Entry Mailing

- Emails regarding status of entry will not be answered if received before March 15, 2026.
- If you wish to have delivery verification for your entry, be sure to use e-confirmation with the post office and waive any signature requirements or the delivery of your entry will be delayed. Do not send by certified mail!
- Receipt of delivery will not be verified before first confirmations are sent.
- Limit of entries per envelope: six (6) Dogs. Note: The exception will be no limit if all dogs in the same envelope have the same 5 digit CPE membership number.

An entry will not be accepted for the following reasons:

- Entries received prior to the postmark date will be destroyed without notice.
- An illegible or incomplete entry, unsigned/altered/incorrect year on check, ineligible dogs.
- More than six (6) dog entries in one (1) envelope with different CPE ID numbers, per event.
- If the fees are not in US dollars.

- The Club is not responsible for lost mail or emails that were not delivered. All emails received will get a response.
- Check your Regional confirmations carefully. Changes and corrections will NOT be made at the event regardless of who made the error. Ensure all entry information and move ups are correct.
- **NOTE:** Contact: tina@powerdupagility.com if you do not receive a confirmation by June 13, 2026. A move up confirmation is sent for each agility move up when processed during the move up dates on page 1.
- Early check in on Thursday will be listed in the final confirmation letter along with the check in times for each day dependent upon the number of entries received.

Eligibility

All eligible CPE dogs registered for agility are eligible to play.

You must enter all 4 tournament events on Friday and Saturday to be eligible for any of the tournament awards.

If you are participating in Team, you and your teammate must enter all 8 Team Classes.

Sunday Classes are all regular classes and are not required to be entered.

Regional Tournament Information

Fusion: This Tournament will combine two classes (Tournament Standard and Tournament Jumpers) offered on Friday: Each of these classes will be one course for all levels. These classes will be scored at time plus faults with the winner being those with the lowest scores. The two classes will be combined for the Overall Fusion 1st through 3rd place Winners. A Podium presentation will be done at the end of the day. Individual class winners will be provided medals from the host clubs. The Overall combined Fusion winners will be provided an award provided by CPE. Tournament placing will be done in the following groupings Reg/Vet Small (4,8,12 Regular), Reg/Vet Large (16V (jumping 12), 16, 20, 24) and Enth/Spec Small (4,8,12) and Enth/Spec Large (16,20).

Standard and Jumpers qualifiers can also be earned in these classes using your normal CPE scoring rules for your level. Regular placement ribbon and qualifying flat ribbons provided by the clubs.

Screwball: This Tournament will combine two classes (Tournament Standard and Tournament Snookpot) offered on Saturday: Each of these classes will be one course for all levels. The Standard class will be scored at time plus faults with the winner being those with the lowest overall score. The Snookpot class is a blend of Snooker and Traditional Jackpot. The teams will perform a Snooker course per usual that will end with a finish jump that will lead directly into a Traditional Jackpot distance challenge. When you have accumulated enough Snooker points for your level, you may take the Snooker Finish jump and move on to the Jackpot part of the course. The course time for Big Dogs (24/20/16/16v) will be 70 seconds and the total game time for Small Dogs (12/8/4) will be 75 seconds.

Scoring of Snookpot:

- If you are “whistled” off on the snooker course, you are not eligible to move on top the Jackpot. You will score 0 (zero) for both parts of the course.
- If you successfully complete snooker and **do not choose to attempt** the Jackpot part of the course, you will earn the points for Snooker and be able to get a Snooker Qualifying leg but will get 0 (zero points) for the gamble.

- If you choose to attempt the Jackpot part of the course and are not successful (including being over total game time), you will get a Zero on both the Snooker and Jackpot courses and overall 0 tournament points.
- If you are not successful with the overall total of points to qualify in Snooker and you attempt the Jackpot because you thought you had enough points, and you successfully complete the Jackpot, you will get 0 points in both Snooker and Jackpot as you did not successfully complete the Jackpot.
- If you are successful in Snooker and you successfully complete the Jackpot under the total game time, you will earn your Snooker points and you will get 44 points for the Jackpot section earning a qualifying score in both Snooker and Jackpot and will earn the combined points toward the overall Screwball tournament.
- This class will be scored by taking 100 minus your game point with the winner being those with the lowest score (with time being the tie breaker).

