**Search Sites:** Are inside of the building

**Potty:** Potty area is in the designated areas. In the briefing you will be advised as to where this is. **Please clean up after your dog at all times.**

**Crating:** Crating will be outside in your cars.

**Parking:** Parking is in the lot around the building.

**Hospitality:** The club will be providing hospitality FOR WORKERS and for Exhibitors for a donation. It is recommended that you bring breakfast/lunch with you, since we will not be providing food for all exhibitors.

**Awards:** SOTC will be providing ribbons for qualifying scores and placements. Rosettes will also be provided for new classes and all-around level titles. Results will be available at the end of each class. There are separate rosettes for Masters Level new class and new level titles. We would like to thank you in advance for all your cooperation in making SOTC

## **GENERAL TRIAL INFORMATION**

For those who are entered in Sunday's trial, Daylight Savings Time for Sunday March 8 is now 1 hour forward. We must set those clocks forward 1 hour. Don't forget to do so.

There will NOT be Friday evening exhibitor setup.

### **Day of Trial Timeline:**

Briefing 8:00 am

First dog on the line directly after briefing and walk thru

**Volunteers:** Volunteers are very much appreciated. Please check in with Beth or Caryn, your trial co-chairs, first thing in the morning to see what their needs are as far as volunteers. **Move ups:** Deadline for move ups was 6pm on Monday, March 2, 2026

**Run order:** A & B divisions will run together. Class running orders are located on the MDE website. Link is below.

Class Running order Trial 1 and 2 will be running concurrently. ***EXCEPT MASTER INTERIORS – ALL OF MASTER INTERIOR TRIAL 1 WILL RUN – THEN ALL OF MASTER INTERIORS TRIAL 2 WILL RUN.***

Please be patient with yourself, your fellow exhibitors and our trial volunteers as we all navigate the My Dog Entry live runtime updates. If you have used this or similar apps at agility trials, you know how cool it is.

**Pro Tip:** for each day click on the 'SAT ALL' or 'SUN ALL' button to see all search classes and monitor your runs in different classes on the same screen. Michael from My Dog Entry has worked hard to make sure no one starts the day with conflicts. We will monitor class times closely and make sure that we work with the judges to ensure everyone gets their runs in.

Also on this page there will be a button at 3:10am Saturday morning at the top that will say "check in", you can check in our dog before the trial opens Saturday. While you are still home drinking your first cup of coffee before you get in the car to come to the trial. Please use this check in as there will not be paper check in at the trial.

You will get another email on Friday evening to remind you about the check in and the running order buttons, and the location of the trial information on My Dog Entry.

**From the East:** Sunrise Highway exit 46 to Southern State Parkway West. Take exit 23 for Meadowbrook Road. Turn right on Meadowbrook Road and turn right onto Washington Avenue.

**From the Northwest:** I-495 East, take exit 22A -E for Grand Central Parkway, continue onto Northern State Parkway, take exit 31A for Meadowbrook State Parkway South. Take exit M6 E for Southern State Parkway East, take exit 23 for Meadowbrook Road and turn right on to Washington Avenue.
