TRIAL INFORMATION

These trials are being held on private property. This is a non-working farm with open fields. There is a long narrow driveway that goes past the house and barns. The parking lot will be in a mowed field off the main driveway. The area will be marked with signage.

There is a gun club approximately one mile from the site. You may be able to hear gun fire during the event. This year there will be a Barn Hunt Event on the same grounds. The area for that event will be under Barn Hunt Association rules while the FAST CAT area will be under the AKC rules.

Beam timers will be used and the course will have a **continuous loop lure**. The 100-yard FAST CAT track and run-out will be fully fenced. The run-out area will be between 30 and 50 yards.

At check-in your dog will be inspected for lameness, physical impairment, fitness to run, height and if a bitch whether or not, she is in heat. The dog must be inspected before any wraps are placed on the dog. **Inspection will take place before each run.**

Do not bring a dog with a contagious disease or a dog that has been exposed to a contagious disease within the last 14 days to the event site. You will be asked to leave the trial.

The handler may release the dog or catch the dog at the finish. You should have someone who will either release or catch your dog with you. If not, you will need to ask someone at the trial to either release or catch your dog. **Bring 2 leashes, one for the release and one for the finish. No Flexi- leashes.**

You may not run with your dog or run alongside the fencing while your dog runs. You may not travel down the length of the course just prior to your dog’s run.

If you are in the finish area you may clap or cheer to encourage your dog. You may run within the finish area. You may **not** use whistles, duck calls, electronic calls or similar items; to call the dog to you and **you may not recall your dog from the start line**. Toys, tugs and treats may be used **after** the dog has crossed the finish line to aid in capturing the dog. Lure must move for a qualifying run.

THE TRIALS WILL BE CONCURRENT. This means that each dog will run one trial and then will run the second trial shortly after the first. The first trial does not finish before the next begins.

THERE WILL BE AN ASSIGNED BLOCK RUN SCHEDULE. A certain number of dogs will run both trials in an hour time block. There is no specified run order within the time block. Example -you will check-in, have your dog inspected, do your run. Then you can immediately return to the inspection /check-in, and do your second run. If you are not comfortable that your dog has had sufficient rest, you can take the time you need between runs. Please complete all your runs during the assigned time block.

You may leave after you have completed your runs. Qualifying ribbons will be available as well as title ribbons for FCAT, BCAT and DCAT. Please let us know if you are anticipating earning a title.

There is no crating available. Be prepared to crate in your car. There is no shade in the parking areas. Bring shade, water, fans, etc. necessary to keep you and your dog(s) comfortable. There will be kiddie pools available for the dogs.

Please clean up after your dog. Anyone caught not picking up after his/her dog will be excused from the remainder of the trials with NO REFUND. It is important that the property be left in pristine condition so that future events can be held here.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

These trials are open to all dogs twelve (12) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. If your mixed breed dog needs a Canine Partner number you can enroll at <https://www.akc.org/register/information/canine-partners/enroll/>.

Your mixed breed dog must be spayed or neutered to receive a Canine Partner number

Females in season may not participate. Aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

By Regulation, each dog will be inspected before each run for lameness, fitness to compete and females in season prior to any form of wrapping being applied to the dog. The dogs may also be measured to ensure the proper height factor is used to calculate points. If you dog is excused at inspection your entry fee minus \$4.50 fee per run will be refunded.

ENTRY FEES

*An entry is defined as a single run by a single dog, in a single class. Entry fees include a \$4.50 per run AKC recording fee.

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax, or hand delivery. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to **Pat Roach** at proactive@rochester.rr.com. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

There will be no refund if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitch in season will receive a full refund less a \$4.50 administration fee. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

DOTCORN is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date - May 21, 2026 at 3 PM. (EDT). A maximum of **15 entries per trial** will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **May 21, 2026 at 3 PM(EDT)**. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on May 21, 2025 unless it can be replaced by a wait listed entry, then a full refund will be issued. Any wait listed entry will have their check held until the trial. **The wait list will expire on May 29, 2026 at noon.** If a wait listed entry does not make it into the trial their check will be destroyed

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Food: There is **no** food available at the site. There are a number of places to get food and /or drink along Route 332 in Canandaigua

Parking: Parking is in **designated areas and there is no overnight parking**

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Qualifying Score *Light Blue*

A **New Title rosette** will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title - BCAT (150 points), DCAT (500 points), FCAT (1,000 points).

Qualifying and title ribbons can be picked up shortly after the dog has run.

Exhibitors are responsible for picking up their ribbons or awards. No ribbons or awards will be mailed.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform the runs safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Kennel Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During runs, dogs may run without a collar. or wear a properly fitted collar without loose tags. Any tags must be removed or taped to the collar so they do not dangle **Prong collars are not allowed on AKC trial sites.** Basket muzzles are allowed. The dog may wear a harness except during the run.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes **may not** be used when on trial grounds. Dogs must enter and exit the race area on a leash, including when waiting in the race area before and after the race.

Please keep your dog on a 6-foot leash at any time the dog is not in your car or on the course. **You want to bring 2 leashes so that the person who releases the dog has one and the person who captures the dog has one.**

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing com-

mittee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused from the course. If the dog was barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee a full refund will be given. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund unless it can be replaced by a wait list entry. Dogs who are excused at inspection will receive a refund minus a \$3.25 service fee for each run.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first trial each day.

RINGSIDE

The Hunt Master, who signals for the lure to start, is not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having the dog ready at the course when it is time to run. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the course area during the scheduled block time. If a dog does not check-in during the assigned block time, it will be considered absent.

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: The Check-in and inspection will be combined in the same area which is visible from the parking areas.

Exhibitors MUST check-in and the dogs inspected EACH day they are entered and for EACH trial that they are entered.

All dogs will be inspected before each run.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

“Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian’s recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.”

2019 Risser Rd. Rd, Canandaigua, New York 14424. This is a residential/farm site north of the city of Canandaigua. Your GPS will take you to the neighbor’s driveway. Look for the FAST CAT signs and /or the columns of horseshoe at the end of the 2019 driveway.

Your GPS may take you on a different route

From the NYS Thruway. (West) Take Exit 44 (Canandaigua) follow signs to Route 332 (south). Take Route 332 to Route 96. Turn left unto Route 96. Take your 3rd right onto Payne Road. Cross 2 intersections and Payne Road become Risser Rd. The driveway will be on your left.

From the NYS Thruway (East) Take Exit 43 (Manchester) Turn right onto Rte. 21. Turn Right onto Route 96. Take your 5th left onto Payne Rd. Cross 2 intersections and Payne Road become Risser Rd. The driveway will be on your left.

From the North- take Route 21 South. Turn right onto Route 96. Take your 5th left onto Payne Rd. Cross 2 intersections Payne becomes Risser Rd. The driveway is on your left

From the South - Take Main St. (Route 332) north through Canandaigua. Turn right on North St. Stay straight onto Macedon Rd. Make a slight left onto Risser Rd. Driveway will be on your right.