The two classes will be combined for the Overall Screwball 1st through 3rd place Winners. A Podium presentation will be done at the end of the day. Individual class winners will be provided medals from the host clubs. The Overall combined Screwball winners will be provided an award provided by CPE. Tournament placing will be done in the following groupings Reg/Vet Small (4,8,12 Regular), Reg/Vet Large (16V (jumping 12), 16, 20, 24) and Enth/Spec Small (4,8,12) and Enth/Spec Large (16,20).

Standard, Snooker and Jackpot qualifiers can also be earned in these classes using your normal CPE scoring rules for your level.

Overall Festival Champion: The overall Festival Champions will take a combined score of Fusion (Standard/Jumpers) and Screwball (Standard and Snookpot) classes over the two days and determine the overall Festival Champions 1st – 3rd place. A Podium presentation will be done at the end of the day Saturday. Placing will be done in the following groupings Reg/Vet Small (4,8,12 Regular), Reg/Vet Large (16V (jumping 12), 16, 20, 24) and Enth/Spec Small (4,8,12) and Enth/Spec Large (16,20).

Team: This tournament will consist of two dogs whose scores from all regular classes offered on Friday (FullHouse, Snooker, Standard,) and Saturday (Jackpot, Wildcard, Colors and Jumpers) will be combined to determine overall Team Winners. Team can be mixed height and consist of two separate handlers and dogs in Regular/Veteran or two in Enthusiast/Specialist. Standard, Colors, Wildcard will be Scored Time plus faults and Snooker, Jackpot and FullHouse will be scored 100 – game points (time will only be considered if a tiebreaker exists). The winners will have the lowest overall combined scores. Jumpers will be the final Team class and will have the be scored as Time/2 + Faults X 2. This will give an little added excitement that the final class can change overall seeding. The winners will have the lowest overall combined scores. The overall team winners Regular/Veteran Small and Large and Enthusiast/Specialist Large and Small placed 1st to 4th will be provided an award provided by CPE.

Class qualifiers can also be earned in these classes using your normal CPE scoring rules for your level. You can enter these classes and not enter team for regular qualifiers.

All classes offered on Sunday are regular classes, no tournaments offered on Sunday.

Awards

- Qualifying flat ribbon will be awarded to each dog earning a Qualifying score in any class.
- Generic placement ribbon will be provided for all classes
- 1st – 3rd Medals will be provided by the Host Clubs for each Tournament – Reg/Vet Small, Reg/Vet Large, Enth/Spec Small, And Enth/Spec Large.
- C-ATCH, C-ATE Ribbons will be awarded by the host clubs, the clubs must have advance notification of potential.
- CPE will provide overall tournament awards for Fusion 1st – 3rd, Screwball 1st – 3rd, Overall Festival Champions 1st – 3rd, and Team 1st – 4th.

Other Show Information

ALL competitors are responsible for the information listed in the following.

- This event will be run under the CPE Rules and Regulations in effect at the time of the trial.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, competitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Obstacles must meet the specifications for obstacles under the current rules of CPE.
- Dogs may wear flat buckle collars without any hanging tags attached to the collar, nothing attached to the collars and no bling. Puppies under 8 weeks old are not allowed at a CPE trial. Selling of puppies/dogs at the show is not allowed.
- Help keep the hotels for future trials! Clean up after the dogs. NO dogs are to be left in the room by themselves at any time! Bring sheets to cover sofas/chairs and bedspreads.
- See the CPE website for more local Information: www.cpe.dog/nationals/ (i.e., Hotels, indoor crating space, camping, photographers, vendor list, other onsite events, and banquet forms). Forms and information will be added/updated as known.
- Competitors/handlers who are under 18 years old must be accompanied at the event by their parent or legal guardian, regardless of if they are signed up as a Jr Handler or not.

