Groups

We will be utilizing two groups to run this event on Saturday and Sunday. Groups will not be used on Friday. A group list will be published to <https://k9trialservices.com> and <https://mydogentry.com>

Schedule Change

The running order for Jumping on Sunday has been changed from what was listed in the premium. We will be running Jumping in Mike's ring Beginner/Novice then Senior/Champ.

Checking In

You do not need to check in with the trial secretary unless you still owe entry fees or have your dog(s) measured.

Course Maps and Gate Sheets

We will not be providing paper course maps. Course maps will be available at site opening on <https://k9trialservices.com> and <https://mydogentry.com>

In an attempt to reduce paper waste, we will be utilizing the real-time run order on MyDogEntry. This allows you to check in, scratch or mark your run as a conflict from your own device. You can also check to see which dog is currently running. There will be a tv near each ring which will be showing the run order for each ring so you can watch the run order while waiting to run your dog.

Bitches in Season – Are allowed to run at this event.

Note from Premier Sports Center. Since this is a special event with exhibitors traveling from a greater distance, we have decided to make an exception for the Jersey Devil DASH. This does not mean we have had a change in policy for all future UKI trials. BIS will run in their running order but must start on a mat provided by the show. You must notify the show management of any BIS. BIS pants may be worn but are expressly done under the handler's risk.

Food

There will not be a food vendor on site. Please plan/pack accordingly.

Volunteers

Help from competitors is not only appreciated but is necessary to conduct a smooth-running show. Please see our ring managers to volunteer to work. We have lots of great raffle prizes for those who volunteer.

Scoring and Results Posting

There will be a TV monitors scrolling scores as they are entered into the computer. Please check these monitors to ensure your score is correct as soon as possible after your run.

Class results will be posted on <https://k9trialservices.com> shortly after the completion of each class. Individual results will also be uploaded to <https://mydogentry.com>.

Please note that any scoring discrepancies MUST be brought to the attention of Dan Burke within 30 minutes of the results being posted for any class.

Running Orders

The running orders for the preliminary rounds will not be emailed to each competitor and will be available online at <https://k9trialservices.com> and <https://mydogentry.com> by Wednesday morning. If you do not have a gap of 10 or more dogs in between multiple dogs, please see Dan Burke or Tina Power to move one of your dogs. You may NOT move in the running order without the permission of either Dan or Tina. If we are not able to create a 10-dog gap, you will be given 6 minutes between your dogs. The 6 minute countdown will start as the handler's first dog crosses the finish line; the handler must enter the ring with their second dog before the countdown is complete.

Measuring Dogs

Please ensure you understand the criteria regarding dogs being measured. UKI Rule Book edition 10 If a dog is under 3 and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of the dog's height must be done by the dog's 3rd trial. A permanent measure must be obtained by a UKI official measurer between 12-18 months after the dog's first/ temporary measure. Any registered dog that only has a temporary measure, must follow the above rule. If a newly registered dog is over 3, they must obtain a measure by an official UKI measurer by their 3rd trial and this measurement will be permanent. Measuring will take place near ring 1 prior to the first class.

Parking/Crating

There is limited climate controlled indoor crating available on a first come first served basis. Crating is only allowed in designated areas. You must bring a tarp to place under your crate.

Car/Van Parking: In addition to the front paved lot, we also have a grass field out back behind the building. There is a side driveway on the right side of the building to access the back field. You can also park along the side of the building and along the tree line next to the driveway. Please park efficiently... do not leave more space between you and the next car than what a normal parking space would allow. If you allow too much space or double park you will be asked to move. Please do not park out on the circle or in any business neighbor's lot. Please do not park your car in the front field or alongside the tree line that faces the front paved lot. Those areas are reserved for RVs. There is very limited handicapped parking, please arrive early to obtain a spot.

RV Parking:

RV's must be parked by the staff. When you arrive, pull up front and park in the fire lane with your blinkers on. Text Sue Bintliff when you arrive to be parked: 609-410-0889. If she does not answer your text, come inside to find her to be parked. This is also where you can fill your fresh water tank if needed.

