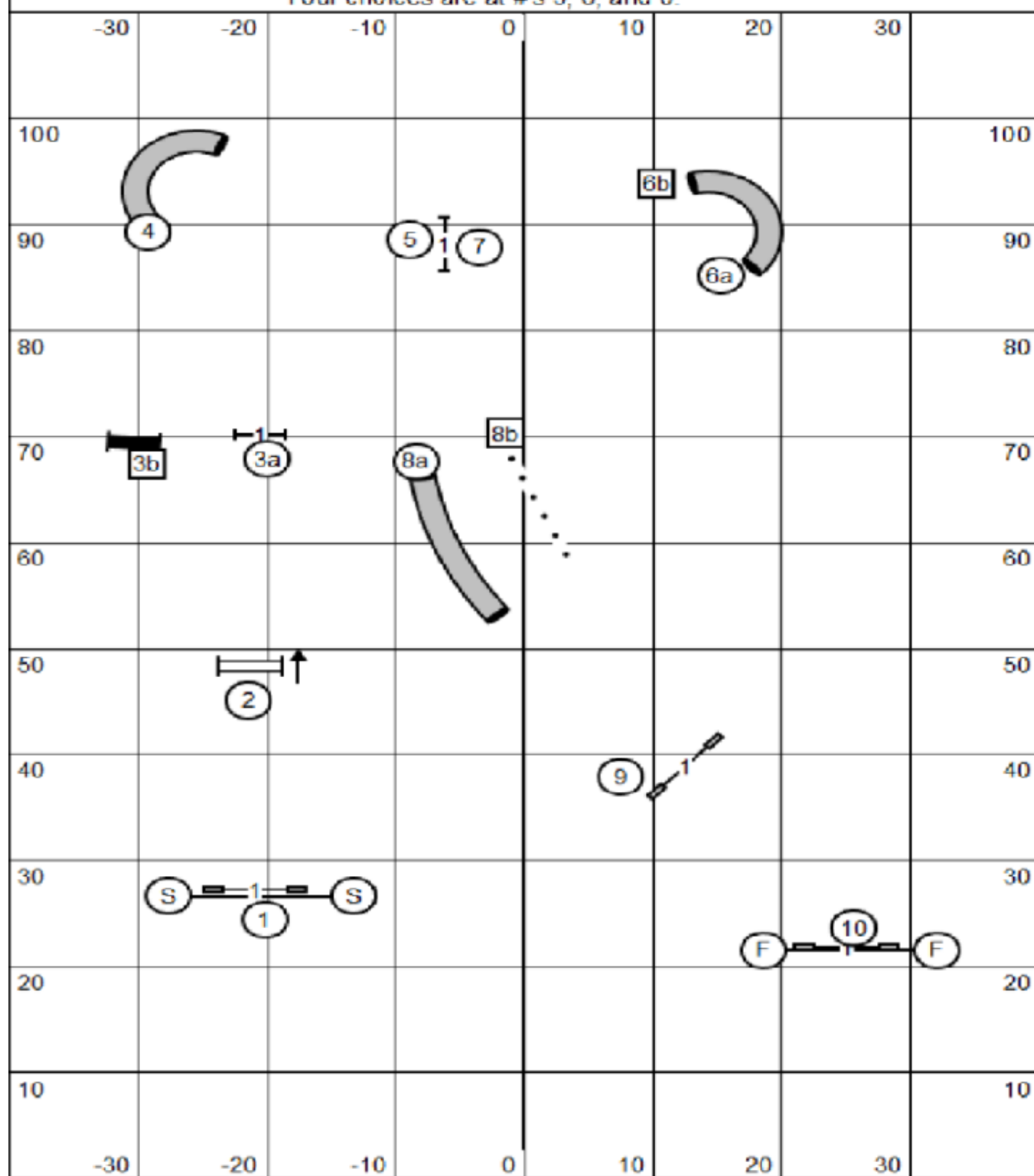
At this level you need 1 A and 2 B's.

