



FINAL CONFIRMATION for JAG UKI Trial - Friday Evening, July 10, 2026

Here is the Final Confirmation for this Friday's UKI trial at JAG.

We welcome CAIT PUSKAS from South 'Jersey as our Judge.

Day of show entries accepted, let your friends and students know!

Come run on our new-and-improved, watered and levelled dirt surface. Day of show entries will be accepted - ask Paul for a form if you need one (pink paper!)

TIMETABLE

5:00 -Site Opens. Please pull head-in to parking places and read more about PARKING below. Check in with the Trial secretary in the office. Additional parking in the back field just to the right of the barn.

6:00 General Briefing. Plan to be near the front of the barn by the tents to hear all that we need to tell you. This will be followed by the walk through for the first course, and any measuring needing done. Measuring can continue throughout the evening. Paul is in charge of measuring and measurement record-keeping. More below.

6:15 Judging begins. First class is Beginner / Novice Speedstakes 1

MYDOGENTRY: this is the first trial where we're using MyDogEntry.com, so you can go to the page <https://mydogentry.com/public/trials/1274> to see the run order, directions, etc. Note that some dogs will be more separated on gate sheets than on this list.

OTHER IMPORTANT NOTES: If you're not handling your own dog, please let secretary know.

MEASURING REQUIREMENTS have changed in UKI.

Here is what UKI wants us to put in every final confirmation:

"The updated rule book, Edition 11 requires all trials to have a dog measure on hand by their 3rd trial (since the 9/16/24 rule change). Please arrange a time that dogs who do not yet have a measure are able to get one at your trial. The rules for dogs to be measured will be strict and so these need to be done in order for handlers to continue competing with their dogs.

Please ensure you understand the new criteria regarding dogs being measured. UKI Rule Book edition 11: If a dog is under 3 and newly registered, a temporary measure or proof of the dog's height must be done by the dog's 3rd trial. A permanent measure must be obtained by a UKI official measurer between 12-18 months after the dog's first/ temporary measure. Any registered dog that only has a temporary measure must follow the above rule. If a newly registered dog is over 3, they must obtain a measure by an official UKI measurer by their 3rd trial and this measurement will be permanent."

We are working closely with UKI to comply with their requirements, as they suggest if you don't comply, you don't get to keep competing! I will have the new (green) height cards for dogs under 3; I am happy to measure dogs. I show that at least BRIOCHE Mainardi, SI'LAS Sawyer, Lucy & Ricky Meyer need measuring. Let's wait until the dogs start running to measure, please.

WORKERS: We need volunteer workers. The volunteer coordinator is Rachel Rosetti. You can sign up when you get there and/or as the day progresses. We will gladly teach you if you want to learn a new volunteer position! JAG Members be sure to sign the book indicating that you did work for the trial.

WORKER RAFFLE: a variety of prizes available for helping us tonight.

PARKING: You may park to the left or right after you go up the driveway - **5 MPH please.** Please pull head-in to (don't back up to) a parking place. Handicap parking - pull right up to the building close to the door. Plenty of good spaces to work from your car, close to the building. This is a working farm with rescued farm animals, so you can't have your car exhaust blowing into their pens. Overflow parking is the lot just to the right of the barn, behind/beyond the regular parking.

(no) **CRATING:** This trial will use the entire floor for the agility ring, so please plan to work from your car.

The GENERAL RUNNING ORDER

is big to little, except occasionally a handler with multiple dogs in one class will have

a dog running somewhere else in the order, often first and last. Senior/Champ will run before Beginner / Novice in each class of this trial, except Speedstakes 2, the last class of the night, will run combined - one walk/run for all.

See separate "Preliminary Run Order" document sent in this same mailing. Specific run orders are subject to change due to our expecting late and day of show entries.

High Level Class orders:

Friday Speedstakes 1 B/N, S/C; Jumping B/N, S/C; Speedstakes-2 everyone together.

Note about the combined class:

Combined Speedstakes means that there is a single briefing, walk-through, set of runs for everyone, but is still scored by level and height.

NEWER: Bitches- in- season are now allowed at this trial, but please let the Show Manager know if that's the case, for specific instructions.

SCORING: Results will be posted on the wall near the clock - we will announce at briefing; ribbons will be put out with results. Ribbon pickup is self-serve. Information labels to put on the back of ribbons should be available.

TRIAL SITE Rules:

- Dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing or at practice jump.
- Competitors must pick up after their dogs and deposit in facility trash cans.
- There is no food service at the site. There are two Wawas within a few miles, including a very convenient one right at Garden State Parkway exit 91.
- Please stay home if you feel sick or think your dog may be exposed to kennel cough.

COURSE MAPS: newer distribution options are now in place:

- Everyone entered will be e-mailed a set of maps about 2 pm Friday --("3 hours before doors open") is the UKI rule
- They should be available on the mydogentry site
- A full sized set of course maps will be posted near the entrance to the office.
- A small number of reduced-size map packets will still be available.

DIRECTIONS: Use your favorite mapping program to get you to 392 Ramtown-Greenville Road, Howell NJ 07731. From PA consider NJ Turnpike to exit 7A (I-195 East) to Garden State Parkway South, taking exit 91, then choose 91B. From South Jersey do that or come across 70 then north on the Parkway or back roads.

Most everything else, alphabetical by topic:

ALTERNATE EXIT GATE: I haven't seen course maps yet but it's possible the side gate will be used as an exit.

HOSPITALITY: we will have various snacks, small water bottles, and possibly baked goods available in the secretary's office, at no charge to you. Donations of food or drink are most welcome.

MEASURING table will likely be placed indoors, in the aisle next to the stalls.

MEMBERSHIP Information: may be on the wall near the hospitality table.

MONEY OWED: several of you still owe for your runs. Payment options: Cash, check payable to PMCC Services LLC; JAG Dollars are accepted too. (Paypal/Zelle to pmccservices@gmail.com and Venmo to Paul-Mount-15 are now accepted for payments too).

NEXT TRIAL HERE: is Friday Sep 11. Premium for this show will be available.

NOT FOR COMPETITION runs "NFC":

You must declare any run "Not for Competition" if that is your intent, as you enter the ring. The run will not be scored, but the judge will still observe that you treat your dog according to UKI standards (safety, good judgment, and fair treatment of the dog). You must still jump your entered jump height. You'll have up to standard course time of the class. In that time, you can work on whatever you want. In an NFC run, you may bring a toy or other like training device into the ring to reward the dog's performance. The toy cannot squeak, contain food, or be food. If a run is not declared NFC and you repeat an obstacle in a way that the judge deems to be training, you will be excused from that run.

PORTO-POTTY: is in front of the building by its left corner.

POTTYING FOR DOGS: on the grass near the fences.

PRACTICE JUMP: Usually outdoors just to the left of the building.

PRODUCT SALES: A variety of products for dogs including 1-TDC, MYOS muscle builder, PB Pets Canine Hemp Oil will be available for sale in the secretary office.

REPEAT and Move On: Similar to Fix and Go in AKC; will be explained by the judge.

RESULTS after the trial: A PDF file of all the results will be sent to you a few days after the trial. Please review this file for accuracy, before it's sent in to UKI.

RIBBONS: including NEW TITLE and championship ribbons will be provided by JAG.

RUNNING ORDERS: We put Gate Sheets and Scribe sheets out one or two at a time to best manage day of show entries. They will be on display just outside the ring under a tent; do find them and check yourself in for each class you're in.
