NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- *The safety of the dogs is the primary concern so by entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- *Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- *It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. If an exhibitor is asked to leave the trial site, then the exhibitor will not be refunded any fees that have been paid.
- *Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- *Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms. Any illegible or incomplete entries will not be entered in the trial.

Effective January 1, 2026. Introducing Double Down (DD)! This is an exciting new option for Host Clubs and Competitors. Have you ever finished a course and wished you could run the same one again? Now, Clubs can offer Double Down: select courses on trial days can be repeated in the premium as a Double Down event (maximum of one Double Down run per trial day). For example, if a club wants to host classes on Saturday but wants to avoid setting up lots of different courses for Standard, they can provide a Double Down opportunity—two rounds of Standard, both on the same course. If you perform well, you might earn two Qs on the same course! Double Down can apply to any course; EMAC will be using this exciting new option on Friday with Standard.

Example of how courses might run using Double Down, Rd 1 Level 1, Rd 2 Level 1, Rd 1 Level 2, Rd 2 Level 2, Rd 1 Level 3, Rd 2 Level 3, Rd 1 Level 5C, Rd 2 Level 5C.

Refunds: There will be NO refunds after the closing date UNLESS the Trial Chairperson and/or Trial Secretary receive a note from the exhibitor's veterinarian or physician. The note must be delivered no later than the end of the trial. Only then will EMAC refund 60% of the entry fee.

CAMPING

RV Parking and Tent spaces will be assigned after closing. All reservations with spots indicated will be posted on our Facebook page and on My Dog Entry shortly after closing.

Ringside Camping is limited. Priority is given to those involved in event management. All other spots are assigned by the order of entries/forms received from the opening date.

Please read these guidelines because they may have changed since our last trial.

- Be sure to fill out the request completely. Reservations must be paid for in full before the reservation is accepted.
 - ⇒ EMAC Member in good standing: **\$40.00** per night for camper or tent
 - ⇒ Non-EMAC Members: **\$50.00** per night for camper or tent
 - ⇒ Any reservations received after the closing date: \$55.00 per night for camper or tent. If campsites are available, campers are allowed without reservations. You must check in with the Camper Coordinator, pay the \$55.00 per night fee before parking/setting up.
- There are a limited number of full hook-up sites available in the newest area, near Walmart, far from the ring. **Clean-up for use of unmaintained sewer hook-ups at all other sites is the camper's responsibility.** Most sites have water and electricity only.
- Please be aware that most sites have only 20 amps. (5 sites have 30-amp outlets near Walmart.) Please bring plenty of water hoses and electric cords.
- Parking in assigned spaces only. If you park in an off-limits area or a spot that you were not assigned, you will be asked to move.
- **Rental campers do not include the camp site fee.** This fee must be paid in addition to renting a camper and a reservation form must be submitted.
- Tent campers will be assigned to an area in the horse barns.
- Arrivals the night prior to the event and staying until the morning after the event is allowed. Please include the fees for the extra night(s)
- Splitters for the water may be needed, and **generators must be off from 9 pm - 5 am** each day.
- There is a dump station on site free of charge.
- Reservations will not be accepted by telephone or e-mail. You must submit this form with your entry form.