Show Site Information

- All Competitors are responsible for this information. Dogs MUST be on leash with the leash in the handler's hand (or picked up) at all times during the show each day from Thursday set-up through Sunday's clean up, when not in their crates/ex-pens/vehicle.
- **Note:** Exception is when dogs are in the warmup areas, or in your immediate camping area if camping, after the show each day and must be under direct handler supervision.
- Dogs must be on leash with it in the handler's hand (or dog picked up) when entering the ring and before leaving the ring out-gate chutes.
- **SPEED LIMIT ON PROPERTY IS 5 MPH. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED AT ALL TIMES.**
- Site buildings and grounds are smoke free. Smoking is NOT allowed anywhere on the grounds. No campfires.
- All exhibitors are expected to pick up after themselves and their dogs and deposit it in the provided trash barrels or you will be excused from the event. If a competitor is excused from the event, refunds will not be provided.
- It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any competitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site without a refund of fees.

Refund Policy

- There will be a \$10 administration fee per each dog's entry for refunds requested prior to the closing date.
- Once a request has been processed to pull a dog from Regional, the request cannot be reversed regardless of the date or reason. No refund for bitches in season after the closing date.
- Refund checks will be sent after the June 12th closing date.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog or handler is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of CPE, the show committee, or a Judge.
- Entry fee will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Returned check fee of \$30 will be charged for all entries received for the member and will be on hold until restitution is made by a US funds Money Order, bank check or certified check. Restitution must be received within 7 days of notification from the trial secretary or trial chair, or all entries are cancelled for that member.
- Dogs that are injured after the closing date will be eligible for a refund of 50% of the entry fees upon receipt of a veterinarian's letter on their office letterhead. Notification by email to the secretary by June 29, 2026.. Letters received after this date will not be accepted and will not result in a refund.
- In the unfortunate circumstance of the death of a beloved dog who is entered in the trial: a full refund of that dog's entry fee will be issued, even if after the closing date. Notification by email to the secretary June 29, 2026.

Directions to the Site.

From the South (Route 22 North): From the Route 22/43 Intersection, continue North on Route 22, past the mobile home park on your right. Take Giles Road (County Route 33 on the right (gray house)). The turn is sharp and the road takes another sharp right after the horse farm. Go over the small bridge and pass by farm buildings on both sides. To the immediate right you will see a yellow Sugar Bush Farm sign. Follow the driveway straight out to the agility fields.

From the North(Route 22 South): Take Route 22 South through Berlin, turn left on Giles Rd/County Route 33. The turn is sharp and the road takes another sharp right after the horse farm. Go over the small bridge and pass by farm buildings on both sides. To the immediate right you will see a yellow Sugar Bush Farm sign. Follow the driveway straight out to the agility fields.

From the West via NY Thruway (I-90 East): Take Exit 11E (Route 20 East. Follow Rout 20 East until it joins Route 22 North in New Lebanon, NY.. Bear left to continue on Route 22 at the abandoned gas station. Remain on Route 22 North, pass through the traffic light in Stephentown where Routes 22 and 43 intersect, continue on Route 22 past the mobile home park on your right. Take Giles Road (County Route 33 on the right (gray house)). The turn is sharp and the road takes another sharp right after the horse farm. Go over the small bridge and pass by farm buildings on both sides. To the immediate right you will see a yellow Sugar Bush Farm sign. Follow the driveway straight out to the agility fields.

From the East via Mass Pike (I-90 West): Take the Mass Pike to Exit 1. Pass through the toll booths and remain on MassPike/ NY Thruway connector Rd. DO NOT exit at the West Stockbridge ramp. Take Exit B-3 off the MassPike/ NY Thruway connector road. Go right on Route 22 North. Continue on Route 22 North through the Town of New Lebanon. Bear left to continue on Route 22 at the abandoned gas station. Remain on Route 22 North, pass through the traffic light in Stephentown where Routes 22 and 43 intersect, continue on Route 22 past the mobile home park on your right. Take Giles Road (County Route 33 on the right (gray house)). The turn is sharp and the road takes another sharp right after the horse farm.