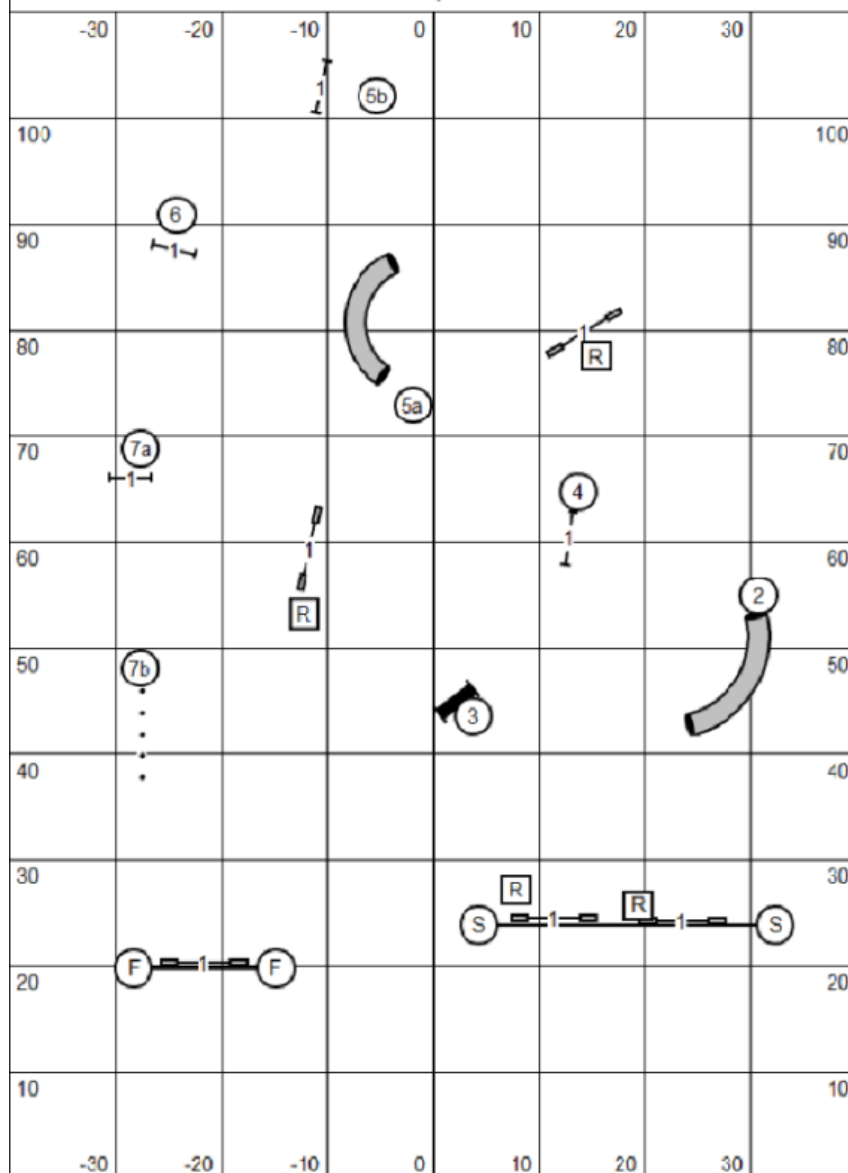

Opening: All numbered obstacles can be taken more than once.
 Red may only be used one time each.
 There are two combos. be sure to complete all parts of each combo even if you fault one part.

Closing: Finish jumps becomes "live". Complete the course as numbered. Go over the finish jump if you complete the course, hear a "thank you", or hear the horn.

Times:

Small dogs have 55 seconds.

Big dogs (16" vets jumping 12") have 50 seconds.

