Entry Information

Entry Method: First Received with an Opening Date of January 15, 2026

- Entries may be received at any time on or after the opening date of January 15, 2026.
- Entries received prior to January 15, 2026, will be destroyed.

Entry Mailing/Online at MyDogEntry (processing fees apply for online entries)

- Emails regarding status of entry will not be answered if received before February 15, 2026.
- **Note:** Overnight envelopes must have the recipient's signature waiver signed, or the envelope will be refused or delayed.
- Receipt of delivery will not be verified before confirmations are sent.
- Checks will not be cashed until the entry has been accepted. Checks will be shredded for any entries that are not accepted/processed by the closing date. Money Orders/Bank Checks will be returned by mail within 2 weeks of the closing date.
- Limit of entries per envelope: six (6) Dogs per event. **Note:** The exception will be no limit if all dogs in the same envelope have the same 5-digit CPE membership number.
- If participating in more than one (1) event, then all entries may be sent in the same envelope.

Closing Dates

- Entries will be accepted until March 5, 2026, 6pm ET/5pm CT/4pm MT/3pm PT.
- Entries will not be accepted between March 5 to April 2, 2026 (closing date).
- Checks will be deposited as early as February 1, 2026/online entry fees will be charged upon an accepted entry.
- There will NOT be any REFUNDS of Entries withdrawn after **April 2, 2026, 3PM Pacific Time (PT). FINAL CLOSING DATE.**

An entry will not be accepted for the following reasons:

- Entries received prior to the mail in date will be destroyed without notice.
- An illegible or incomplete entry, unsigned/altered/incorrect year on check, ineligible dogs.
- More than six (6) dog entries in one (1) envelope with different CPE ID numbers.
- If the fees are not in US dollars.

An entry will be delayed or not delivered for the following reasons:

- Using any method other than Postal Mail.
- The required signature on the Express mail is NOT waived.

- CPE is not responsible for lost mail or emails that were not delivered. All emails received will get a response.
- Check your National confirmations carefully. Changes and corrections will NOT be made at the event regardless of who made the error. Ensure all entry information and move ups are correct.
- **NOTE:** MDE will send out a confirmation immediately. Contact CPE at **CPEnationalssecretary@gmail.com** if you do not receive a confirmation by February 20, 2026 for mail in entries.
- Early check in on Tuesday will be listed in the confirmation letter along with the check in times for each day dependent upon the number of entries received.

Eligibility

- A dog must have earned 20 Qs in SpeedWay between January 1, 2025, and December 31, 2025.
- The Qs may be earned in any SpeedWay class. All Qs earned at Nationals will count toward any respective titles.
- A permit height measurement must be listed on member services for each dog is required when the entry is sent into CPE.
- Competitors are responsible for all information contained in the premium.

Trophies and Awards

Medals will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height in each class. Veterans will be separate from Regular. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to each dog earning a Qualifying score in any class. There will be High In Trial Awards offered. Details will be available at the event.

Sponsored High in Trial Trophies

Sponsored awards are not CPE sponsored. The sponsor will determine the recipient and present their sponsored award at the awards ceremony Sunday evening.

- Any CPE club/member wishing to sponsor an award must contact CPE at **nationals@cpe.dog**, between March 20 to 27, 2026. The award wording must be approved prior to the sponsorship being accepted. Limited to one (1) award per CPE member ID or CPE Host Club. The club/member is responsible for supplying the award and must be present to give the award to the recipient at the awards ceremony on Thursday evening.
- The sponsored awards will be listed with the emailed nationals info, so exhibitors know what awards are offered.
- The award cannot be a wooden wall plaque. Most awards are usually no more than \$50 in value. The award cannot exceed \$100 total in value (cash awards are not allowed, gift certificates are).
- The award can have "CPE," "Nationals" or "National Event" on the award, the dates of the event, city, and state and High In Trial. The award cannot duplicate a trophy awarded by CPE.
- Individuals cannot win their own sponsored award if eligible. The award would go to the next eligible dog.
- There must be at least five (5) dogs or handlers entered for each respective sponsored trophy to be accepted and awarded.
- Awards can only be High In Trial and must be able to be determined by a team's cumulative score, not by an individual class, score, vote, or personal determination, unless approved by CPE.
- All sponsored awards must have a signup sheet at the event and is the responsibility of the sponsor. Contact CPE for a sample signup sheet format. The sponsor must determine the award recipient. Competitors are responsible for recording the scores on any award their dog is signed up for. If scores are blank, then those class(es) will not be counted regardless of the dog's score.

