Tournament Winners:

DASH Triathlon podium (1st-3rd Place in each height) will be held immediately following Triathlon Rd 3.

Steeplechase DASH Challenge podium (1st-3rd Place) will be held immediately after the Steeplechase DASH Challenge Finals are complete. It will be followed by the announcement of the DASH Tourney Overall Winner.

Parking: We are the only residence/business on Pigeon Road so when you drive down the road you will come to a large field with a white fenced agility ring and dock diving pool. Car parking is located in the front field between the road and the ring. Please do not park next to the fenced ring. You can crate your dog in your car or in the front field as long as it is not up against the ring area.



Preliminary Run Order: The preliminary running order is available on MyDogEntry: <https://mydogentry.com/public/trials/923>. *Note: the running order for Steeplechase DASH Challenge Final will not be posted until after the completion of the Steeplechase DASH Challenge Rd 3. As a reminder, only the top 10 or top 25% (whichever is higher) from the combined DASH Challenge rounds 1-3 will progress into the DASH Challenge Final.*

Course Maps: Course maps will be available when doors open on MyDogEntry (click on “Maps” at the top of their website): mydogentry.com

Walkthroughs: We will have two separate walkthroughs for DASH tournament classes on Saturday/Sunday. Saturday will be Small Dogs (4/8/12/16), then Large Dogs (20/22/24). Sunday will be Large Dogs (20/22/24), then Small Dogs (4/8/12/16).

Electronic Gating: We will be using electronic gating for this trial using MyDogEntry (click on “Run Order” at the top of their website): mydogentry.com. You can view the running order on the screen by the ring, or you can view it on your phone at any time. The estimated run times will update throughout the day. Login to your MyDogEntry account for personalized views! No app to download, no code needed.

Ribbons for non-tournament classes: For non-tournament classes, we have some beautiful ribbons for Q’s and Titles available. Please add your info to the ribbon sign up sheet (located by the trial secretary) and we’ll get a ribbon made up for you!

Potty Time:

Dogs - Dogs can access any of the surrounding area, but we ask that you please pick up after your dog. We will have short blue pails on each corner of the ring to drop all bags into.

Humans - There will be port-a-potty(s) on site (located to the right of the agility ring set back in the wooded area). Please put all food and other garbage in the black trash cans located at the top two corners of the ring.

RVs: Upon arrival, please check in and pay for your spot. RVs should park by the woods on the far side of the pool. RV Dry Camping is offered at a fee of \$15 per night. If you haven’t signed up already, please contact pawspackdogs@gmail.com to reserve your spot.

Dock Diving Pool: The Dock Diving Pool will be open to participants for cool-down swims ONLY (no dock diving practice during the trial). Cost for the weekend is \$25 per handler, payable cash or check at the trial. *You must fill out a completed liability waiver.* Contact Patricia with questions at pawspackdogs@gmail.com

This is only for competitors to swim (it is not open to the general public). As always, please be considerate of dogs competing in the ring during your dog's swim cool downs and do not jump / yell / etc. Please keep your dog on a leash to the pool and leaving the pool. Handlers must follow all verbal and posted safety instructions.

Note on Measuring: Dogs that need to be measured must be done before they run, and it is the competitors' responsibility to know if they need to be measured. Measuring will occur behind the ring near the white tents and large black ring gate.
