

Welcome to the T2TQ May 2026 trial ! We are planning on having a great trial and a lot of fun. Please read this whole document, it contains a lot of information on how this trial will run.

First the run order: Please remember that this is a day of show trial so the run order can change.

Saturday-running small to tall

FullHouse All

Standard 1, 23, 5C

Jackpot traditional and double down- 12, 12, 3, 3, 5C, 5C

Colors 12, 35C

Sunday-running tall to small

Jumpers 12. 35C

Snooker 12, 35C

Standard 1, 2, 3, 5C

Standard (Double Down)

Wildcard 12. 35C

We will be using real time run order for this trial. You may check your dog in early.

Each morning of this trial there will be a large "Check-In" button at the top of the MyDogEntry screen.

- if you are logged in to your MyDogEntry account when you click "Check-In", you'll see a list of your dogs and can check-in for each class.
- If you are not logged in to your MyDogEntry account when you click "Check-In", you'll see a list of trial locations. Click on your trial location and you'll see a list of all dogs. Scroll down to find your dog's name. Click on your dog and check-in for each class.
- This can be done using your home computer, tablet, or mobile phone.

Each morning of this trial there will also be a large "Run Order" button at the top of the MyDogEntry screen.

- If you are logged in to your MyDogEntry account when you click "Run Order", you'll see the current run order and your dog will be highlighted in green.
- If you are not logged in to your MyDogEntry account when you click "Run Order", you'll see a list of trial locations. Click on your trial location to see the current run order.
- The dog shown at the top of the screen is either currently running or will run next.
- The estimated run times will update automatically throughout the day.
- This can be done using your home computer, tablet, or mobile phone.

Move-ups and corrections:

Please check your entry information carefully and contact me via email if any corrections need to be made. The deadline for moveups is Mon May 4, 2026 at 6:00 PM No corrections will be made at the trial regardless of who is at fault.

Please check your scores before leaving the trial site. Once they are sent to CPE they are final. We will be uploading scores to My Dog Entry throughout the day. If you have enabled text alerts you will get notifications throughout the day.

Takes 2 to Q General Briefing / May 2026 CPE Trial at Working Dogs, Amsterdam, NY

Thank you for coming to our May 2026 CPE Agility Trial! In an effort to keep our day of briefing as short as possible, please review the following written briefing. *This information will not be repeated at the in-person briefing.* Please also refer to the premium and confirmation letter for additional important information. We will assemble to welcome everyone; introduce key workers, our judge and announce the details of our Special Raffle. Please don't hesitate to ask questions during the trial—we're here to help!

We all appreciate the opportunity to trial at Working Dogs and ask that you pick up after yourself and your dogs, both inside and out. We are able to crate inside the building, space permitting. Please follow designated areas for crating.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR WORKING DOGS:

WORKING DOGS NY POLICIES AND INFORMATION

WDNY has implemented a footwear policy for the building.

Clean dry shoes are required on the turf floor.

All handlers that train/compete in our building will be required to bring indoor shoes to be worn while on the turf. We will no longer allow outdoor shoes on the turf. Dirt, mud, and snow are damaging the turf.

No dirt, mud, or snow on shoes or personal equipment. Matting is necessary under crates and chairs. No crumbly treats. Soft treats recommended. No glass.

No smoking on the property.

- **POTTY POLICY** Payment to WDNY of **\$30/offense** for dogs eliminating inside the building will be assessed to the dog owner.
- **SPACE IS LIMITED.** Building will open at 7 a.m. NO EXHIBITOR SETUP PRIOR TO SATURDAY MORNING. Please do not crate unentered dogs in the building. No X-pens, lounge chairs, or tables will be allowed. Crates and chairs must be on mats. There will be no "preferred" crating. Please be respectful of the trial committee if you are asked to move your setup to make room for others. Thank you.

If there are any issues or questions, please let your Trial Chair or any T2TQ member know and we will get them resolved.

