Course maps will be emailed to competitors the evening before each trial day and will be available on My Dog Entry at 3:00pm the day before each trial day. Individual hard copies will not be available at the trial, print your own if you want them.

There will be no food provided at the trial, water and a few snacks will be provided for workers. If you order food for delivery, please specify that it be delivered to the barn (not the houses). Please do not leave any food or treats in the barn overnight.

TRIAL SITE RULES & INFORMATION

- **5 mph speed limit on the property. Violators may be asked to leave without a refund.** Tetz Lane is posted 30mph. It is strongly suggested that you go no faster than 10mph between the white house on the turn and the first red barn.
- Please stay close to the barn! The fields, areas by the houses, the horse paddock area, and fenced runs in front of the building are all off limits.
- Crating is not permitted in the seating area of the arena. If you need help finding a stall to crate in, please ask. You can also work from your vehicle or set up a tent outside.
- During trial hours, dogs must be on leash or crated at all times when not competing in the arena or at the practice jump. No flexi leashes in extension allowed in the barn or arena.
- No food or treats are to be left in the stalls or the arena overnight. Stall windows/doors must be closed when stall is not in use.
- No personal heaters of any kind - propane, kerosene or electric allowed in stalls, in any building or within 100 feet of any building.
- No smoking in any building or within 50 feet of any building. Cigarette butts must be properly disposed of.
- All trash is to be placed in proper receptacles, black/ garbage and blue/ recycling
- Clean up after your dog. There are orange poop cans with bags.
- Unsupervised children are not allowed on or about the premises.
- The consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited during trial hours.
- Self-contained RVs only / Limited number / Pre-registration required.
- Please park in designated spaces.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW:

From the NYS Thruway (North or South): Exit 16 - Merge onto NY- 17 W Take exit 122 - Crystal Run Crossing. Turn right onto Crystal Run Crossing. Turn left onto Crystal Run Road. Take to end - make right at traffic light - County Rd 83/ Goshen Turnpike/Scotchtown Ave. Approximately 1.2 miles to Tetz Lane – turn left onto Tetz Lane to end.

From the West: I-84 Eastbound – Take Exit 19A for NY-17 E towards New York City. Keep Right for County Rd 67/Crystal Run Rd. At traffic light, turn Left onto Crystal Run Rd, follow for 2 miles, turn Right at traffic light onto Goshen Turnpike/Scotchtown Ave. After 1.2 miles, turn left onto Tetz Lane. Follow to end.

From the East: I-84 Westbound – Take Exit 19A to merge onto NY-17 towards New York City. Take Exit 122 for County Rd 67/Crystal Run Rd. At traffic light, turn left onto Crystal Run Rd, follow for 2 miles, turn Right traffic light onto Goshen Turnpike/Scotchtown Ave. After 1.2 miles, turn left onto Tetz Lane. Follow to end.