Points needed per level:

Level 3	30 pts
Levels 5C	32 pts

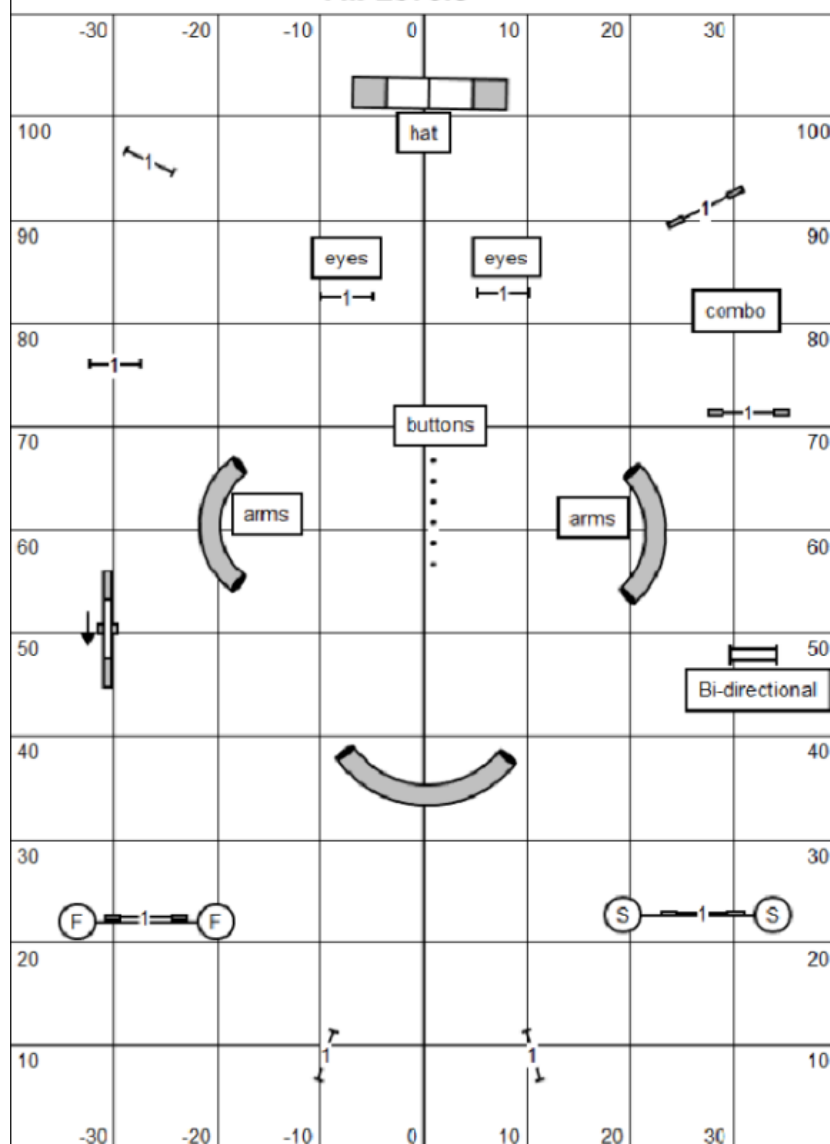
Snooker 12

Non Traditional Jackpot All Levels



All obstacles may be taken twice for points and back to back if done safely.

This is a non traditional gamble. You are building a snowman. The first time you take any part of the snowman, I will call out hat, or eyes, or buttons, or arms. You must get four of these parts to complete your snowman. These do not have to be done in particular order. These four snowman parts are worth 20 points.

Closing: The finish jump becomes "live". It is worth 5 points but it must not fall.

Points:

1 pt - single bar jumps

3 pts - weaves, double jump, tunnels

5 pts - teeter, A frame, combo (must be done in flow, either direction)

Times:

Small dogs have 35 seconds in the opening and 20 seconds in the closing. Total time: 55 seconds.

Big dogs (16" vets jumping 12") have 30 seconds in the opening and 18 seconds in the closing. Total time: 48 seconds.

Points needed to Q:

Level 1	32
Level 2	36
Level 3	40
Levels 5C	44

Specialists and Enthusiasts need two fewer points.