For hospitality, our club is providing water and lite snacks for our much-appreciated workers.

Please remember trial etiquette, including:

- Please keep all food, human and canine, at least 10' from the ring to avoid distracting the dogs running.
- No squeaky toys inside the building and crate noisy dogs in your vehicle.
- Dogs waiting at the start gate to run and those exiting the ring have the right of way, please give them space as they are likely focused on their run and exiting the ring quickly afterwards.
- Please keep passageways and entry/exit doors clear of dogs and personal belongings.
- Avoid congregating, especially with dogs, near the gates and building exits.
- If you have set up text notifications in MDE, you will receive your scores on your phone as soon as the results have been uploaded to MDE.
- For safety's sake, please maintain physical distance between people and dogs.

WE WILL BE OFFERING DOUBLE DOWN AT THIS TRIAL, WITH JACKPOT x 2 ON SATURDAY AND STANDARD x 2 ON SUNDAY. SAME COURSE CAN BE RUN TWICE IF PRE-ENTERED AS SUCH. NO DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES AFTER 7:45 am (i.e. if you run Standard or Jackpot the first time and do not Q., you cannot add the second run on the same course immediately after the NQ. Entries for Double Down must be made IN ADVANCE. CPE does not allow same day move-ups so you cannot move up between double down rounds

Walk-throughs: Timed walk-throughs begin following the briefing and the order of walk-throughs will be announced each class.

Running the course: When it's your turn to run, please remember to enter the ring and be ready to run before the previous dog has finished its course, unless specifically instructed otherwise by the judge, gate steward, or previous handler.

Delayed entry to the ring should be the exception, especially for levels 3-C. The judge and the gate steward will tell you at what obstacle or buzzer you should be entering the ring. With your help getting to the line, we can keep the trial flowing efficiently.

*Please announce your dog's name **BEFORE** you run; this will help cut down on entering scores on the wrong scribe sheet, and the time it takes to fix them.*
Exiting the ring quickly will also save us a lot of time.

If you have been whistled off the course or the horn blows because you are overtime, that means you need to immediately go to the exit because your time is up.

Please read the rulebook for current and some little-known rules and their potential penalties, such as excessive delays at the start and finish lines and for continuing to direct your dog to take obstacles if your run has ended.

Scoring: We'll set up a small monitor near the scoring table. If you have a question about your score, please ask Chris Penna or Jean Guyon ASAP after your run and we will assist you. If it is necessary to confer with the judge regarding your score, Chris or Jean will approach the judge at a convenient break in the run order.

- **Please remember that we cannot change scores after the completion of each trial day. The results emailed to you after the trial (by Monday latest), are what is being sent to CPE and cannot be changed.**

Title Ribbons & Move-ups: Clipboards will be available near the scoring area to let us know that you've earned a title – we customize the ribbons for you! If you have a move-up in Standard, there will be another clipboard to tell us what level you're moving to. We need to have that information after the completion of Standard to make the change for the next day. No changes will be made on Sunday morning.

Special Raffle that benefits Free to Be Me Rescue

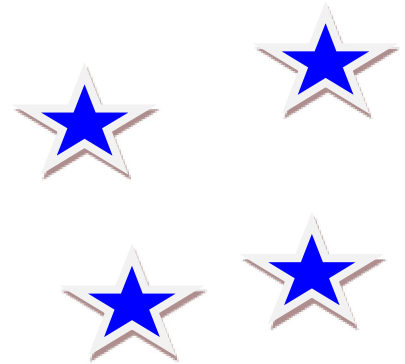
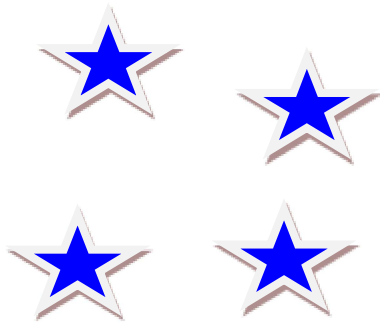
