



April 11-12, 2026 CPE Trial Confirmation Letter

Please read this letter carefully, it contains important information about the Hilltown Hounds Trial and the trial site. We are not taking day of show for this trial.

Course maps for each day will be available to competitors after 3pm the day before on My Dog Entry. They will not be emailed to you. Copies will be posted on site, there will not be any additional copies available at the trial. Judge's Class briefings will be listed on the course maps. If you do need an explanation of anything at the trial the judge will be available to answer your question. We will have a leash runner that will use a leash grabber. However, you also have the option of carrying your leash with you during a run (doesn't need to be out of sight as long as you don't lure the dog with it or use it like a toy), or you can put in your pocket or toss towards the finish line.

Returning this year!

All competitors will be entered in a raffle for a door prize sponsored by Hilltown Hounds. The door prize will be drawn on Saturday during the general briefing so if you are entered for one day you will be able to take home your prize.

Competitors Info for Roots Athletic Center 181 Root Rd, Westfield MA

We will have signs at the entrance.

Park in the back parking lot. We enter through the side door which brings you to the area we are using on the LEFT. You may drop your things off at the door and then go and park. Important: There will be parking spaces blocked by cones along the side of the building near our entrance. These spaces are reserved for use by designated people and some are handicapped spaces. If you park in any of the marked spaces you will be asked to move. If you need a handicap spot please contact MaryLou, buzz2004@verizon.net before Wednesday at 6PM. The marked handicap spots at the site are not near the door that we are using so we have to mark off closer spaces .

Please potty your dogs before you run. Don't wait to the last minute, give them time to go.

There will be a \$20 cash fee if your dog pees or poops or vomits in the building.

You must pick up outside or you will be asked to leave. We have poop bags at the door. Please take a few when you go outside.

No peeing on the building, trash cans, cones or anything people touch. OUTSIDE SOCCER FIELDS!! THESE ARE OFF LIMITS!

There is a nice trail to walk on at the back of the parking lot and sandy areas outside the building.

Dogs can have treats(please none that crumble) and water in the crating area. Humans only water, no food, coffee, soda etc

There is a kitchen area with tables and chairs to eat at. The club will have workers snacks and goodies in the kitchen area. Dogs are not allowed in these areas.

There is a small snack bar that will be open at 8am. They have coffee, soda, other drinks, snacks, pizza, chicken tenders, and hot pretzels. There is also a vending machine.

Please make sure to put a tarp or mat under your crate and chair.

Doors open Saturday and Sunday at 7 am for set up. We have 1 club member willing to be there from 3-4:30 on Friday if people want to set up then.

CHECK IN, MEASURING AND BRIEFING

Saturday & Sunday: Set-up 7:00 a.m. Measuring and Check-in: 7:15 -7:40 a.m. General briefing and first walk thru will follow. First dog on the line at 8:00 a.m. Dogs that need to be measured must be measured BEFORE their general briefing.

RETIRED DOG RUN:

We will again be doing a retired dog run on Sunday before Level 1 Standard runs. All retired agility dogs are invited to participate. All jumps will be on the ground and the handler can choose what obstacles to do or you can just parade around the ring to honor your dog. DECLARED TRAINING IN THE RING WILL BE OFFERED AT THIS TRIAL:

We will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course. ☒ Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be DTIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring. See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules. The following items are considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go: ☒ Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact ☒ Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start) ☒ Putting the dog back on the table in the point games
