Thank you for entering **PCOTC's** April 2026 Scent Work Trial!

**Search Areas:** Access the container searches by using the street-level building entrance and proceeding up the stairs. Buried searches are down the driveway, inside the lower level of the building.

**Parking:** Parking is available on the side streets surrounding the club and all along Ferris Avenue. Please ensure that you do not block any driveways. On Sunday, the two (2) hour parking limit is NOT enforced but there is a church directly across from PCOTC whose members also park on the street mid/late morning. If you plan to arrive after the briefing, we recommend arrival by 8:45 for the closest-to-the-facility street parking.

**Crating:** Crating will be outside in your cars.

**Potty:** Potty area is on the side streets, NOT in front of the church. Please clean up after your dog at all times.

**Hospitality:** The club will be providing hospitality for VOLUNTEERS ONLY. Please bring breakfast/lunch with you, since we are not able to provide food for exhibitors. We will have a hot water kettle available that you may access in between classes.

**Awards:** PCOTC will be providing ribbons for qualifying scores and placements. Rosettes will also be provided for new element and level titles. Results will be available at the end of each class.

We would like to thank you in advance for your cooperation in making **PCOTC's** Scent Work Trial a success. As you can see, the trial committee has put a lot of thought into making the trial run smoothly and set it up so the teams that are working have the greatest chance for success.

All of our trial committee members as well as our trial workers are volunteers who have stepped up to make this trial happen. Look for us wearing red volunteer lanyards. We would like to wish you the best of luck at the trial, and we look forward to seeing you and your pups!

**Check in:** On this page, there will be a button at the top early Sunday morning that says, "check in." Please check in your dog before the trial opens Sunday while you are still home drinking your first cup of coffee before you get in the car to come to the trial! You must check in online; there will not be a paper check in at the trial.

**Pro tip:** On Sunday, click on the 'SUN ALL' button to see all search classes and monitor your runs in different classes on the same screen. Michael from My Dog Entry has worked hard to make sure no one starts the day with conflicts. We will monitor class times closely and make sure that we work with the judges to ensure everyone gets their runs in.

Please be patient with yourself, your fellow exhibitors, and our trial volunteers as we all navigate the My Dog Entry gate calling and live runtime updates. If you have used this or similar real time run orders at other trials, you know how cool they are.

**You will receive another email on Saturday evening to remind you about the check in, running order, and location of trial information on My Dog Entry.**
