\*Friday Standard will run as Double Down, two rounds of the same course. They will run concurrently. i.e. Standard Rd 1 Level 5C, Rd 2 Level 5C, Rd 1 Level 3, Rd 2 Level 3, Rd 1 Level 2, Rd 2 Level 2, Rd 1 Level 1, Rd 2 Level 1. There will be a walk-through between runs.

- **Bait and toys:** These must be at least ten feet from the ring. Use the “bait baskets” provided just outside the gates to store your bait bags.
- All exhibitors **must** pick up after their dogs in all areas of the fairgrounds. Please use the trash cans for dog pick-up.
- **Fairgrounds:** If you are camping or staying in a tent, please pick up after your dog. If you wish to stay an extra night, please let the secretary know, and pay for the extra night.