We will be there on Thursday evening until 8:00pm to park RV's. If you arrive after 5:00pm on Friday or Saturday eve when no one is there to park you. Park in the paved lot only. Take as few parking spots as possible. Be prepared to be moved in the am possibly.

Do not assume it is ok to park yourself on the grass .. this depends on how much rain we have had. No RV's along side of the building. If you want to park next to someone you can let me know that when you arrive and we will find a spot where you can save space for your friend.

Online Results

All clear rounds/qualifying results will be available to view at <https://ukagilityinternational.com> within 2 weeks of the trial. You will be able to log on to your account and see results that were clear rounds, gaining level points.

Sports Center Hours

The Center will close, and doors will be locked approximately one hour after the last run has been completed for the day. Be prepared.

Smoking

Smoking is not permitted inside our facility and not encouraged outside near others. We prefer if you must smoke that it is done inside your vehicle and that your butts are discarded in your vehicle ashtray.

NFC & Repeat and Move On

Not For Competition (NFC) and Repeat and Move On (RMO) will be allowed in all runs. A maximum course time will be enforced during all NFC/RMO runs.

Maximum Course Time

All eliminations and NFC runs will be given a maximum course time of 60 seconds. A single buzzer will sound at 50 seconds as a warning and multiple horns will sound at the 60 second mark, at which time you must leave the ring immediately. For Gamblers, you must leave the ring on the second horn, there is no reattempting the Gamble after the 2nd horn.

Dog Exercise Areas

Premier Sports Center has 4 acres of grass for you and your dogs to enjoy. All dogs need to be on a leash and under control at all times while on Premier Sports Center property. The only exceptions for off leash are when at the practice jump or in the ring. Poop bags are to be discarded in outside trash receptacles only. Do not walk your dog on our business neighbor's properties. Pay attention to your dog and pick up after your dog. Anyone seen in person or on video not picking up after their dog or walking on the neighbor's property will be subject to a bench hearing and immediate excusal from the Center for the remaining day(s) of the trial. Do not let your male dog lift its leg on the building, front landscaping, or on any item a human needs to handle.

Please be considerate of the public restrooms. Trash cans will be placed in the bathrooms for proper disposal of paper products other than toilet paper. No dogs allowed in public restrooms. Personal chairs/handicap chairs will not be allowed on the turf field. We will provide bench seating in the front of the rings for all to use. Please remove your personal belongings when your class has ended.

UKI DASH - General Rules

- Dogs and handlers need to be UKI members. Register online at www.ukagilityinternational.com
- Entry is open to everyone irrespective of the dog's UKI level.
- Dogs and handlers must be registered with UKI.
- Each class has a separate competition for each jump height.
- Dogs may only compete at one height throughout the whole event.
- Dogs may only compete with one handler in DASH Tournament Classes. If this rule is broken handlers and dogs will be disqualified from the whole DASH event.
- Classes will be run in strict running order. Running orders will be randomly drawn for all rounds except the Steeplechase DASH Challenge Final.
- Failure to be on the start line for your turn will result in Elimination and unable to run in the class.
- Classes will be run under UKI rules and regulations, with additional rules detailed in the premium. Any further amendments will be posted on the trial's social media page for the event.
- In the event of a tie for a progression place in the Triathlon, the result from the FUSION Agility will decide the winner followed by the result from the Jumping.
- In the event of a tie for a progression place into a final, both dogs will go through to the Final.
- In the event of a tie for a top 3 overall podium in a Final, a runoff will be required. If a competitor chooses not to run in a runoff, they forfeit their place, and the higher place will go to the other competitor. A coin toss will determine the placings if both competitors do not want to run in a runoff.
- In the event of a tie to determine the running order in the Steeplechase DASH Challenge Final, a coin toss will determine the running order.
- A no-show in any class or any round of an event will result in disqualification from that event, including prizes and awards and will incur 1000 faults.
- UKI reserves the right to rule at the event on anything not covered in these rules and in any exceptional circumstances.
- The Steeplechase DASH Challenge and Final will use a scoring of 5 faults = 5 seconds. The FUSION DASH Triathlon will use the least faults wins with time as a tiebreaker.
- FUSION DASH Pentathlon Agility classes must have 3 contact passes per course, the Dogwalk may not be used.
- Courses may have up to 22 obstacles at this event.
- The minimum and maximum distances (dogs' path according to the course design program) will be 20-28 feet with an average maximum distance of 25 feet.
- Show Management is committed to safety and is determined to provide premier equipment, running surface and course design. However, unforeseen circumstances may arise that are out of our control. By entering this event, you accept that you have a personal choice not to run in any class if, for any reason, you believe there are safety issues due to differing opinions on course design and/or environmental factors. You agree by entering this event that you have no comeback or right for a refund on any course you do not wish to run due to course design and/or environmental factors.

