

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

Jump height cards are no longer required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form has been changed to indicate whether the dog has been issued a temporary or permanent height card or needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running.

Jump Heights

Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights; however, only those dogs running in the 12," 16," 20" and 24" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoffs (different than regular AKC cutoffs) may use their clean run toward the required qualifications for WTT or EOTT. Please see the 2026 EO/AWC Tryout Rules for further details.

The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- **Small** (12" jump height) – for dogs measuring 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ " or less at the withers
- **Medium** (16" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and up to 16 $\frac{7}{8}$ " at the withers.
- **Intermediate** (20" jump height) – for dogs measuring more than 16 $\frac{7}{8}$ " but less than 18 $\frac{7}{8}$ " at the withers.
- **Large** (24" jump height) – for dogs measuring over 18 $\frac{7}{8}$ " at the withers

Qualifications

"Clean run" scores from ISC Classes at official FCI jump heights, 12", 16", 20", and 24," may be used to fulfill the qualification requirements for WTT/EOTT. A "clean run" consists of a run without time or course faults. Minimum YPS requirements are waived for these scores, as long as the dog is under the course time set by the judge for that class.

International Sweepstakes Classes (ISC)

Purpose: The International Sweepstakes Class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various International Style Standard (Agility) and Jumpers with Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in International Agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in Excellent / Master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC Website (<http://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: ISC classes are open to all dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials. There is no Preferred Option for ISC. Dogs may enter at their preferred jump height; however, they will be scored against the regular division dogs jumping their regular height. For example: 16" preferred dogs will be scored against 20" regular division dogs. Eligible dogs may be entered in any level of ISC. At present, there are no eligibility requirements for any level of ISC and any dog that is eligible according to the information in this premium list may run any level.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs (15) months or age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are register able breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind, or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place **indoors on a turf** surface. Ring size will be **120' x 130'**.

ENTRY FEES PER DAY

First entry of each dog\$25
Each additional entry of the same dog per day\$25

NEW for 2026 from AKC: Entry fees include a \$4.50 per run fee to AKC for the first entry per day and \$4.50 for each additional entry per day.

An initial E-mail will be sent out as entries are processed, typically within 24 hours of the entry being received.....Move-ups are confirmed by a new emailed confirmation being sent to you...if you have multiple dogs entered the updated email will only be for the dog that had the move-up. Final confirmations will go out after the trial has closed.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a **\$30.00** collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Classes will have ribbons awarded to the 1st through 4th place in each jump height with qualifying scores.

Qualification ribbons will not be awarded at this trial unless requested. Additionally, other awards will be given to top finishers in the May Magic Cup Finals A3 course.

NQ (Not Qualified) Raffle - Every NQ run, receive a ticket for the NQ raffle!

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – please review, updated information

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes, and participation is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level in FEO runs. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Bitches In Season (BIS)

BIS will be permitted to compete at this event. Handlers with bitches in season are requested to indicate this on the run order prior to their run and take appropriate precautions to minimize disruption. BIS pants must be worn whenever the dog is in one of the main agility rings, or on the matting in the crating building. The handler/owner acknowledges the inherent risk of running a dog on an agility course with BIS pants on and assumes all risk by doing so.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

Conroe Agility Training Club, and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. **Conroe Agility Training Club** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against **Conroe Agility Training Club** or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

Emailed entry changes are not official until the exhibitor has received email confirmation back from the Trial Secretary.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

CATALOGS

Advance catalog sales may be ordered and prepaid on your entry form for **\$10**.

Vendors are not allowed at this event without written permission from Dog Gone Fun Agility, LLC.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating/Set Up - On Site set up may begin on Friday at 7:45 am. The crating area is NOT available on Thursday as there are classes being held there. **Gate/Doors open at 7:45 each morning.**

Please do not allow your dog to potty on the building, trash cans or anything staff may handle, the artificial turf between the buildings, or the A/C units.

Crating space will be available. Crates may be left overnight; however, **Conroe Agility Training Club** and **Dog Gone Fun Agility LLC** will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
