Telephone, email and fax entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms or Entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the form are not acceptable. Unsigned Entry Forms cannot be accepted nor entries which specify any conditions as to its acceptance. Entry Forms MUST be filled out completely. Incomplete entries do not constitute a valid entry.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, & no entry will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE CLEARLY. **NO STAPLES OR TAPE PLEASE.**

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a **\$25** collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Exhibitors will receive an email **confirmation** of their entries being received. After the entry period closes, the Trial Secretary will send a final confirmation.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

NO Dogs under 6 months of age can enter. Dogs between 6 - 12 months of age can use a half course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. **No refunds for overpayments \$10 or less.**

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The Doberman Pinscher Club, the trial secretary, their agents, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children not under the control of their parents or guardians.

IF IT IS NECESSARY TO RESCUE A DOG from a parked car on the show grounds, the Club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the car involved.

Owners or handlers entering dogs in a trial do so at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them, or by their dogs. They also agree to abide by the Rules of the American Kennel Club and the current edition of the AKC Agility Regulations.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Anyone in violation of a restriction pursuant to AKC rules or policies, or the law can be asked to leave the grounds. If the person fails to leave, the local authorities will be contacted. In addition, if the club believes laws, restrictions, or conditions of release are being violated by an individual's attendance or participation in AKC events, the local authorities will be contacted immediately as they have the authority of enforcement.

Volunteer Breaks: Field workers will have staggered breaks between 9:30 and 10:00. A 30 minute lunch break between noon – 1:00.

For safety reasons, no flip-flops, clogs or platform shoes will be permitted in the test area. Appropriate footwear is enclosed and will not slip off.

VEHICLES AND CRATING: If you leave your air-conditioner running, your vehicle MUST be parked on the pavement in the RV parking area and your dog must be crated.

INSPECTION: At check "in" dogs will be inspected for lameness, fitness to compete, and females in season. If, in the opinion of the inspection committee, any entry is found to be lame, unfit to compete or in season, they shall not be allowed to test, and the applicable entry fees shall be refunded. **The dog MUST be inspected prior to each run, even if running consecutive events.**

For all runs, the lures will be white plastic bags (no squawkers). There will be NO recall from the start line. Electronic timers will be used.

The field has no amenities or shade available. Please ensure the comfort of you and your dogs by bringing your own portable shade/shelter, water and chair.

There will be NO food available. There are restaurants/fast-food within 2 miles of the trial site.

The Start: Dogs may start up to 10 feet behind the starting line.

BRING TWO leashes: one for releasing dog and the other for catching.

PLEASE have a person to release your dog and to catch your dog BEFORE running your dog. The club plans to have available volunteers to assist, but it is not guaranteed.

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded. ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK.

Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Dogs may wear any collar **except** a choker collar, a collar with prongs or an electronic training collar. The collar should be snug to minimize the chances of getting hung up on something during the run. Tags hanging from the collar should be removed. Owners may use clips or rubber bands to hold the dog's hair. The owner assumes responsibility for the safety of the dog regarding the dog's collar and paraphernalia on the dog.

FUN RUNS

Fun Runs provide an opportunity for your dog to run the Fast CAT course without being entered in the Fast CAT trial. The same rules apply as the dogs running in the trial.

WHAT IS FAST CAT?

A timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to chase it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

FORMULA: $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$

$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS (ROUNDED TO NEAREST 0.01)}$

Based on the dog's size at the withers, a handicap is applied and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

- BCAT = 150 points
- DCAT = 500 points
- FCAT = 1,000 points
- FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

2551 Taylor Road, Punta Gorda, FL

- Take I75 to exit 161 Jones Loop Road
- From Tampa and points north, turn Right at end of ramp and then Right onto Taylor Road
- From Ft Myers and points south, turn left at end of ramp then Right onto Taylor Road
- Bratty Paw Dog Plex is on the left, 1.9 miles on Taylor Road