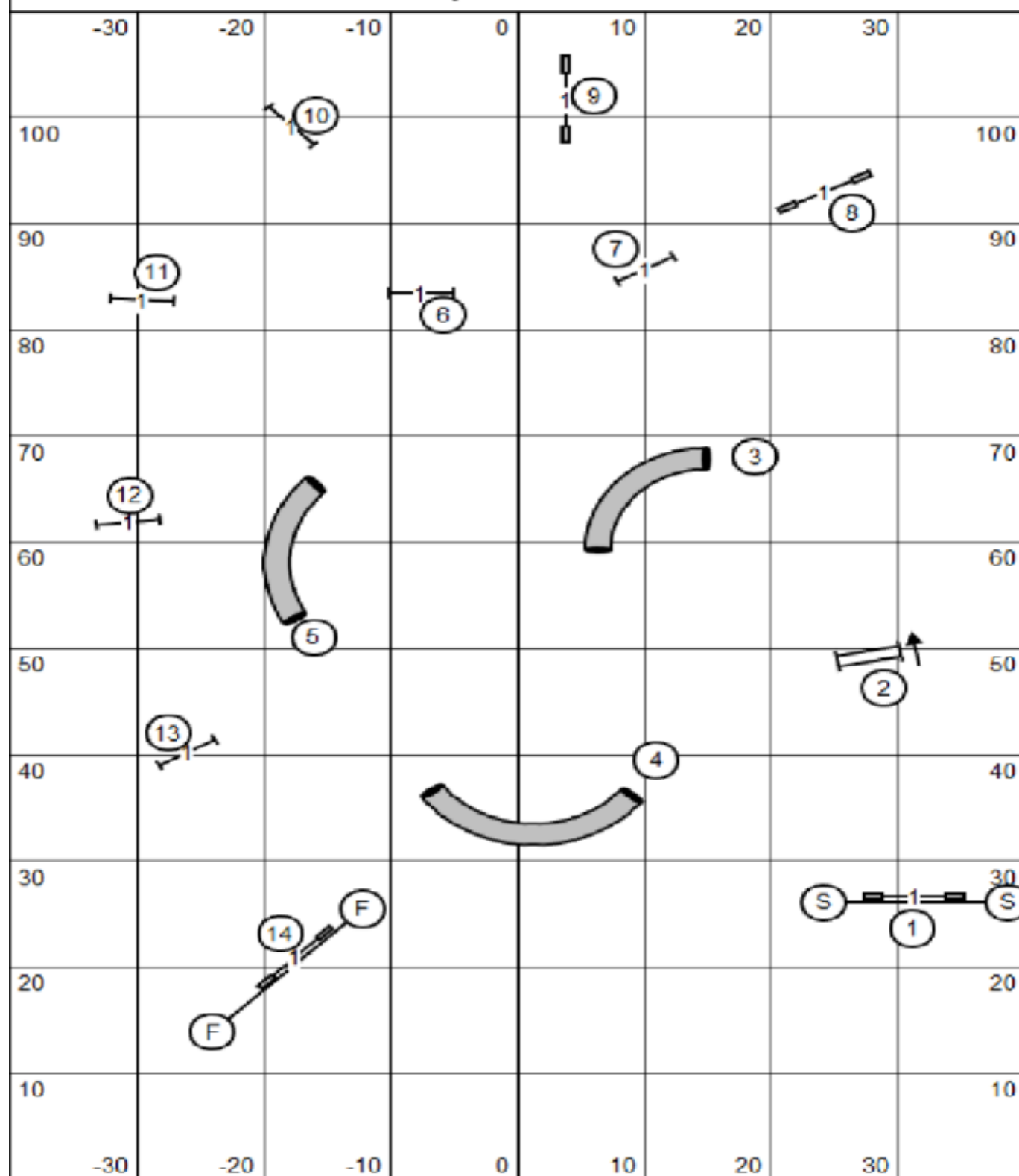