UKI DASH TOURNAMENT DESCRIPTION AND SCORING

The DASH Tourney Overall Winner

Each jump height will produce the best scoring dog based on the overall results of those who ran in the Steeplechase DASH Challenge Final and the results of the DASH Triathlon. The winner will gain a bye into the Speedstakes Final at both the USO & WCO & will also gain a Rd 2 Nationals Bye at the USO & CO. If the overall winner has not already achieved a bye for one of the Finals at the DASH Open, they may choose one of the Finals as their automatic Bye.

The tabulation for the Overall winner will be based on the number of dogs entered within each jump height in both events. The event winner (i.e. Steeplechase DASH Challenge Final) will receive the highest points equal to the total number entered in that jump height. Example: If 10 dogs are entered in the 24-inch height in the Steeplechase Challenge, then the winner will receive 10 points, 2nd place 9, 3rd place 8 and so on. All dogs entered will receive the points based upon their ranking, even if they are not eligible for the Overall awards. Eliminations in the Steeplechase Challenge Final will receive 0 points.

- Only dogs progressing into the Final of the Steeplechase DASH Challenge are eligible for the Overall tabulation.
- A no-show or NFC in any class will result in disqualification from any awards or progression for that event and overall winner result.
- If a dog is eliminated in the Final, they are no longer eligible for the overall award.
- If a dog obtains TWO eliminations in the Triathlon event, they are no longer eligible for the Overall award.
- In the event of a tie for the overall winner, the Steeplechase DASH Challenge Final placement will be the deciding factor.

Should a dog win the overall result and has previously obtained this result at another DASH Tourney, the result will not move down to the next placed dog.

1. Steeplechase DASH Challenge & Final

Scoring: Faults converted to time. 1:1. i.e. 5 faults equals 5 seconds

Eliminations will score 50 faults with 50 second course time.

Three preliminary rounds and a Final

- Rd 1 - Speedstakes (jumps & tunnels). Clear rounds will earn *4 level points in Speedstakes*
- Rd 2 - Speedstakes Jumping (Jumps, tunnels 1 x weave). Clear rounds will earn *4 level points in Jumping*
- Rd 3 - Steeplechase (jumps, tunnels, 1 x AF, 1 x weave). *No progression points awarded.*

The top 10 or top 25% (whichever is higher) from the combined rounds 1-3 will progress into the Final. (Any No Show or NFC rounds in the above classes do not progress.)

- Final - Speedstakes class. *No progression points awarded.*

SDC Final Winner Award – Gains a Bye into Steeplechase DASH Challenge Final at The UKI DASH Open.

2. DASH Triathlon

Scoring: Least faults wins with time as a tiebreaker.

Eliminations will score 100 faults with 50 second course time.

Three Rounds with results combined to determine the winner

- Rd 1 FUSION Agility (3 contact passes). Clear rounds will earn *4 level points in Agility*
- Rd 2 Jumping. Clear rounds will earn *4 level points in Jumping*
- Rd 3 Speedstakes. Clear rounds will earn *4 level points in Speedstakes*

(Any No Show or NFC rounds in the above classes will not be placed.)