Other Show Information

ALL competitors are responsible for the information listed in the following:

- This event will be run under the CPE Rules and Regulations in effect at the time of the trial.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, competitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Obstacles must meet the specifications for obstacles under the current rules of CPE.
- Dogs may wear flat buckle collars without any hanging tags attached to the collar, nothing attached to the collars and no bling. Puppies under 8 weeks old are not allowed at a CPE trial. Selling of puppies at the show site is not allowed.
- Help keep the hotels for future trials! Clean up after the dogs. NO dogs are to be left in the room by themselves at any time! Bring sheets to cover sofas/chairs and bedspreads.
- See the CPE website for more local Information: www.cpe.dog/nationals/ i.e., Hotels, indoor crating space, camping, photographers, vendor list, other onsite events, and banquet forms.
- Veterinarian and Hospital info will be included in future Nationals notifications and/or be available at the site.
- Competitors/handlers who are under 18 years old must be accompanied at the event by their parent or legal guardian, regardless of if they are signed up as a Jr Handler or not.

Team or State Shirts

The shirt can have "CPE", "Nationals" or "National Event", the dates of the event, city, and state.

Nationals Shirts

Shirts are ordered through Beauty Of The Beasts and can be picked up from their booth at Nationals or arrangements can be made with them to have them shipped to your home.

Show Site Information

- All Competitors are responsible for this information. Dogs MUST be on leash with the leash in the handler's hand (or picked up) at all times during the show each day from Tuesday set-up through Thursday's trophy presentation and tear down, when not in their crates/ex-pens/vehicle.
- **Note:** Exception is when dogs are in the warmup areas, or in your immediate camping area if camping, after the show each day and must be under direct handler supervision.
- Dogs must be on leash with it in the handler's hand (or dog picked up) when entering the ring and before leaving the ring out-gate chutes.
- The Training Center buildings are smoke free - No smoking is allowed in any building on the grounds.
- All exhibitors are expected to pick up after themselves and their dogs and deposit it in the provided trash barrels or you will be excused from the event. If a competitor is excused from the event, refunds will not be provided.
- It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any competitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site without a refund of fees.

Refund Policy

- There will be a \$25 administration fee per each dog's entry for refunds requested prior to the closing date.
- Once a request has been processed to pull a dog from Nationals, the request cannot be reversed regardless of the date or reason.
- Refund checks will be sent by April 14, 2026, for refunds received by the closing date, by late May for all other refunds.
- No refund for bitches in season after the closing date.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog or handler is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of CPE, the show committee, or a Judge.
- Entry fee will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Returned check fee of \$30 will be charged for all entries received for the member and will be on hold until restitution is made by a US funds Money Order, bank check or certified check. Restitution must be received within 7 days of notification from CPE, or all entries are cancelled for that member. If the entries are cancelled, the returned check fee of \$30 will still be outstanding; if not paid within the 7 days, the CPE membership will be inactivated until the fee is paid.
- Dogs that are injured after the closing date will be eligible for a refund of 50% of the entry fees upon receipt of a veterinarian's letter on their office letterhead. Notification by email by May 1, 2026, or at the site by May 17, 2026, at the site. Letters received after these dates will not be accepted and will not result in a refund.
- In the unfortunate circumstance of the death of a beloved dog who is entered in the trial: a full refund of that dog's entry fee will be issued, even if after the closing date. Notification by email or at the site by May 17, 2026.

