



Medina Swarm May 2 & 3 CPE Speedway Trial

The building will be open at 7:45am for set up on Saturday. First dog on the line at 9:00am on Saturday and at 8:00 AM on Sunday.

There will be DAY OF SHOW entries (until we reach our maximum of 400 runs per day) at \$15 per class from 8:00 – 8:30 on Saturday, and 7:00-7:30 on Sunday. Please bring a completed Premium. We would appreciate a check or correct change. If you know of someone coming for DOS, please advise them.

The running order will be posted to MyDogEntry by Thursday, April 30th for Saturday's ring games. There will be no formal run order posted for Drag Race. Due to DOS entries and conflicts there may be changes in the running order. Please check your confirmation & posted running order for accuracy.

SATURDAY: Parking is in the large back lot on the EAST side of the building. Please do not park in the small front lot on the southeast side. You will be asked to move.

SUNDAY: Overflow parking is available a little further down by the ballfields.

DRAG RACE: Please be sure to bring two leashes (one for the person releasing the dog and one for the person catching the dog). We also recommend that you bring someone to release your dog (or catch them). There will be no formal run order for Drag Race.

Those who need to see Mandii (Trial Secretary) please do so before 8:30 AM on Saturday and 7:30 AM on Sunday.

Exhibitors entering trials held at Medina Swarm must comply with all Federal, State and Local laws, and at any time is done entirely at your own risk. Per the CDC it is highly recommended that those who are unvaccinated, compromised, or have vulnerable members at home wear masks within the building, and are encouraged to social distance. Medina Swarm will not be supplying masks.

Note per the CPE Premium

No changes to trial results will be made once the trial has been completed – handlers are responsible for the accuracy of information in their confirmation from the trial secretary (dog's info, level, height category and/or jump height, etc), prior to running in a trial, and for reporting any discrepancies of posted results prior to leaving the trial site each day. This also includes if there was a correction to a scribe sheet – the handler must verify that the results were corrected as well.
