Measuring

Measuring of Dogs: We do not have a VMO at the trial. The judge of record at the trial will be measuring dogs every morning before the start of the trial. If your dog needs to be measured you need to arrive before the start of the trial to have your dog measured because the judge has very limited time between classes.

However: If an AKC rep is attending the show, they are all VMO's and you can have your dog measured by the rep. (AKC reps do not announce whether they will attend a show.)

Scoring

Results will be posted by the ribbons. The Move Up-sheet (CONGRATULATIONS!) will also be by the ribbons.

Check your results as soon as possible. If you have a question about your results, you need to bring it to the secretary's attention before the next class has started. And preferably before the judge has reviewed the results.

Placement Ribbons

Ribbons will be available for pick-up at the trial. All ribbons must be picked up AT the trial, none will be mailed.

After the judge has reviewed all scribe sheets and catalog pages for your class, we will release individual printed ribbon labels. You will then be able to come to the Awards area and make your own ribbon(s) using these printed labels. We will try to have the labels out as soon as we can, but please be patient -- remember that the AKC requires extensive review of the results by judges before ribbons can be made available to competitors.



Title Ribbons / Bars

In addition to rosettes for placements and qualifying flat ribbons, we will have new title ribbons and MACH/PACH ribbons and bars. There is also a Grand Champion ribbon.

Ribbons will NOT be mailed to you after the trial; you must pick them up by Sunday or they will be recycled.

Volunteers

Parking

Crating


You can crate your dog in your car or in the front field as long as it is not up against the ring.

Please keep all dogs at least 5 feet from the ring fence at all times!!

Potty Time

Humans - There will be port-a-potty(s) on site (located to the right of the agility ring set back in the wooded area)

Dogs - Dogs can access any of the surrounding area, but we ask that you please pick up after your dog. We will have short blue pails on each corner of the ring to drop all bags into. Please put all food and other garbage in the black trash cans located at the top two corners of the ring.



Directions to Paws Pack:

160 Pigeon Rd. Wagener, SC 29164

From I-20:

Take Exit 33 toward Wagener SC-39S (Old 96 Indian Trail).
Turn Right onto Bethcar Church Road.
Turn Left onto Rishstore Road.
Turn Right onto Pigeon Road

From Aiken:

Take 302 toward Wagener.
Make a left onto Coleman Bridge.
Turn Right onto Spoonbill Road.
Turn Left onto Pigeon Road

Alternative Route from Aiken:

Take 302 toward Wagener
Take a sharp left to follow 302 toward Town of Wagener.
Take a Left onto Rishstore Road.
Take another Left onto Pigeon Road

From Charleston:

Take I-26 W to Exit 154A to merge onto US-301S. Continue on 301S to SC-4 W/Neeses Road NW to SC-302. Turn Left onto Rishstore Road.
Turn Left onto Pigeon Road