Emergency Information: Veterinarian and Medical Center

- Will be available in show information emailed after closing and at the site during the trial.

CHANGES for 2026 SpeedWay Nationals and Going Forward.

CPE now requires handlers to indicate if their dog will run back-to-back in the ring games. The courses will be the same for each day. This information will help in scheduling the groups as well as preplanning. There is a spot on the entry form for the handler to circle or to check on MyDogEntry, which will be required to be able to submit the entry. If the handler does not circle a response on the paper entry form, then CPE will assume the dog is not running back-to-back in the ring games. Once the entries have closed then the handler may NOT change.

Nationals SpeedWay Information

The Ring Games Only or Drag Race and Games Combined.

The following classes will be offered each day:

- Drag Race 50 – Two (2) rounds offered each day.
- Drag Race 100 – Two (2) rounds offered each day.

Note: A dog may only run either Drag Race 50 or Drag Race 100 but not both and/or one of each. See options on the entry form.

- Pitstop - Two (2) rounds offered each day.
- Slingshot – Two (2) rounds offered each day.
- Pole Position Solo – Two (2) rounds offered each day.

Competitors are responsible for reporting any discrepancies of posted results (scribe sheet copies or labels are not official, only printed posted results are official) prior to leaving the trial site each day; this also includes if there was a correction to a scribe sheet. The competitor must verify that the results were corrected as well.
- I/we agree to abide by the rules of CPE currently in effect at the time of the trial date and all terms and conditions pertaining to this Event. By signing below, I/we agree to the disclaimer and indemnity obligations on this entry form.

Timer – Electronic Timers will be used. PLEASE!!! Ask if you need instruction. The Timer will tell the next handler when to go by pressing the “GO” button, after the previous dog has entered the exit leash box. The Course Marshal will hand the timer the scribe sheets to write down the time of the run.

Exception: Drag Race, the timer will have all of the scribe sheets and will add the time.

Ring Games – if you have pushed the “GO” button for the team to start their run and the dog bypasses the first obstacle and crosses the “plane” of the start line/obstacle, you **must** start the dog’s time regardless if the handler resets the dog before the start line. The dog’s time HAS begun when the dog crossed the start line. If there is an issue with the timer and it affects the dog’s run, then the dog will get a rerun.

Timer Assistant for Drag Race – Once the Gate Steward gives the name and armband number for the next dog then the Timer Assistant will provide the scribe sheet to the Timer to add a time for the dog once the run is finished.

Gate Steward – In DRAG RACE notify the Timer the name of the dog, armband number, and confirm the Timer is ready. Allow the dog releaser to go into the ring ONCE the lure is in place, the previous dog has left the ring, and the catcher is in the ring. In the RING GAMES clip the scribe sheets for each dog entering the ring onto a clipboard and hand the clip board to the Course Marshal. Notify the handlers when to enter and will let the Course Marshal know of any problems or special circumstances.

Gate Steward Assistant – The Assistant for DRAG RACE will check dogs in and give the competitor a slip with the dog’s name so the competitor can give the slip to the Gate Steward. The Assistant for the RING GAMES will check in the dogs. ONLY the Gate Steward or Gate Steward Assistant can move the dogs if needed.

Leash Runner – RING GAMES ONLY. Please walk the leash to the Out Gate Leash box and place it on the chair. **Do NOT** put the hand loop or collar over something where the dog may get hurt.

Exit Gate Helper for Drag Race – Help the person catching the dog to quickly leave the ring so the next dog can run down the line. The next dog may not enter the ring until the previous dog has been caught and out of the ring. Ensure the gate is closed for the next dog to begin. The catcher may go into the ring when the dog is announced, and the lure is in place. **NOTE:** Be sure correct catcher is in the ring for the correct dog.
