Other Details

- Remember to wear **clean, dry shoes in the ring** and to familiarize yourself with [OTR's Gym Rules](#).
- Check the "other items/charges" section at the end of your confirmation e-mail to see if your dog needs **measuring**. Please review the new measuring policy in section 4.5 in the [11th edition rulebook](#)
- **Crating** is available in the main crating room, part of the back crating room, or out of your vehicle. When crating inside, please put a mat/blanket under your crate **and** chair. (You can also put cardboard squares under your chair legs or borrow some chair protectors if your mat isn't big enough for your crate & chair) Please be respectful of the neighbors and do not leave barking dogs in your vehicle (no matter where you park).
- **Parking:** We have a large entry so park near the next car in the lot when spots aren't marked and please consider car-pooling. You can also park on the road in front of On the Run (on their side of the road), but do not block the mailbox on Friday or Saturday.
- **Check in: All exhibitors receive a gift bag.** You can pick them up at the check-in table (near the ring) in the morning plus drop off new checks (if needed). If you bought **additional swag from Ernie's Pro Shop** by April 24 your items will be available at check-in. (You can also [order more items](#) that will be shipped to you later).
- As per UKI rules, **course maps** will be posted when the trial opens each morning and will be available in the Agility Gate app and your MyDogEntry account. We will not have extra hard copies.
- **NFC with a toy** is allowed for all runs, but there is no food reward box at Classics. NFC runs have a 50 second time limit or the total game time (whichever is less). Note that running a Classic tournament class NFC disqualifies you from overall placements or Open byes for that tournament class.
- **Multiple Dog Handlers** – Please review the rules at the bottom of p4 in the premium regarding the "6-minute rule" when there are not enough dogs in the height to separate your runs with a 10-dog gap.
- If you have a **BIS**, please contact me ASAP. The BIS will remain in their running order and BIS will be designated next to the name on the running orders. The BIS must wear pants while inside, including when running. The handler/owner acknowledges the inherent risk of running a dog on an agility course with BIS pants on and assumes all risk by doing so.
- **Going to the US, West Coast, or Canadian Open?** Consult the **Bye tracker** available at <https://ukagilityinternational.com/events/> and remember that byes must be earned by the same dog **and** handler team that is competing at the Open. Let me know ASAP if your final confirmation doesn't show the correct handler.

MAC's next regular UKI trial is **September 19-20, 2026, at Animal Inn** with Danielle Davis judging.