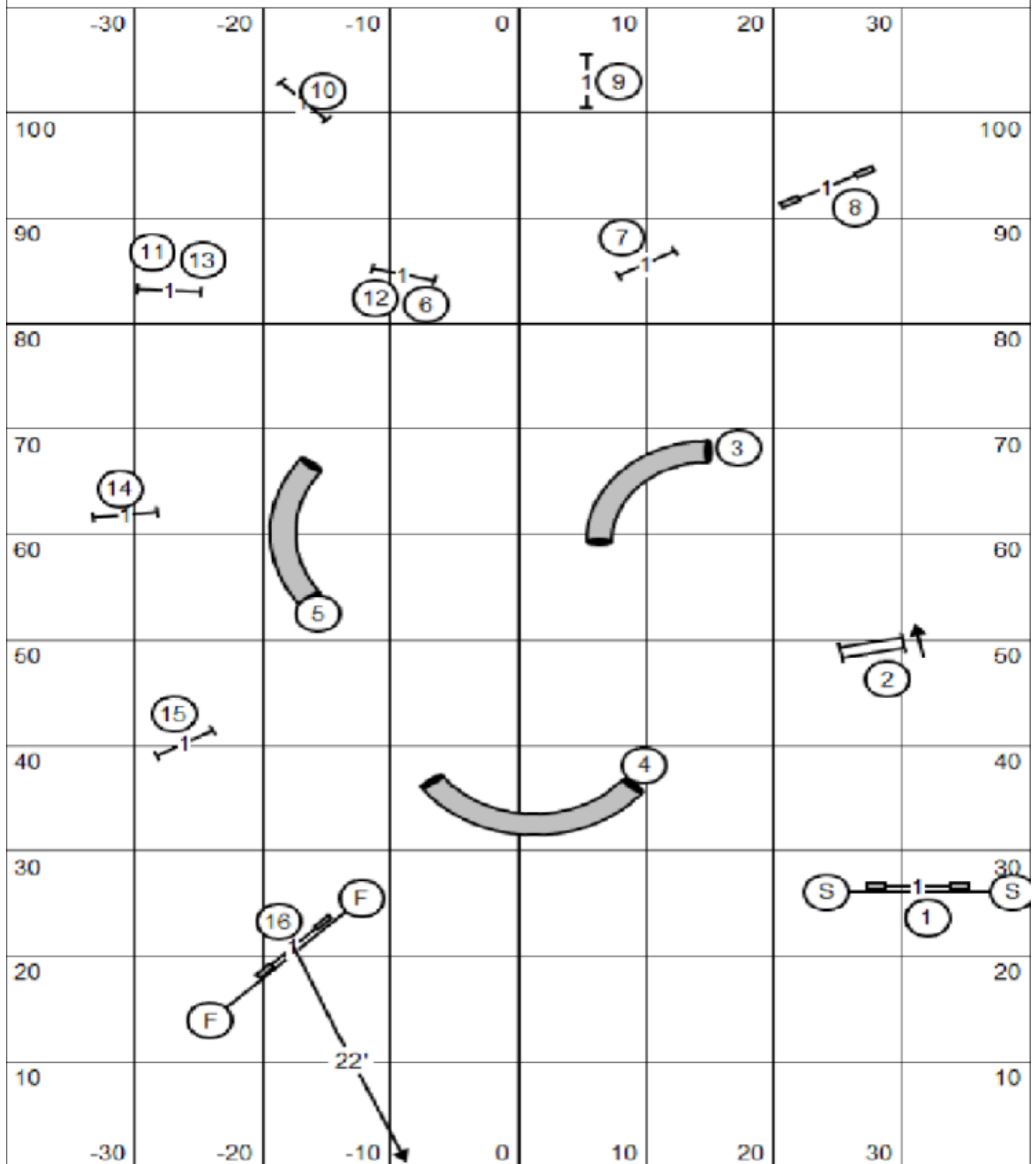
